
Human Ecology ALUMNI UPDATE News for Alumni and Friends of the College of Human Ecology

The FY 07 Human Ecology Annual Fund

- raised \$740,213, a 43% increase over last year
- received contributions from 1,613 donors, an 11% increase over last year

- Approximately 1,200 Human Ecology alumni attended 42 events in 17 cities across the country
- The College has raised \$21 million towards its \$70 million goal as part of "Far Above... The Campaign For Cornell"
