Dear Sir:-

I have this day sent to the 2" Asst P.M.G. a diagram showing the location of our Road between Atchison and Saint Joseph, together with a time table under which we are now running, and from which you will perceive (as you are doubtless already aware) that we are the most expeditious route for mail service reaching Atchison.

I have not shown the Saint Joseph & C. B. R.R. for that is immaterial. Should Mr. Tyner inquire about it you can say that it runs within fifty feet of our Line between the cities.
