Community-Based Science



WHAT: Community-based science event. Volunteers help **detect ticks** important to human and animal health in their communities.

WHY: Several tick species are moving northward and westward across the state. We want to keep track of where they are moving each year.

HOW: Volunteers register to participate and attend a training event. All participants receive a tick collection kit in the mail & sample for ticks at a designated location. All ticks are mailed back to Cornell University for identification.
