**BOARD DECISION AND ORDER**

This matter comes to us by reason of a report and recommendation of the Acting Director of Conciliation (Director) regarding a petition for interest arbitration filed by the Subway Surface Supervisors Association (SSSA) under § 209.5 of the Public Employees' Fair Employment Act (Act) and § 205.15 of our Rules of Procedure (Rules) with respect to an impasse in contract negotiations between SSSA and the Staten Island Rapid Transit Operating Authority (SIRTOA).

In his report and recommendation, the Director concludes that a voluntary resolution of the contract negotiations between SSSA and SIRTOA cannot be effected and recommends that the impasse be referred to a public interest arbitration panel.


SIRTOA has not filed an objection to the Director's report and recommendation

pursuant to § 205.15 (b) of the Rules.




