Dear Sir:-

I understand from our Gen'l Supt that you are supplied with blank passes over this Road. If not please advise me and I will send you same for such use as seems best.

I say book because I understand they are printed in that form, not that I want a very large number but it is quite convenient to have them on hand as the interests of both roads are advanced by their use.
