Yours of the 12th, with enclosures received.

The report of the meeting at Atchison is substantially correct.

The rates of Toll were not made by the Ry. Company, but accepted by them, as under the circumstances, satisfactory.

We have a very good switch engine, and I think capable of doing all the work of crossing cars at the Bridge, certainly for the present, that we will rent you for \$8.⁰⁰ pr day, putting the same in good order before sending it. Should not this be of sufficient power, I can let you have another one in its place, first class in all respects, for \$10.⁰⁰ pr day, that being the least price at which I have heard of any locomotive be rented.
