The enclosure I hand you explains itself.

I have written the major that his views and ours are identical in reference to the propriety of the early solution of the liability, and where it should rest. With this view, it seems advisable that you should visit Kansas City at as early a day as consistent and thoroughly investigate this matter, for the purpose of ascertaining by whose fault the collision occurred. That done, we shall be in a condition to settle, not only with Maj. Henning, but also the claim of the party demanding damages account of injury in consequence thereof.
