An office can be built at small expense adjoining north side of Baggage shed. If material were sent me I can if necessary have labor performed by force now employed on this Division. I do not desire to construct a gorgeous concern but a comfortable place to do necessary writing or should you wish a small room could be built independent of Baggage Shed and after present Depot is vacated it could be used for watchman's house or other suitable purpose.
