The one with the N. Mo. R.R. is somewhat indefinite in its terms, and very brief. This track needs repairing badly as the iron is very much worn. Would it not be well to arrange with the "N. Mo." for relaying this nine (9) miles with steel, if they are to pay one half of the maintenance.
