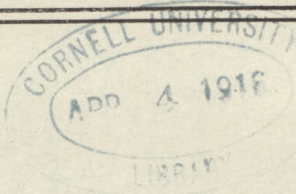

It may be well to sum up definitely and briefly this matter of Mrs Martin's resignation, which is of very real concern to us. Mrs. Martin's resignation is on grounds of the University's refusal to invest the office with any academic recognition. She is doing the work of a dean of women with the handicap and the injustice of not being officially recognized as dean of women. The real loss we will undergo with this resignation is not in matters of discipline and administration in connection with girl's affairs. It is a loss of a personal leader. But we cannot expect to keep the woman who is capable of this service to girls without giving her academic rank. She can get it elsewhere, and we cannot expect her to be an educational leader without it. Therefore our request for a dean of women should have the serious and united support of the girl student body.
