STUDENT GOVERNMENT.

Yesterday at a house meeting in Sage, the new plan for "signing up" was outlined to the girls. It is somewhat on the order of University registration and is called the "Three Card" system.

Every time a girl leaves the dormitory to be out later than 10 p. m. she must sign three cards stating the time of leaving and the time of returning to the dormitory. One of these cards is to be filed with the warden and one with the Advisor of Women. If the card is for a social diversion, -- under the head of which, come dances, theatre (including the Star and Crescent), dinners, etc. -- the warden must approve and sign the card. University concerts, lectures and the library do not need the approval of the warden, but cards for these places must be filled out and filed.

This plan is to be tried out in the dormitories and a little later will be put in effect for the organized outside houses.
