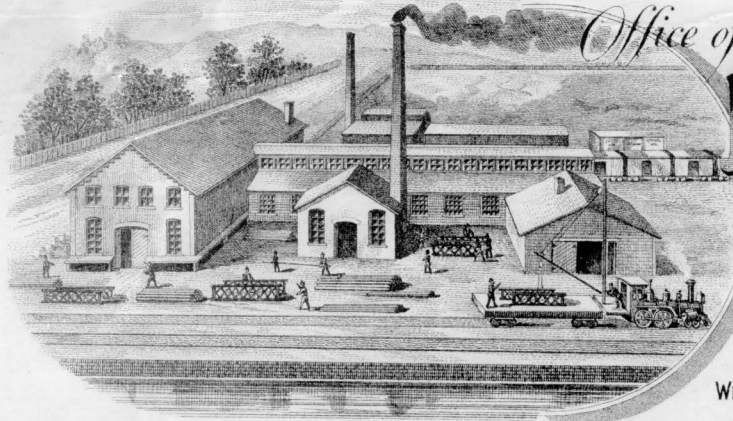

Among the first examples of my father's work and first exemplifying his ideas and peculiarities of construction are the bridge over the Connecticut River at Springfield Mass. for the B. & A. R.R. - 7 spans 180 ft. each, double track, three trusses, and the North Hudson River Bridge at Albany - 4 spans 175 ft. each, 1 draw span 262 ft, and 14 spans about 70 ft each, double track with two overhanging sidewalks, with two trusses.
