

Feb-6. 1827. This morning
about one o'clock as David
Jackman and Mr. Frederick
Carlton were driving a heavily
loaded team, drawn by four
oxen and a horse over Essex
Murrineds Bridge the Chains
broke and precipitated them
into the river, Both men &
horse were saved, but the
oxen were drowned. This morn-
ing was very cold and the
bridge had on a large quanti-
ty of snow and ice
