I have also prepared the infobase version of the report called for by our agreement. Thanks to the LEAP Library CD-ROM that version is able to link to illustrations of many features of our works that the print report can but describe. Once the infobase has been installed (using the load utility contained on the disk) onto a machine set up to run the LEAP Library CD-ROM, those links connect to a wide variety of LII publications.
