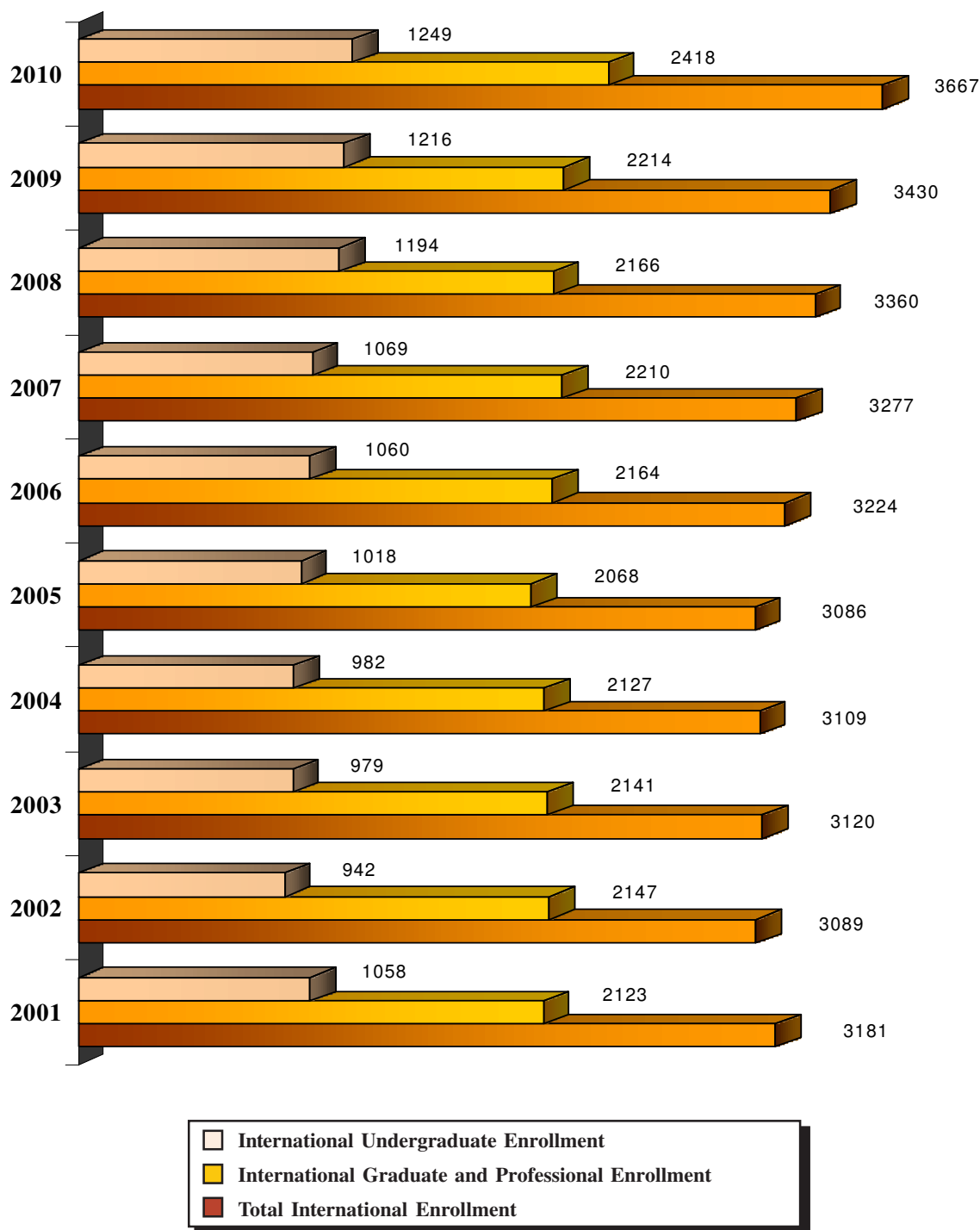
## International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment



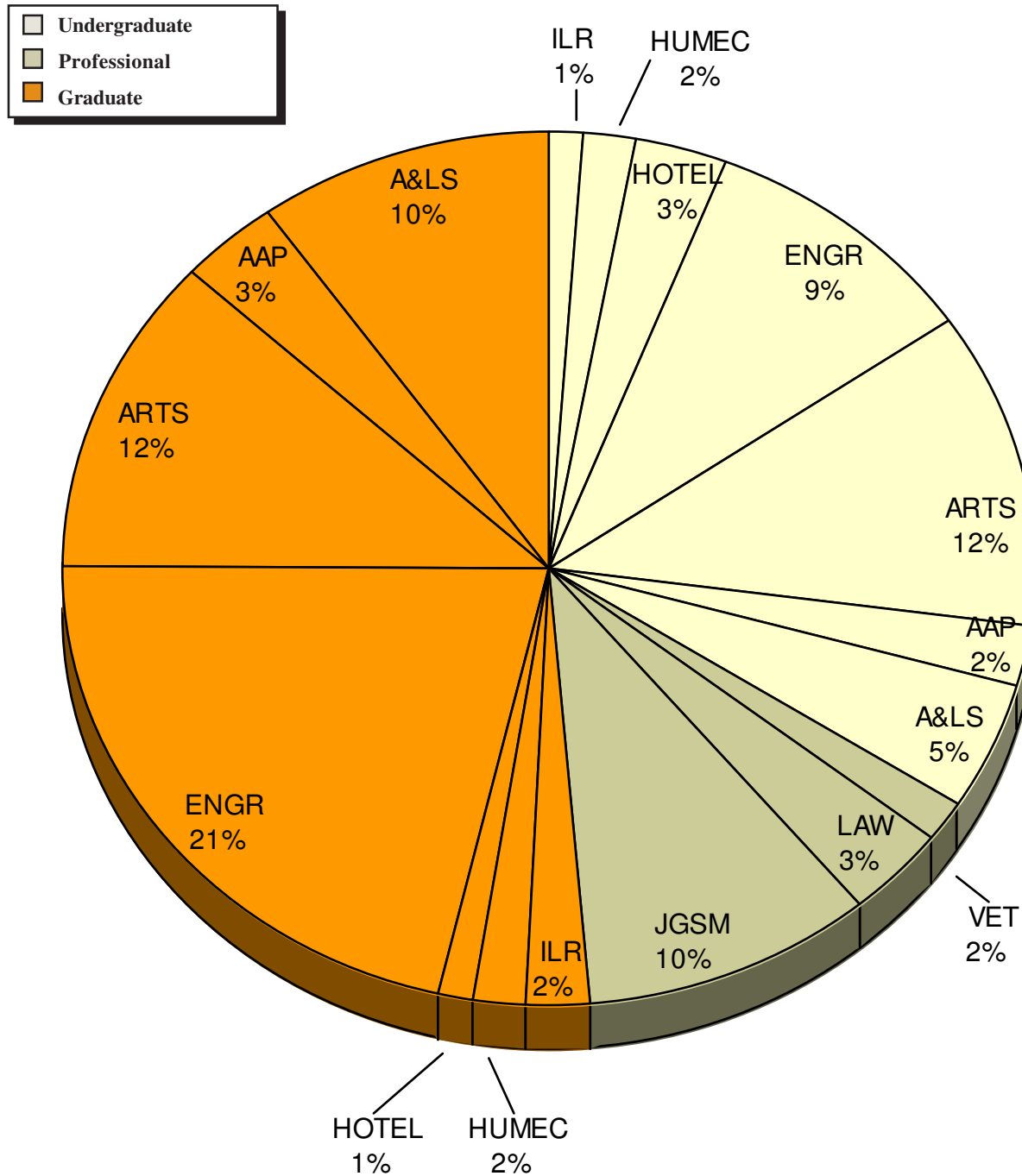

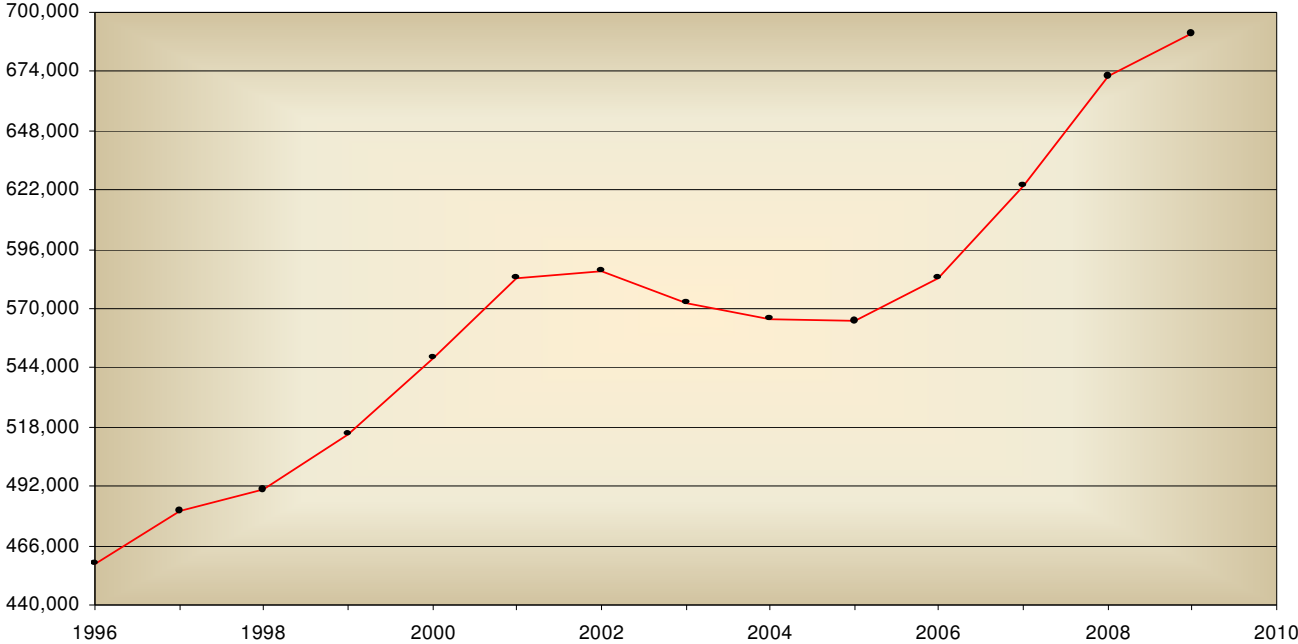


# International Undergraduate, Graduate and Professional Student Fields of Study Fall 2010

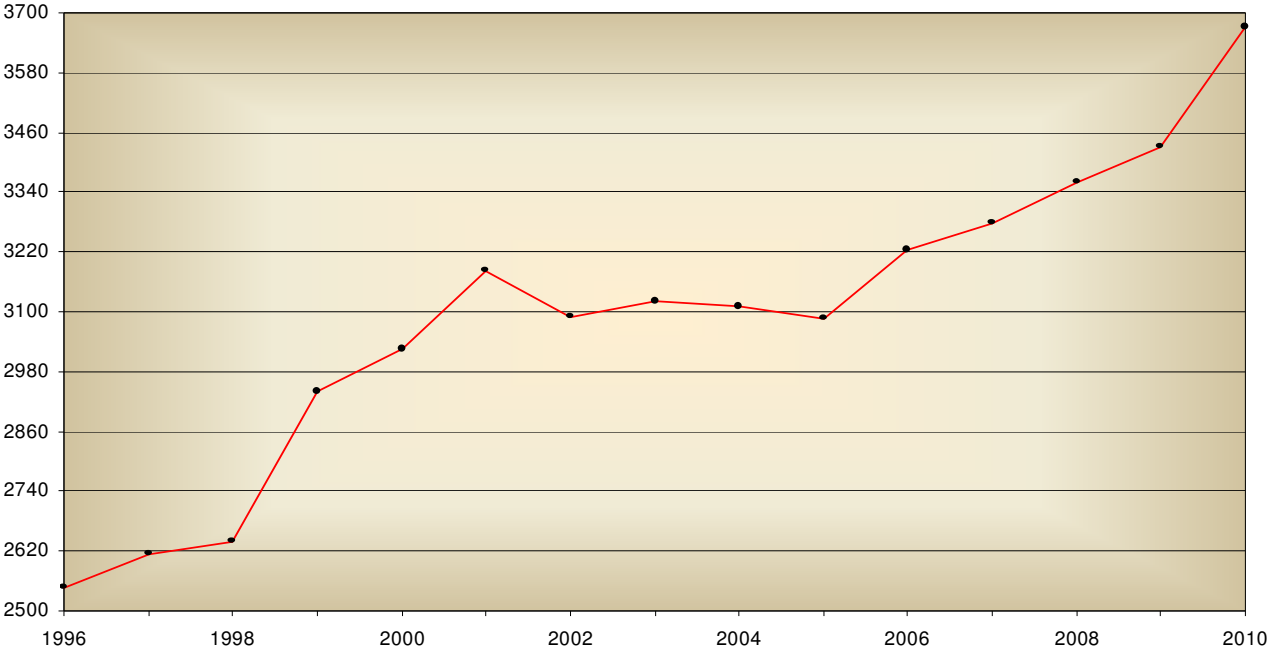


# International Enrollment Trends 1996 - 2010

## National Trend



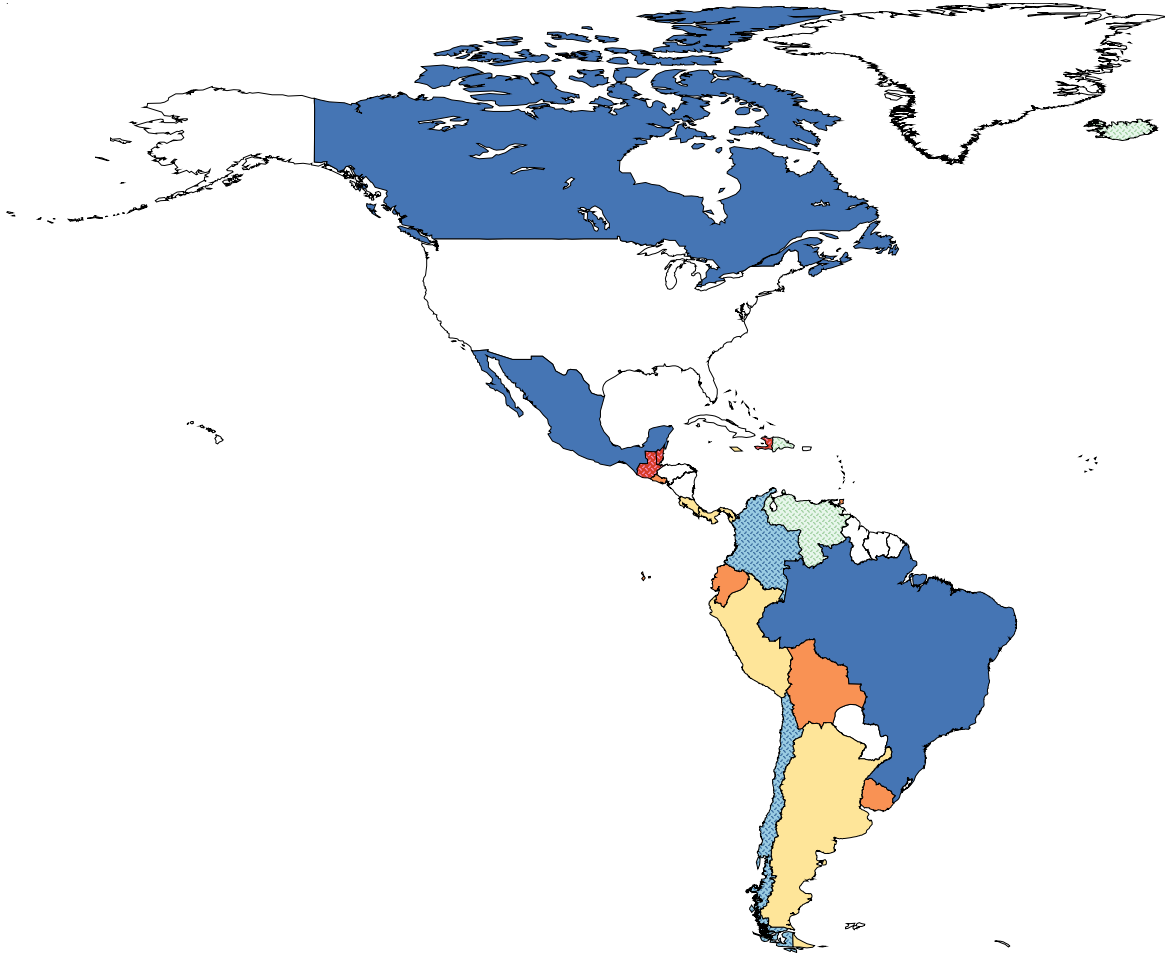

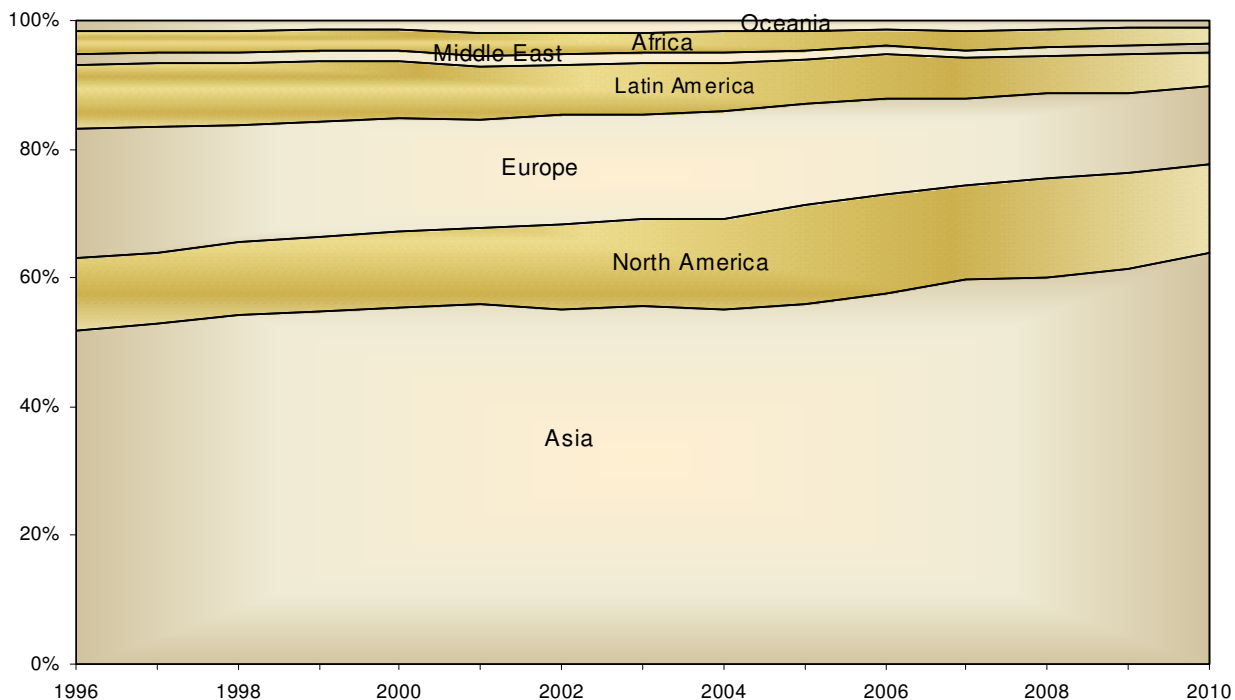

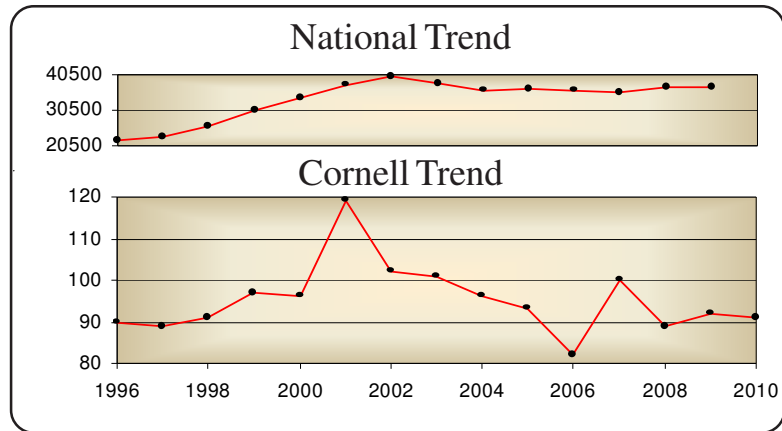
## Regional Enrollment Trends 1996-2010



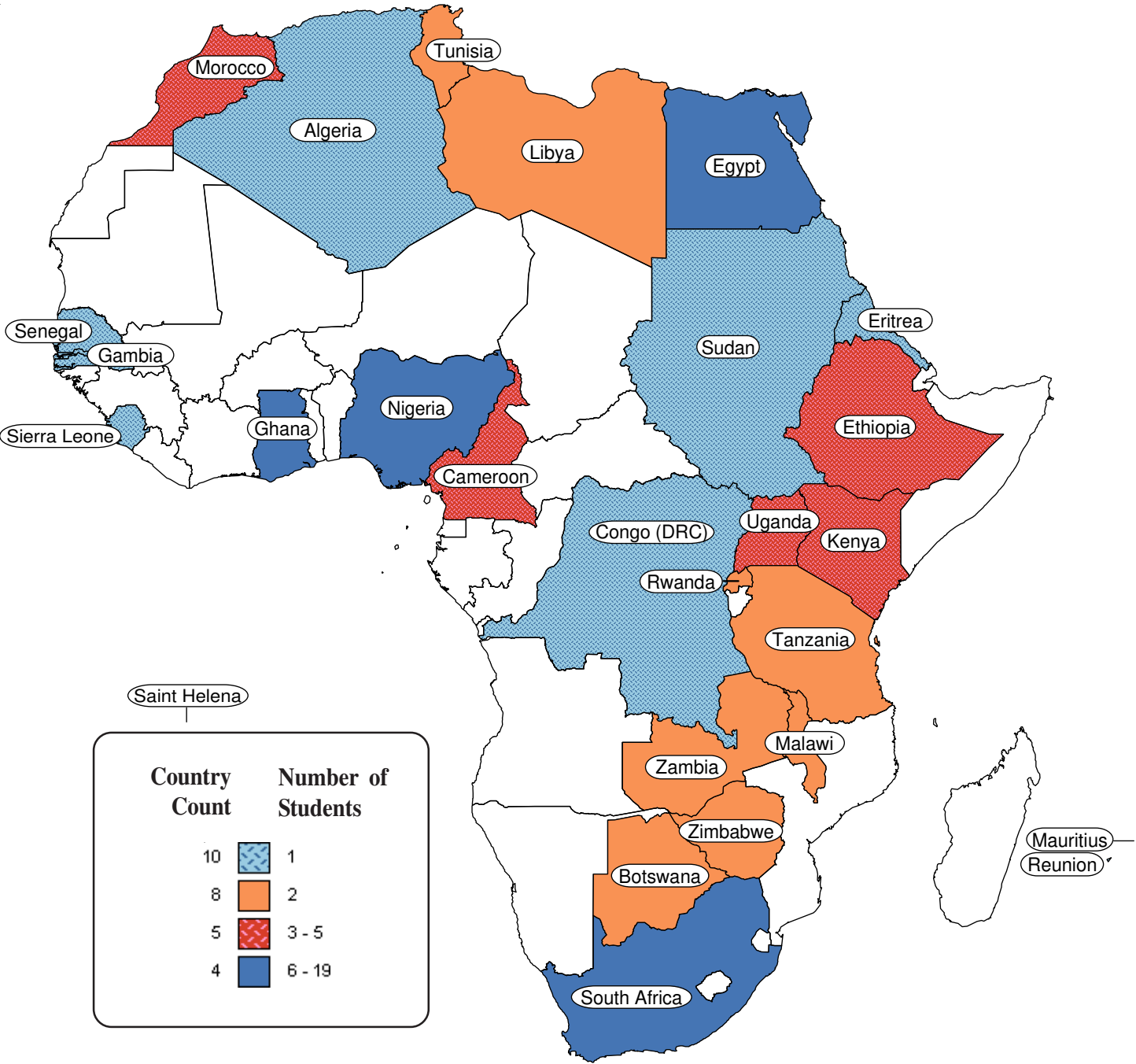
