

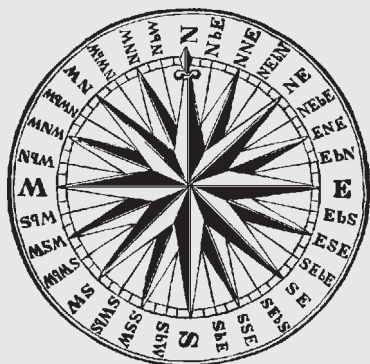

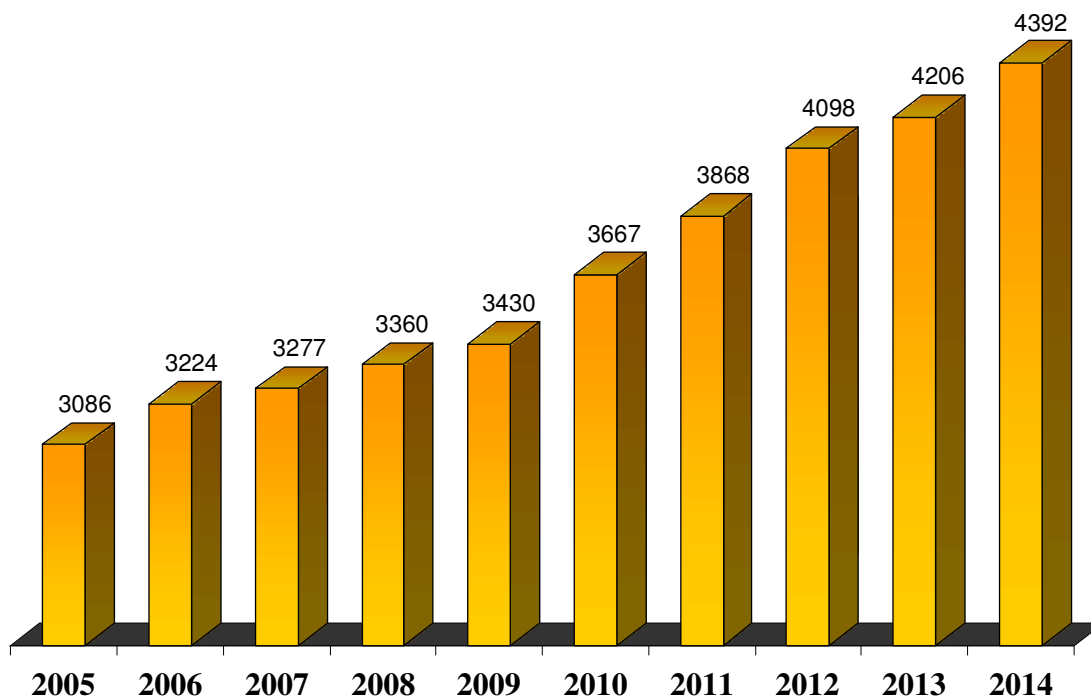

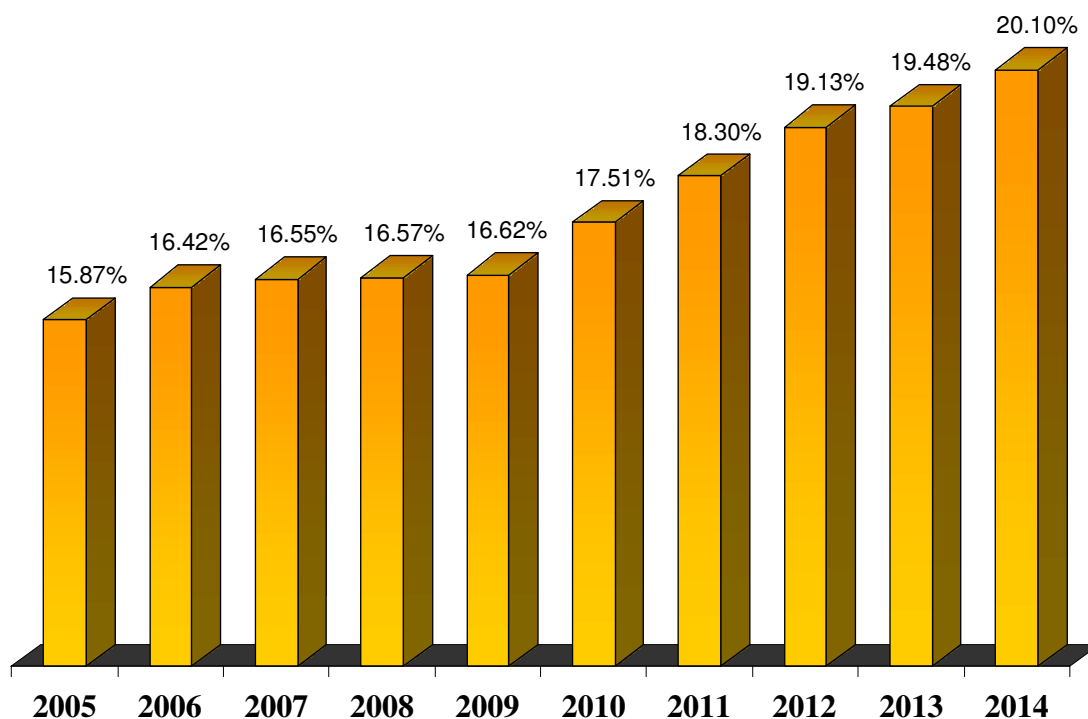

International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment

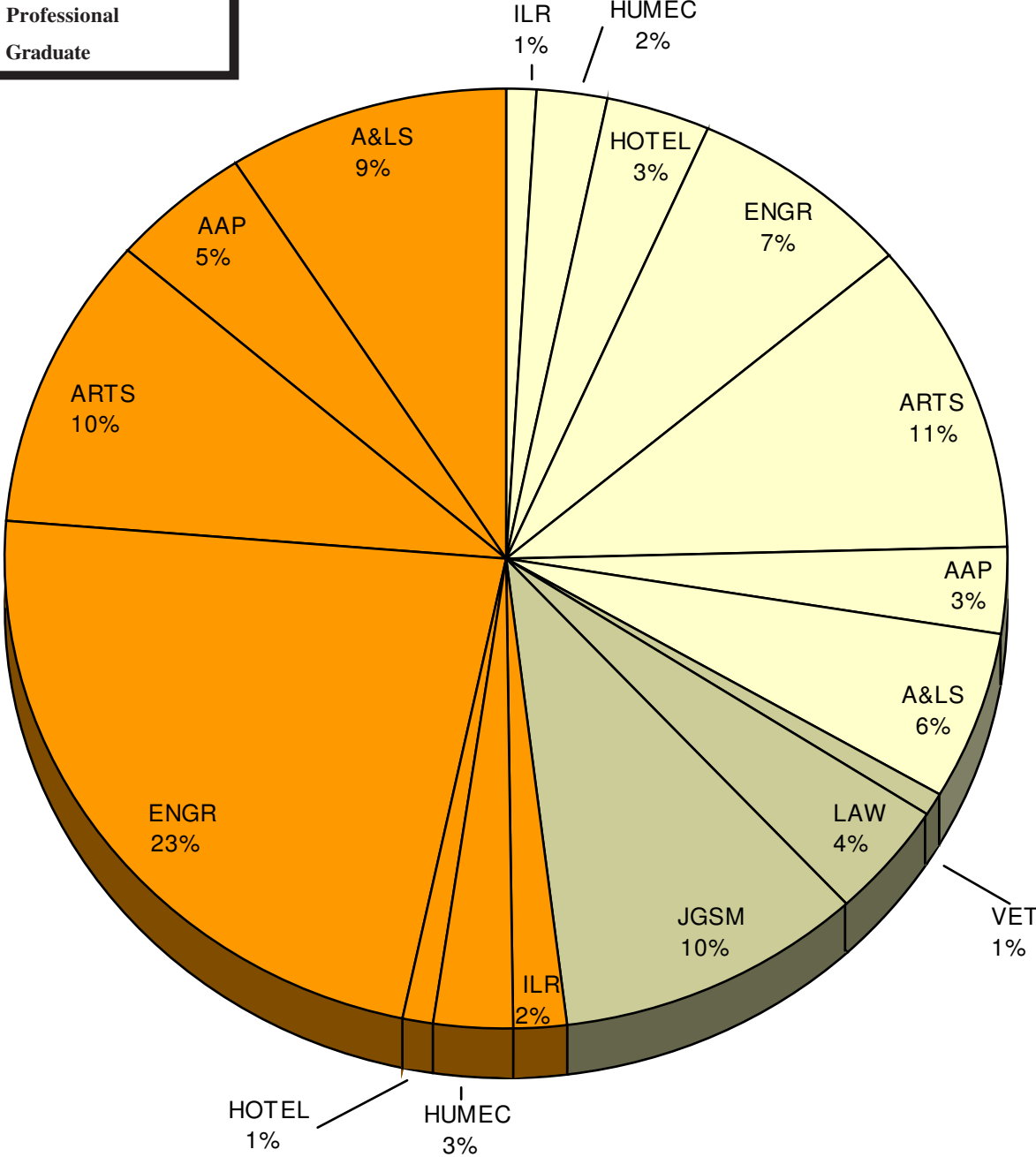
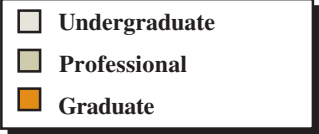

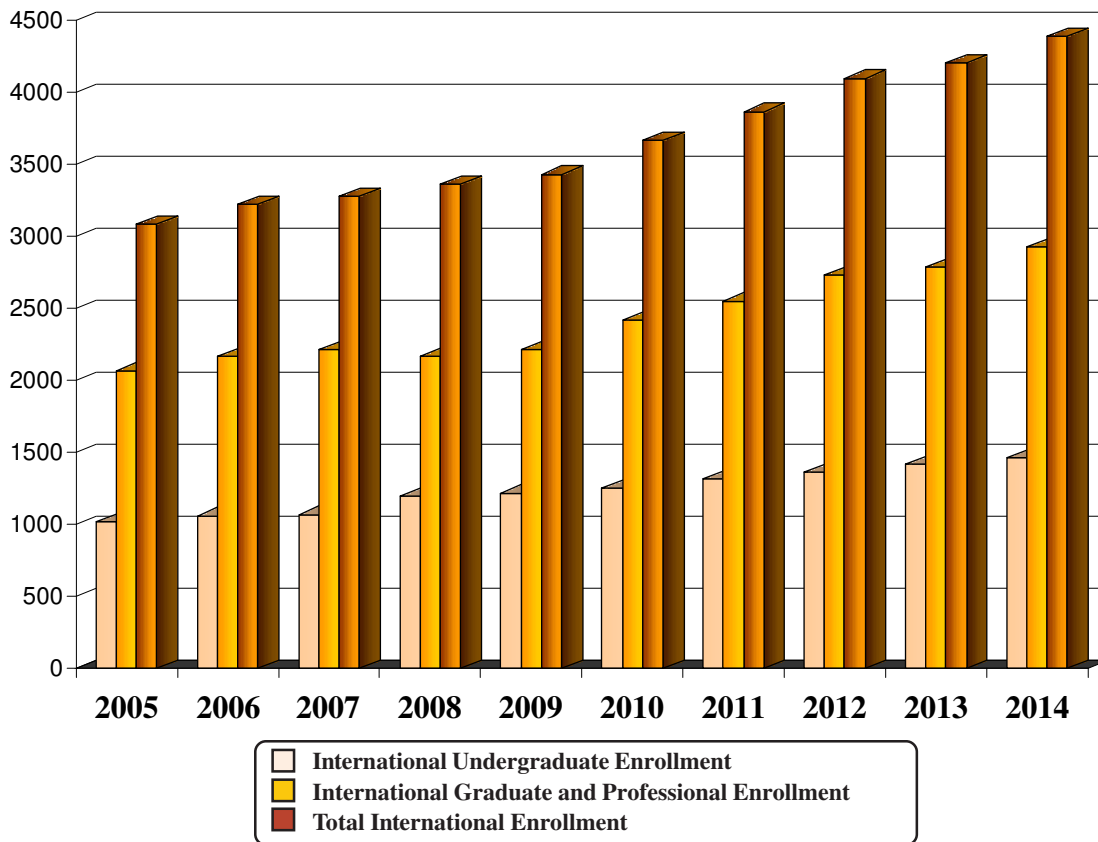

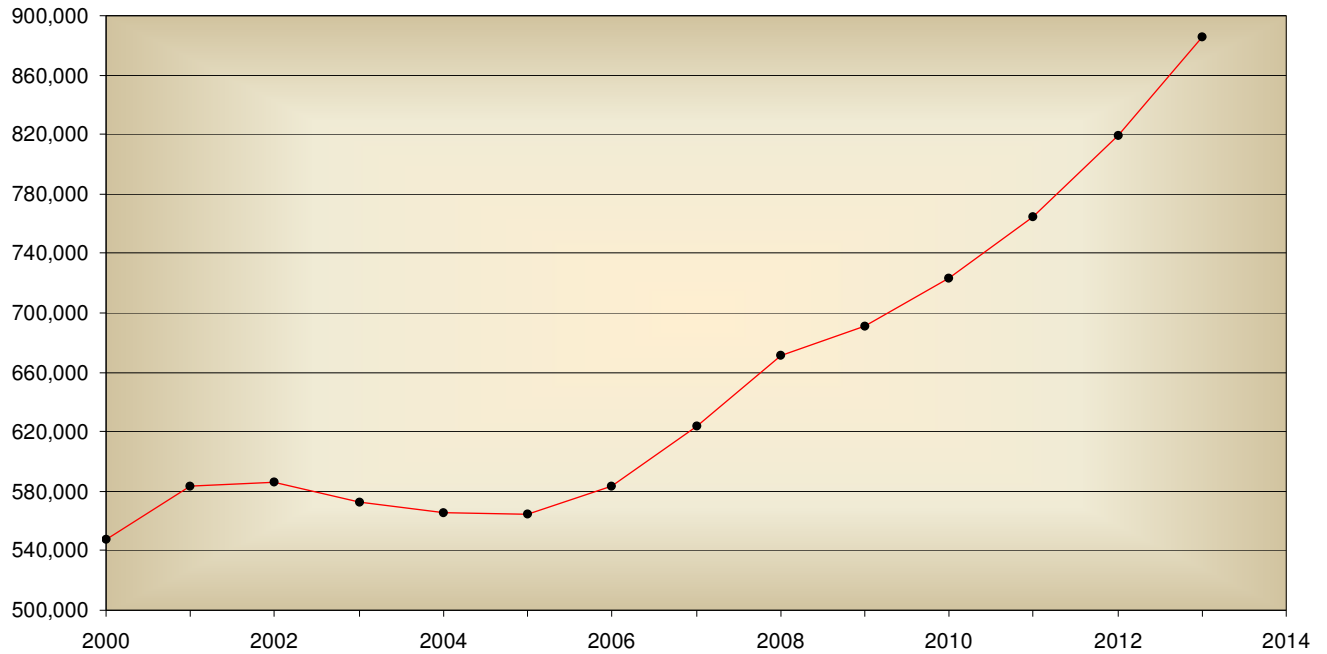

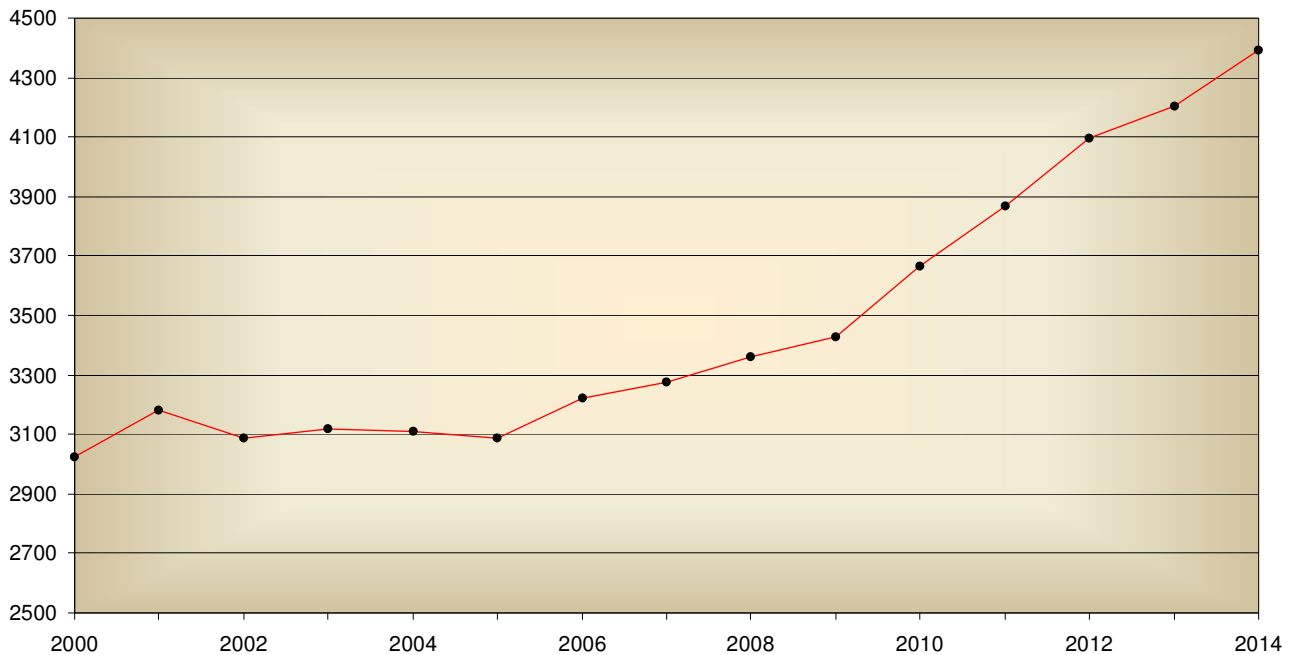

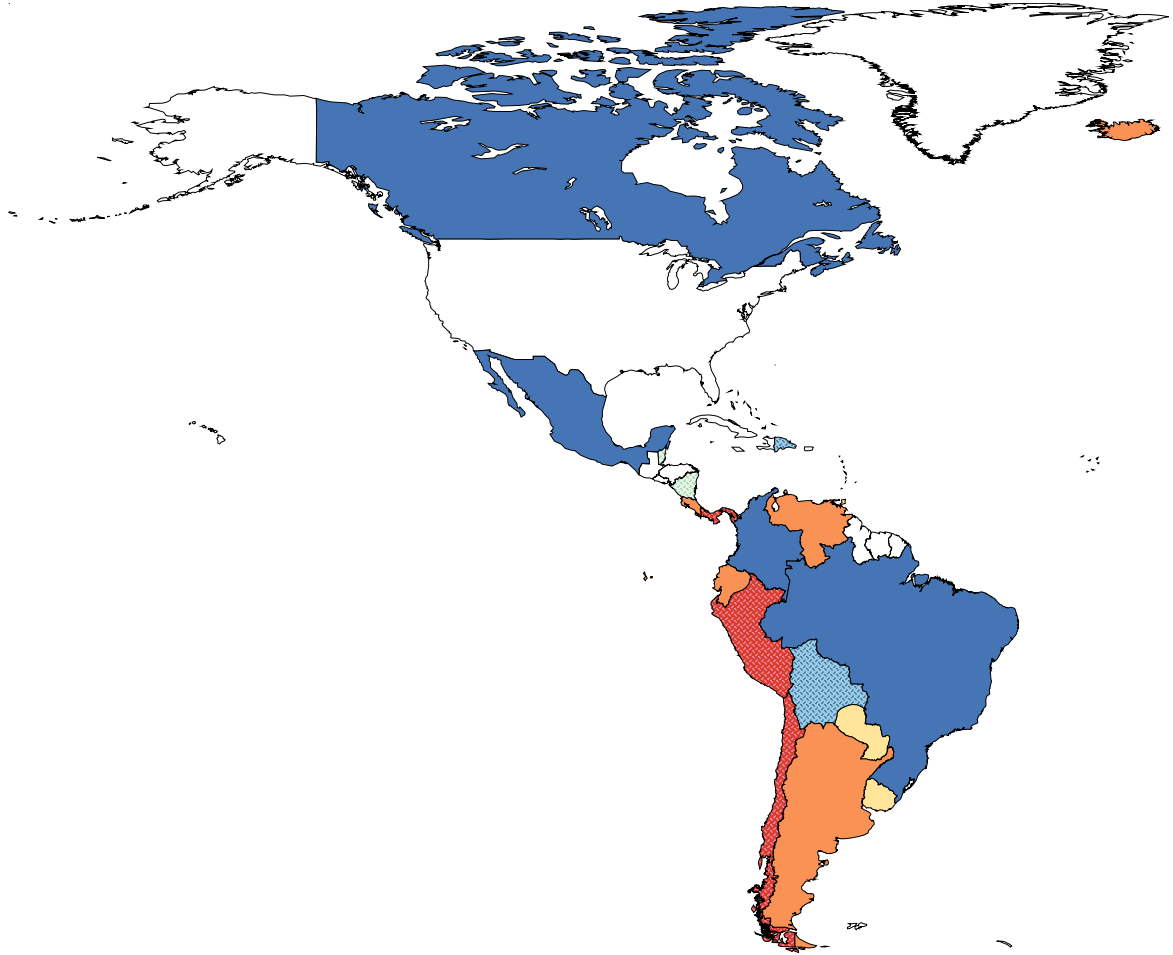
International Enrollment Trends 2000 - 2014

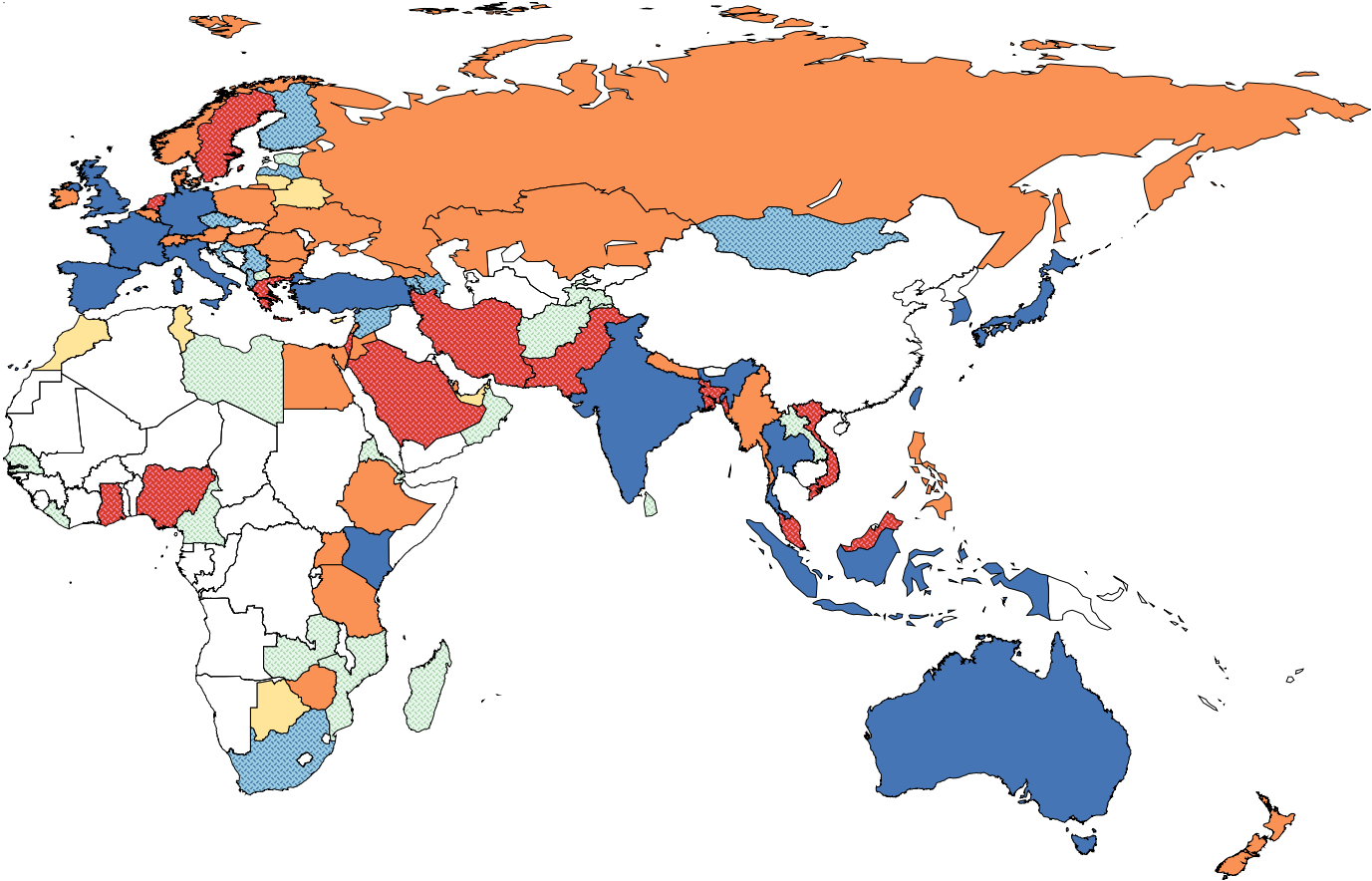

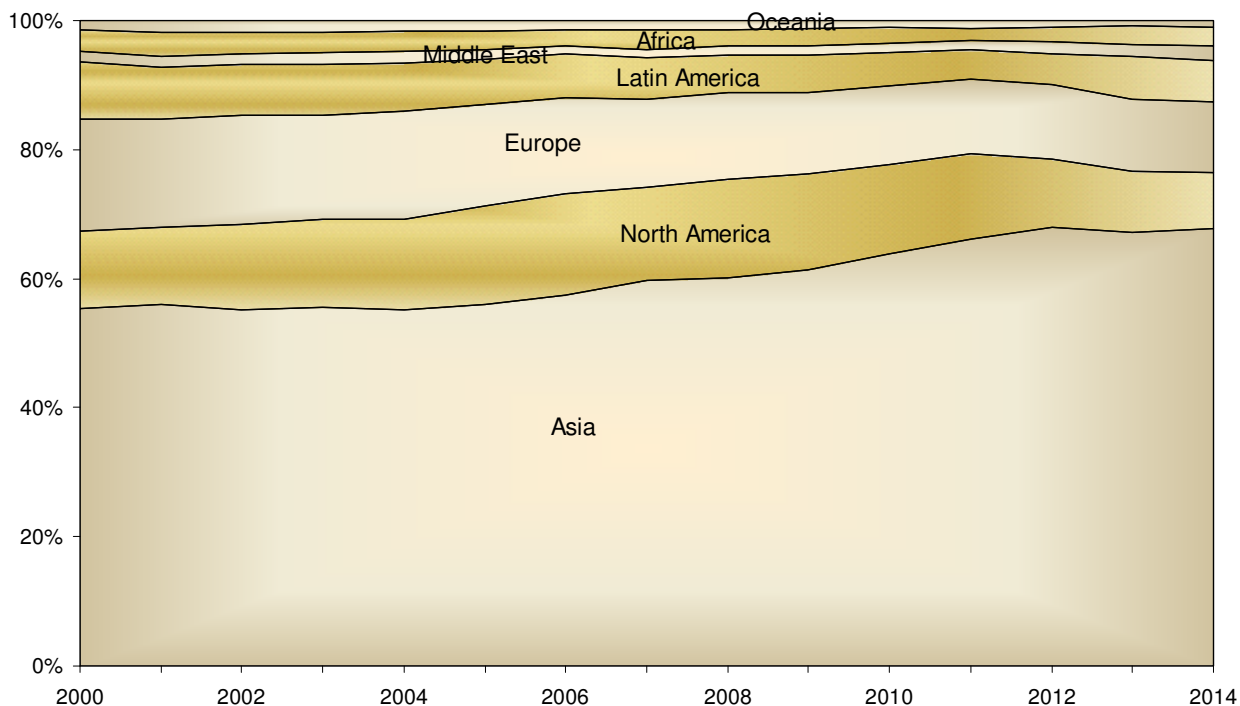

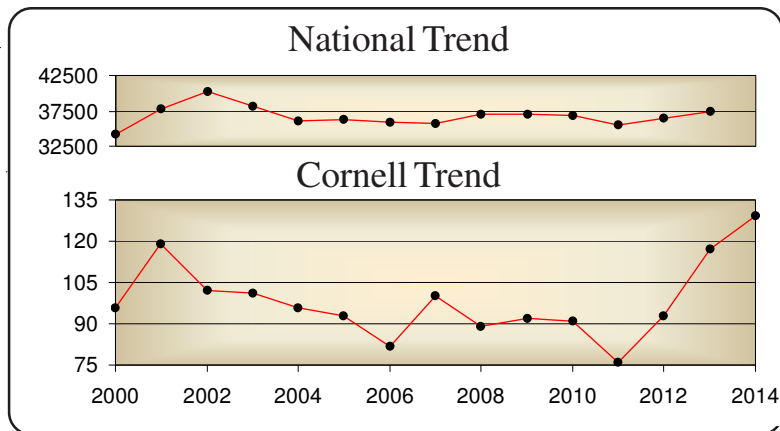
Regional Enrollment Trends 2000-2014



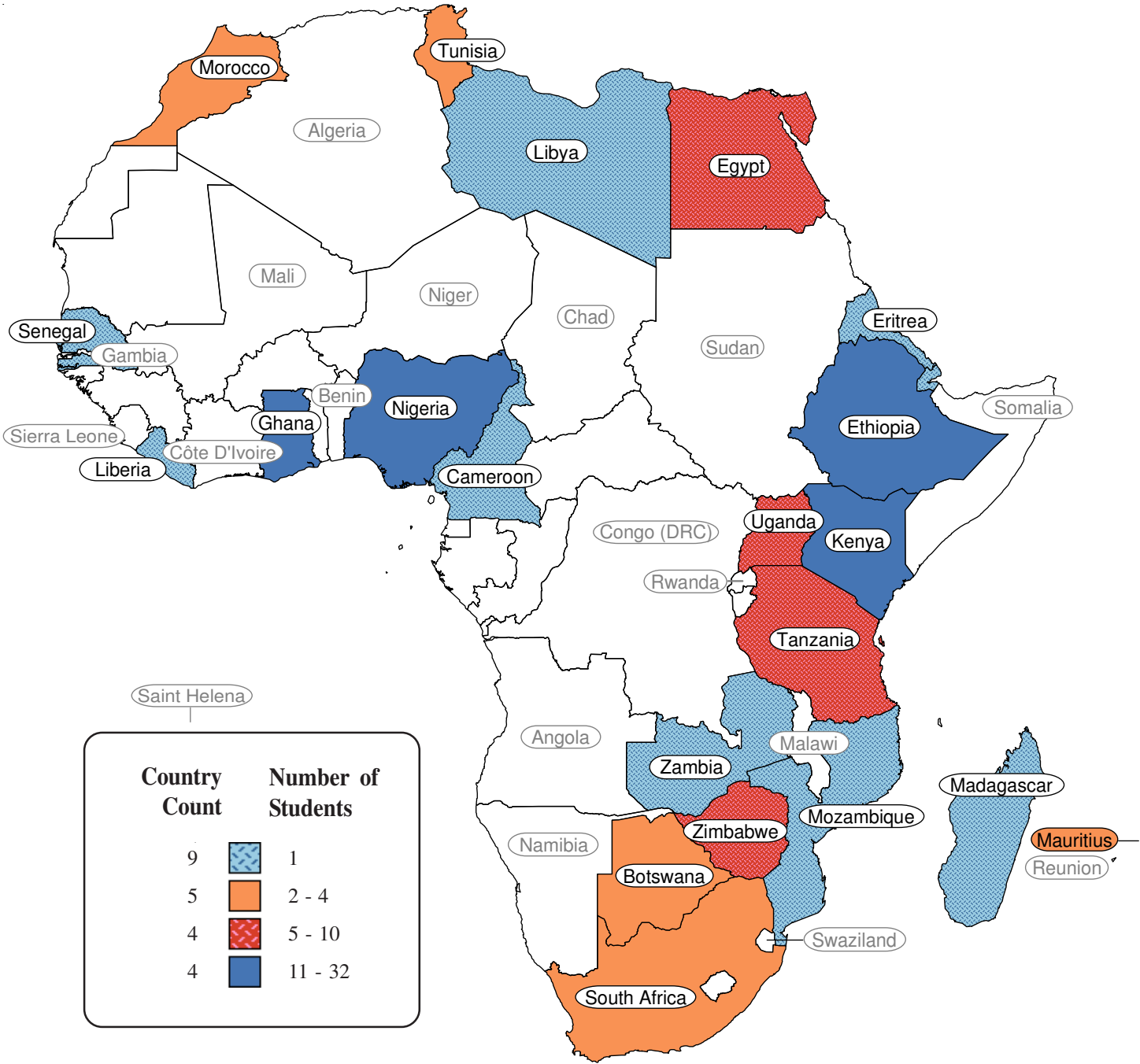
