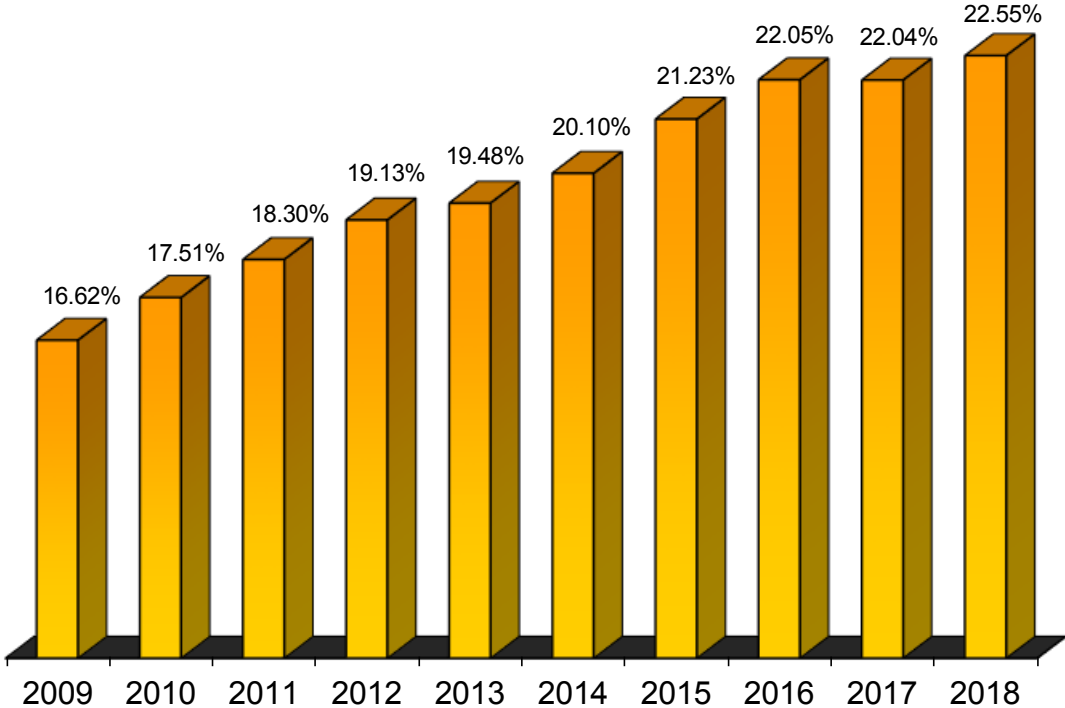




# International Students At Cornell University



## International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment



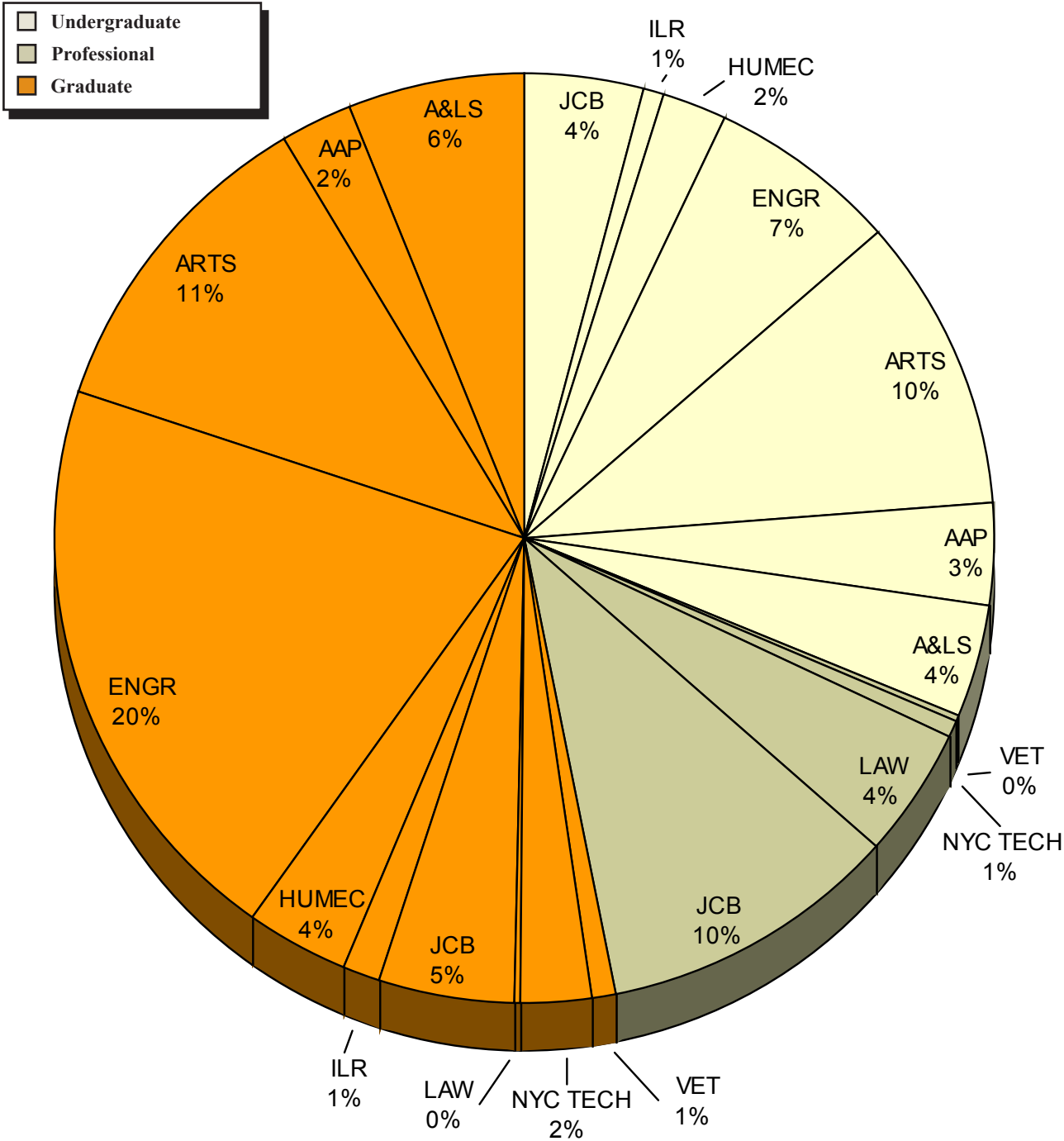

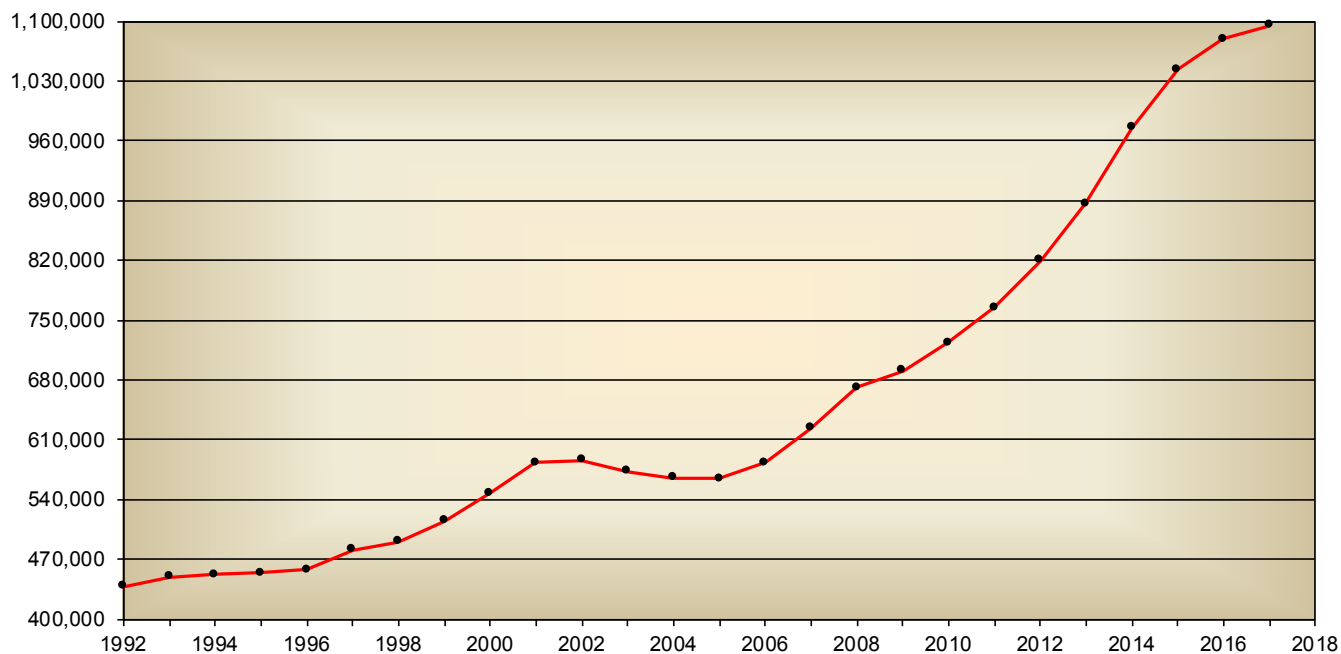

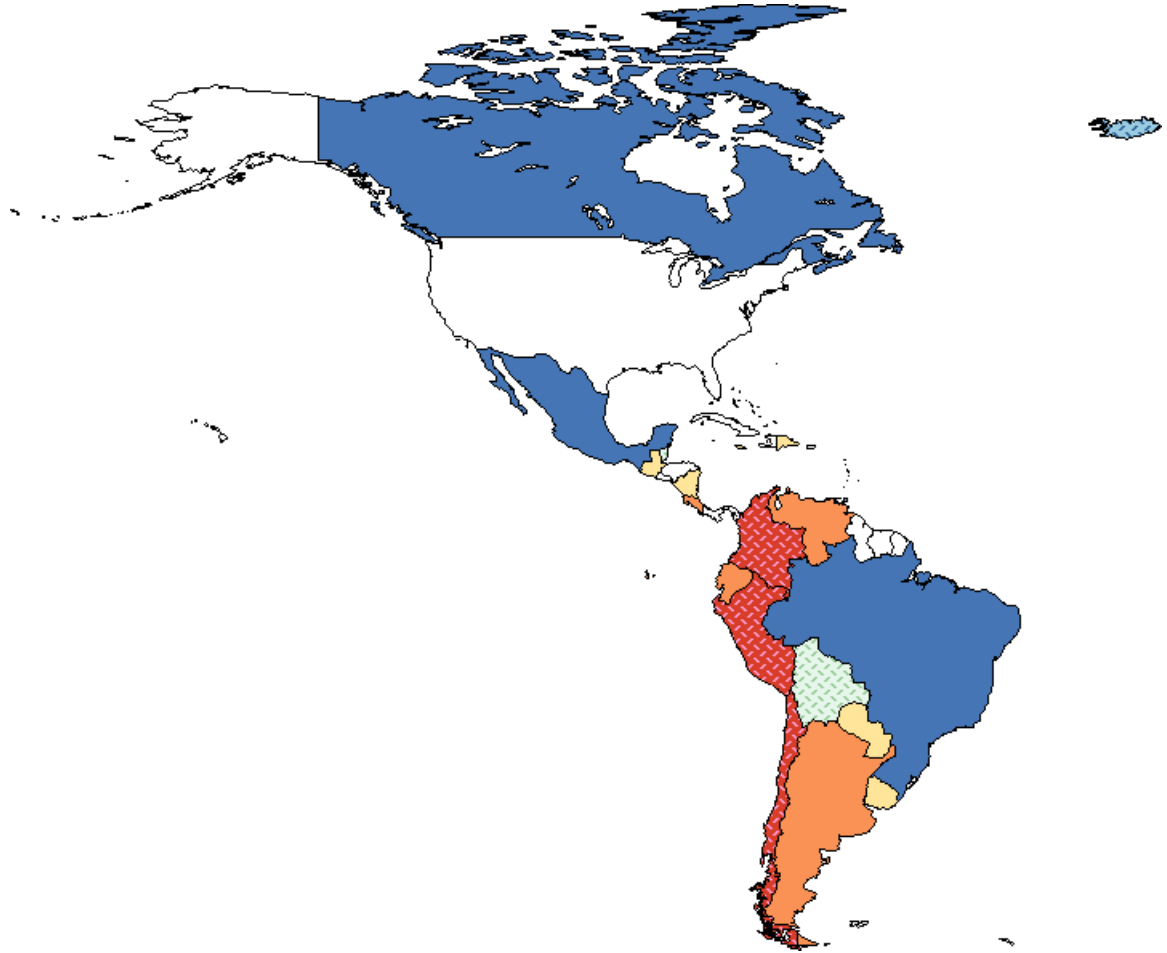
# International Enrollment Trends 1992 - 2018

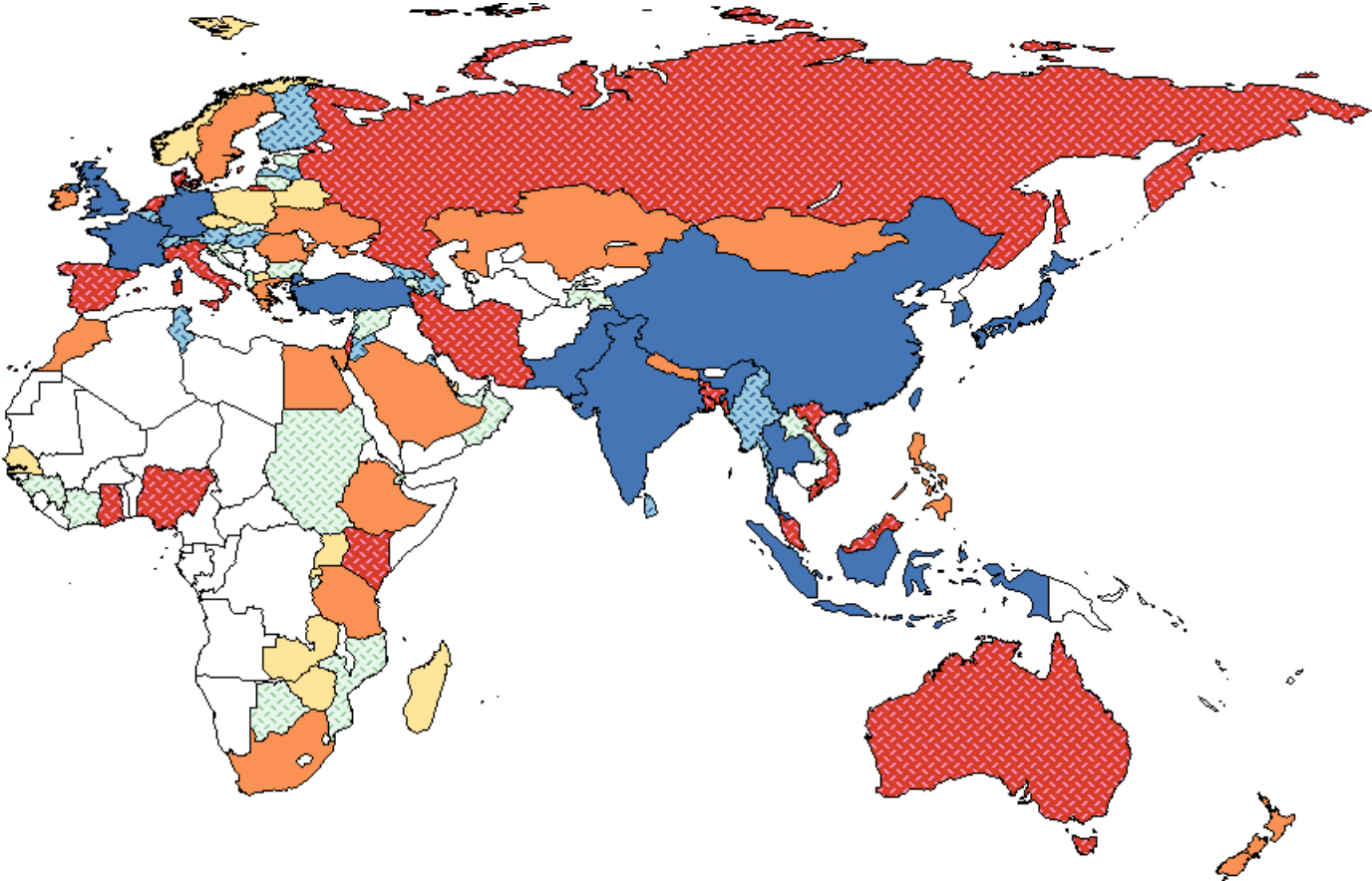

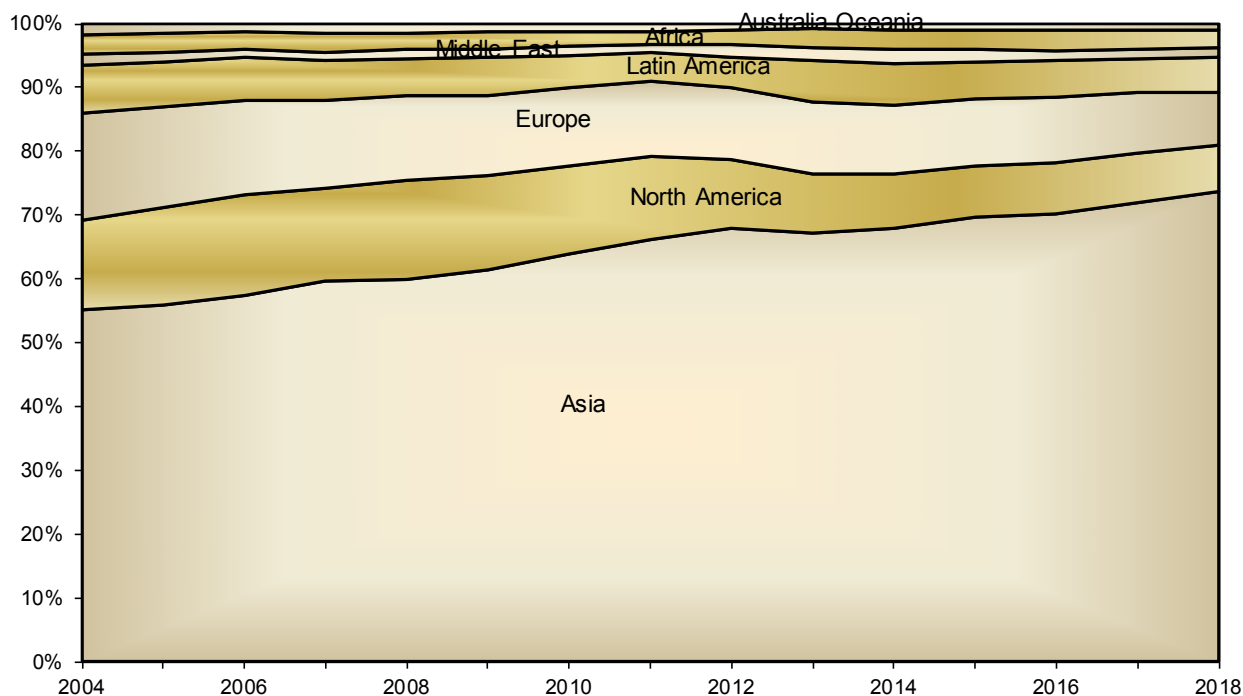

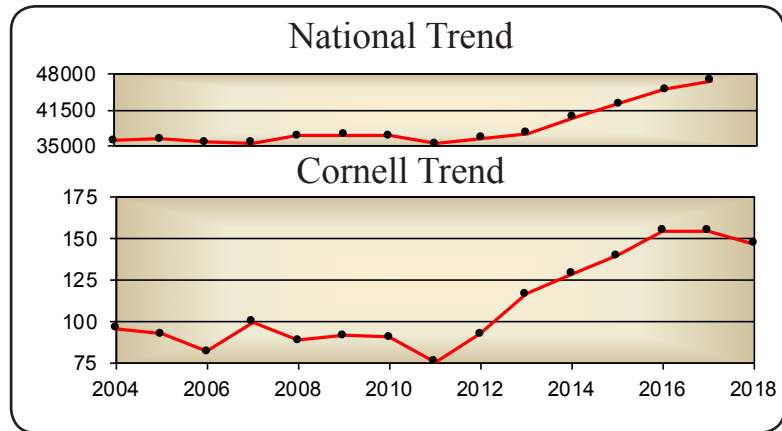
## Regional Enrollment Trends 2004-2018



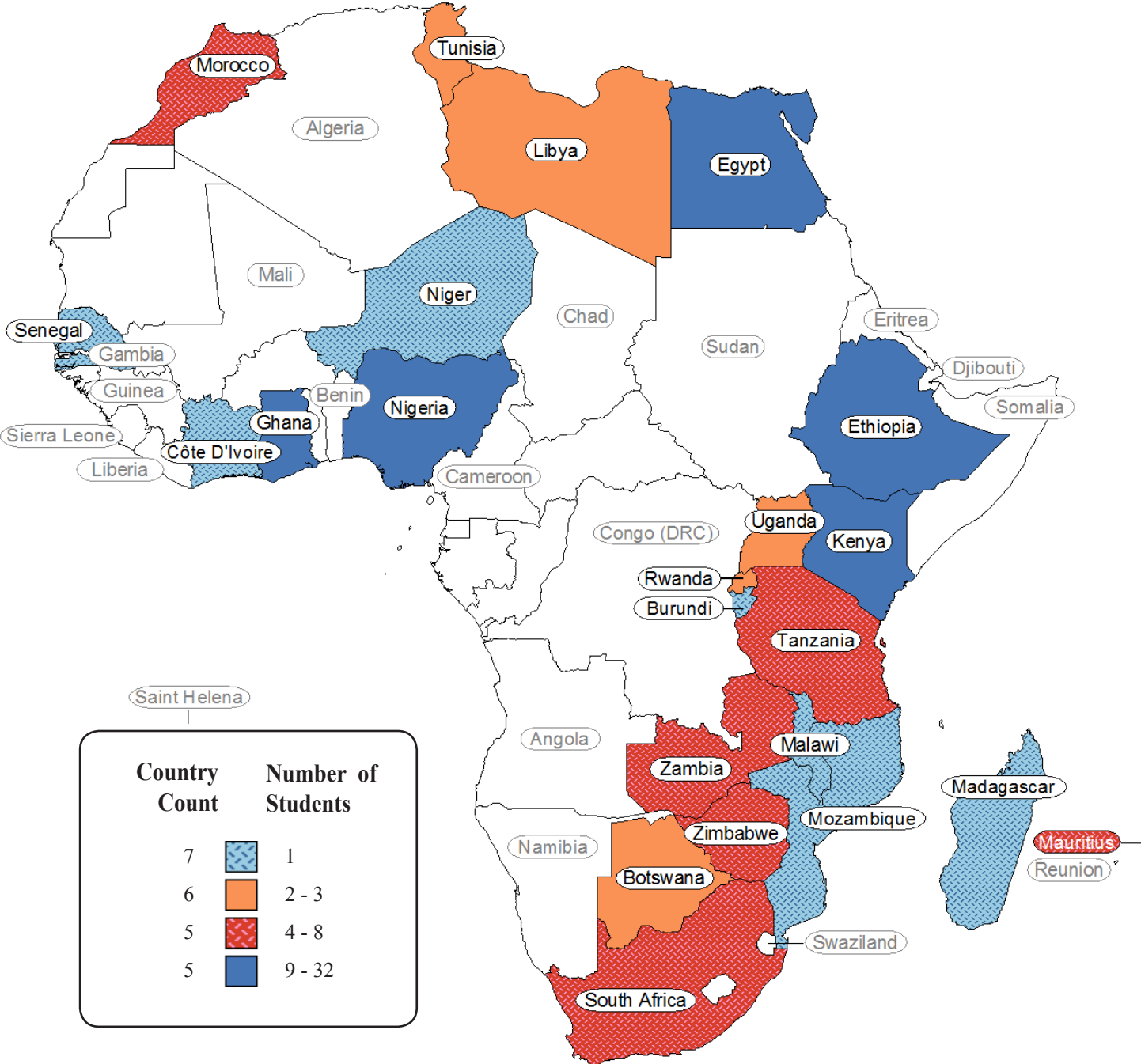

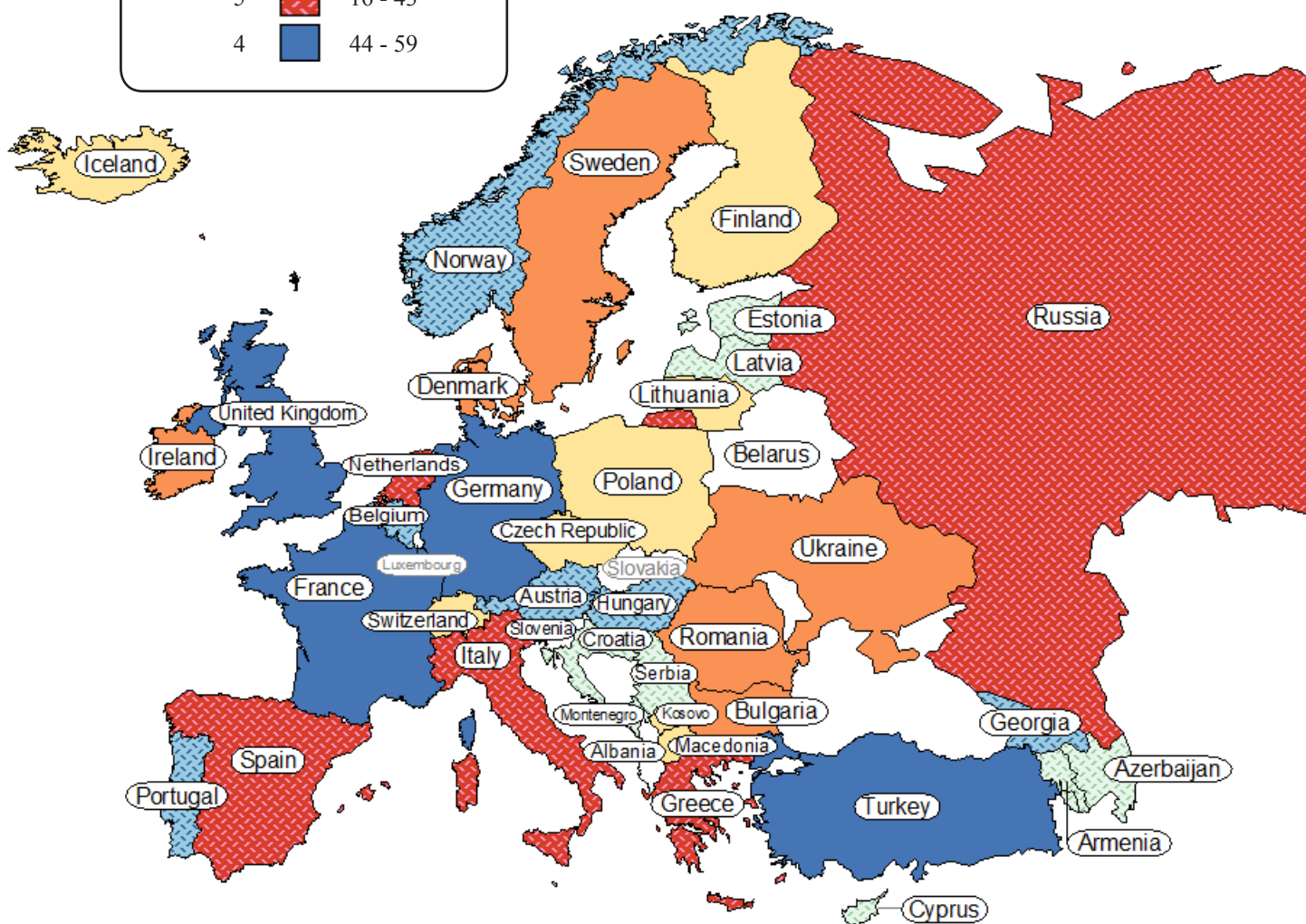
