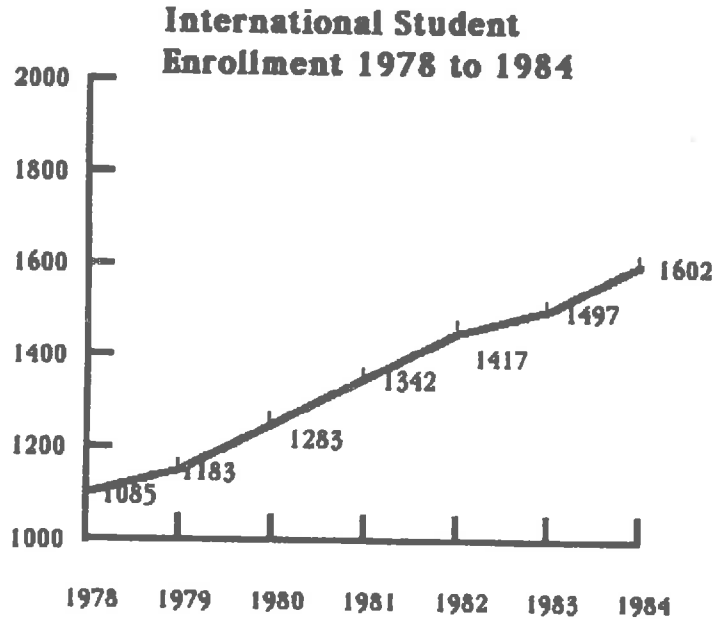

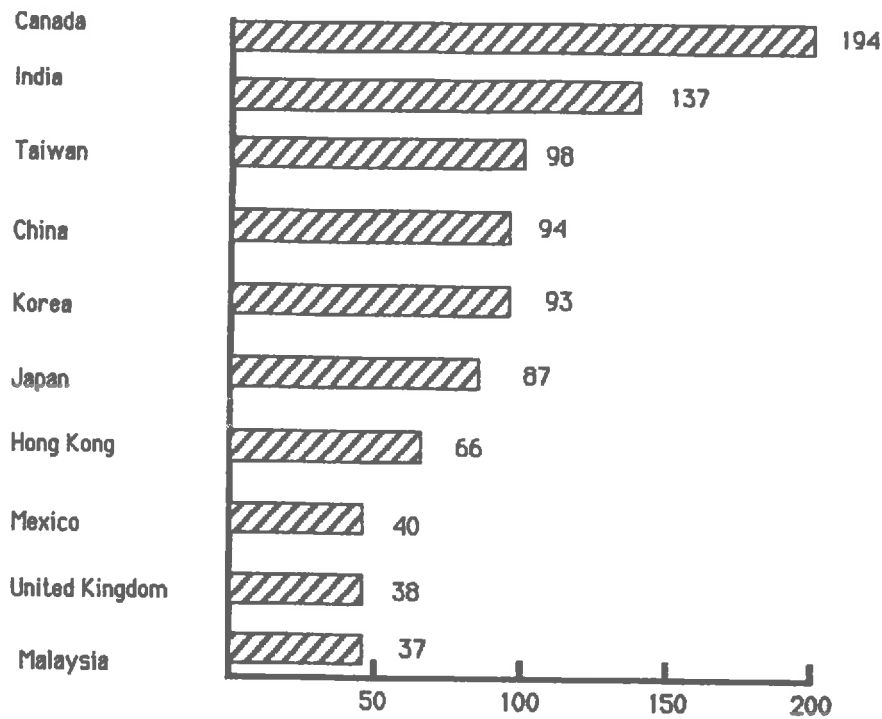

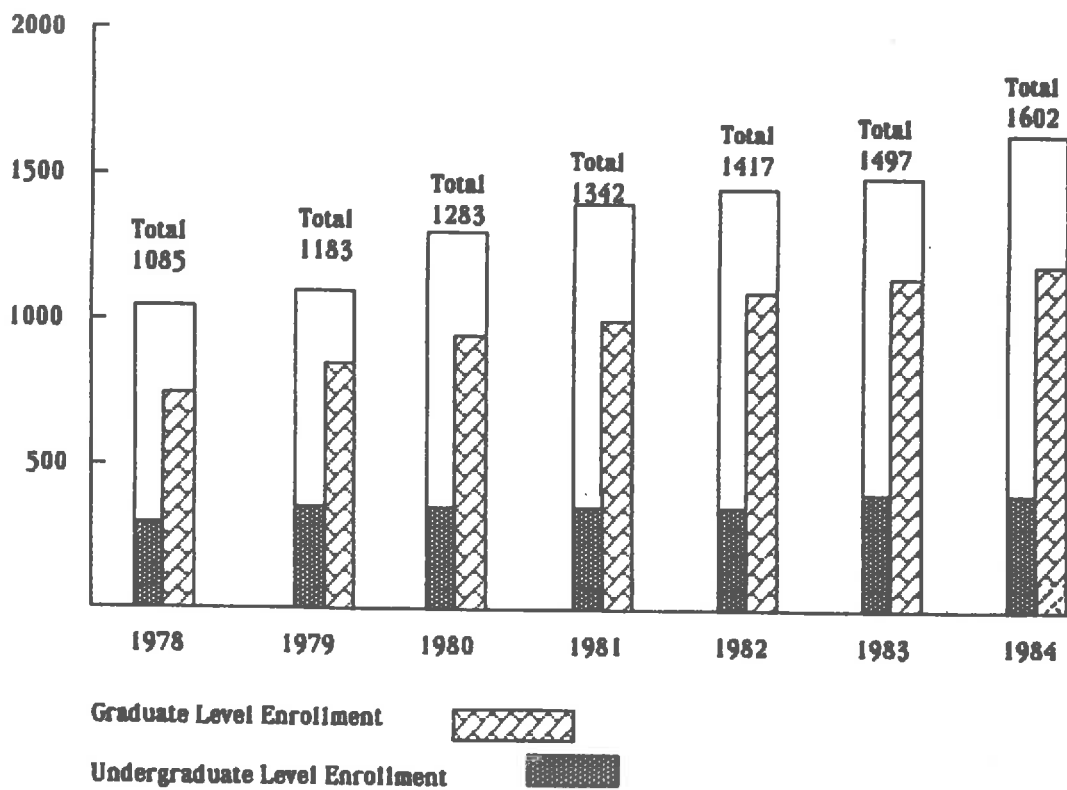

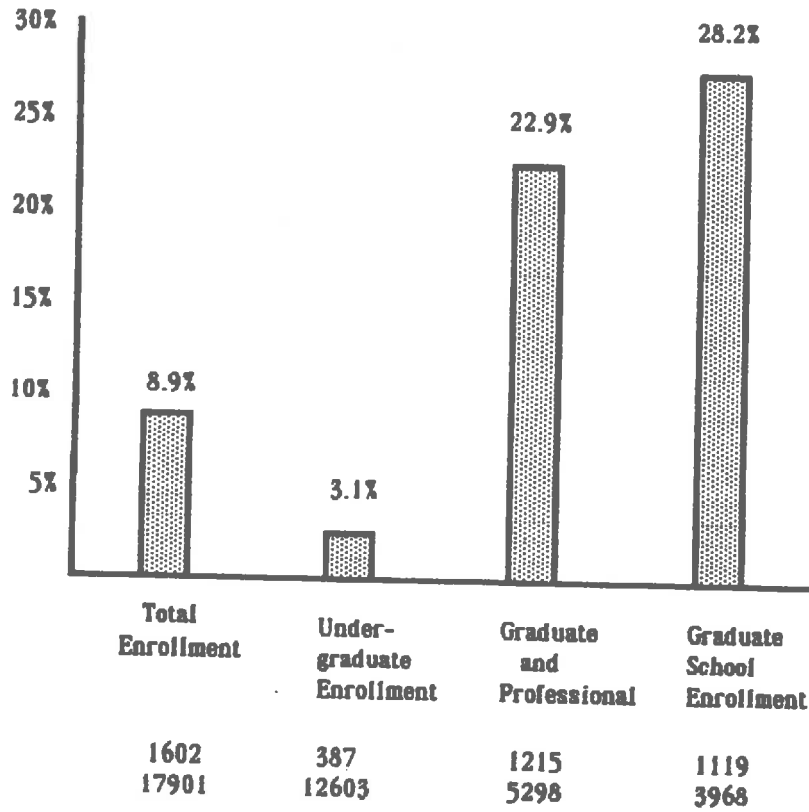
Largest Geographic Representation
