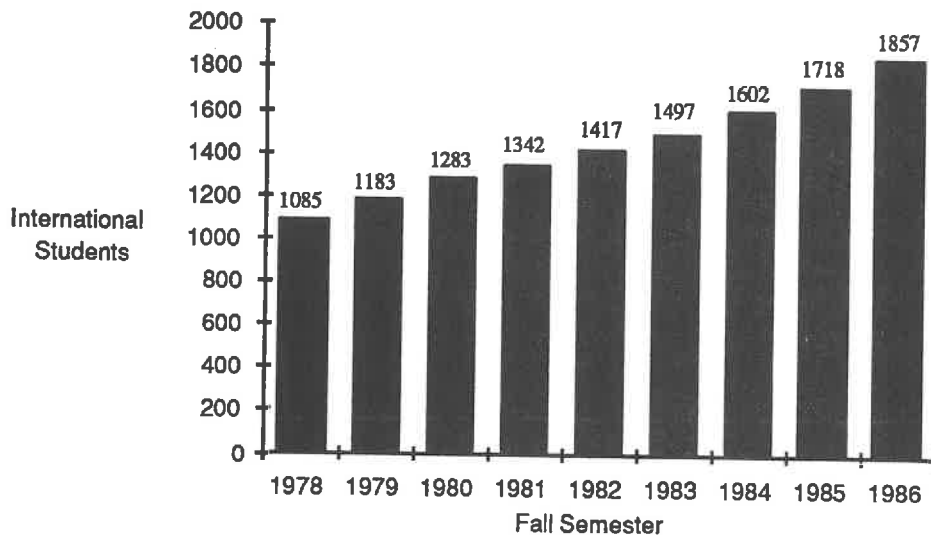

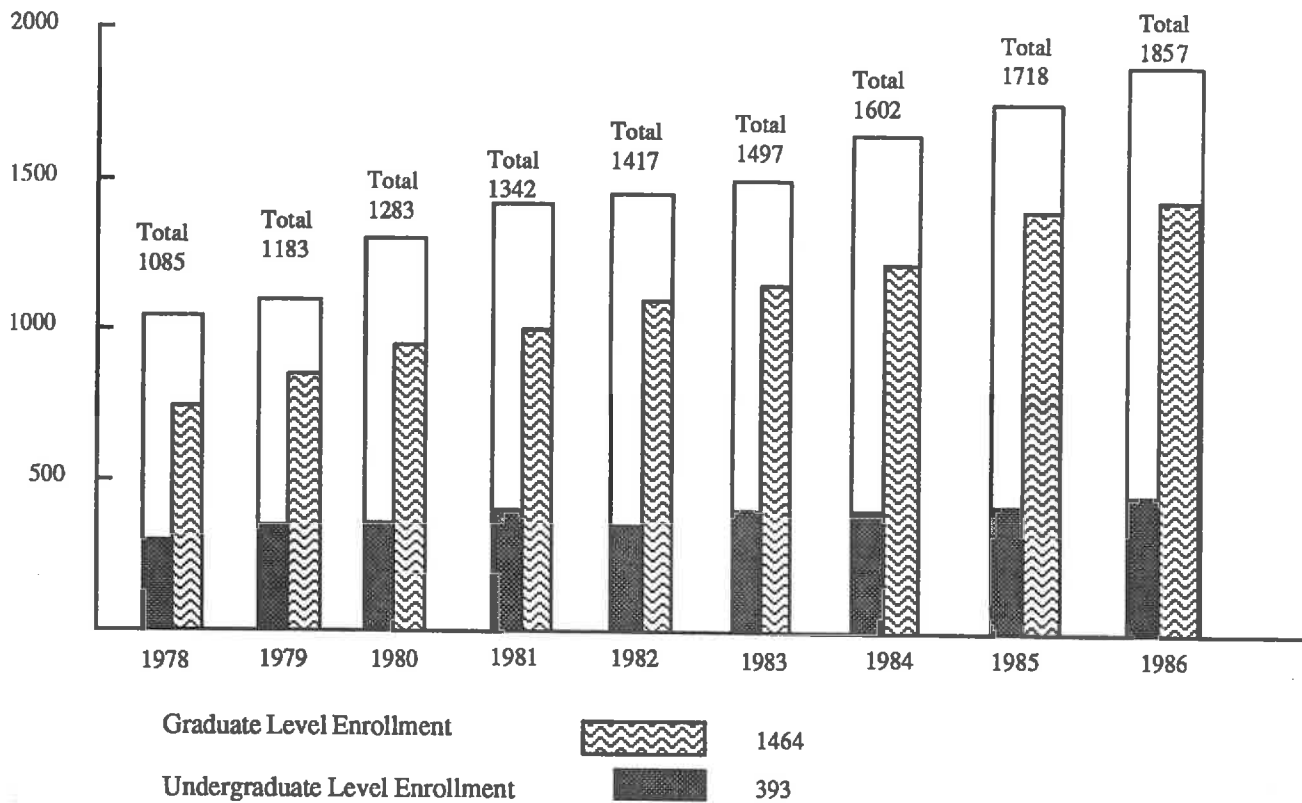
**International Student Enrollment  
(1978 to 1986)**



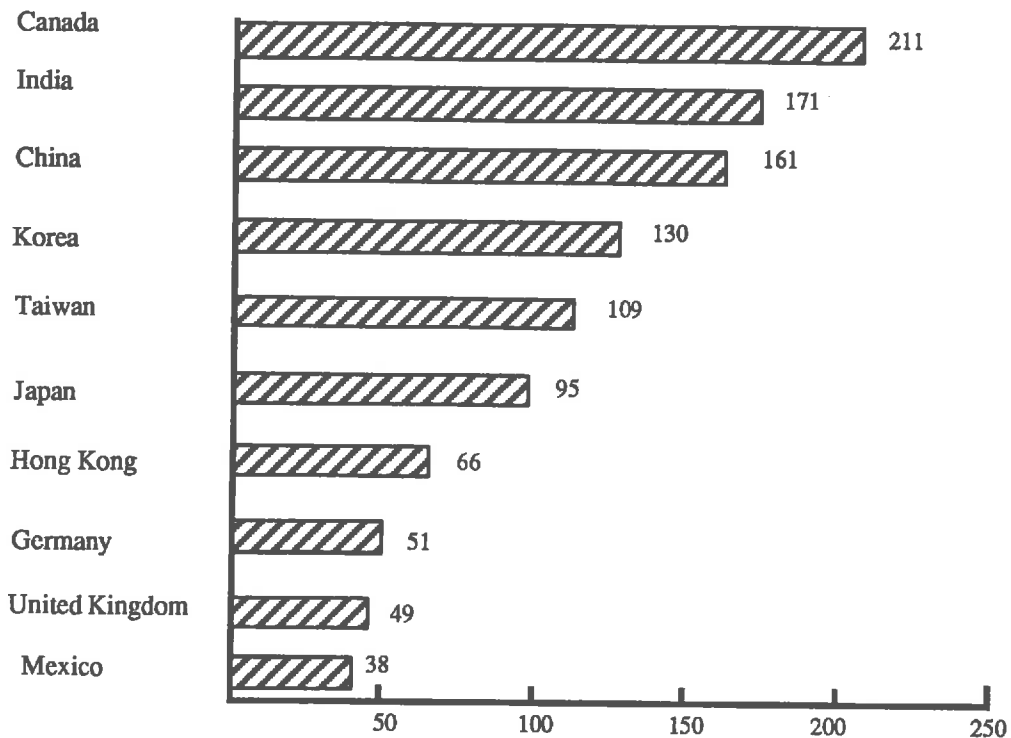

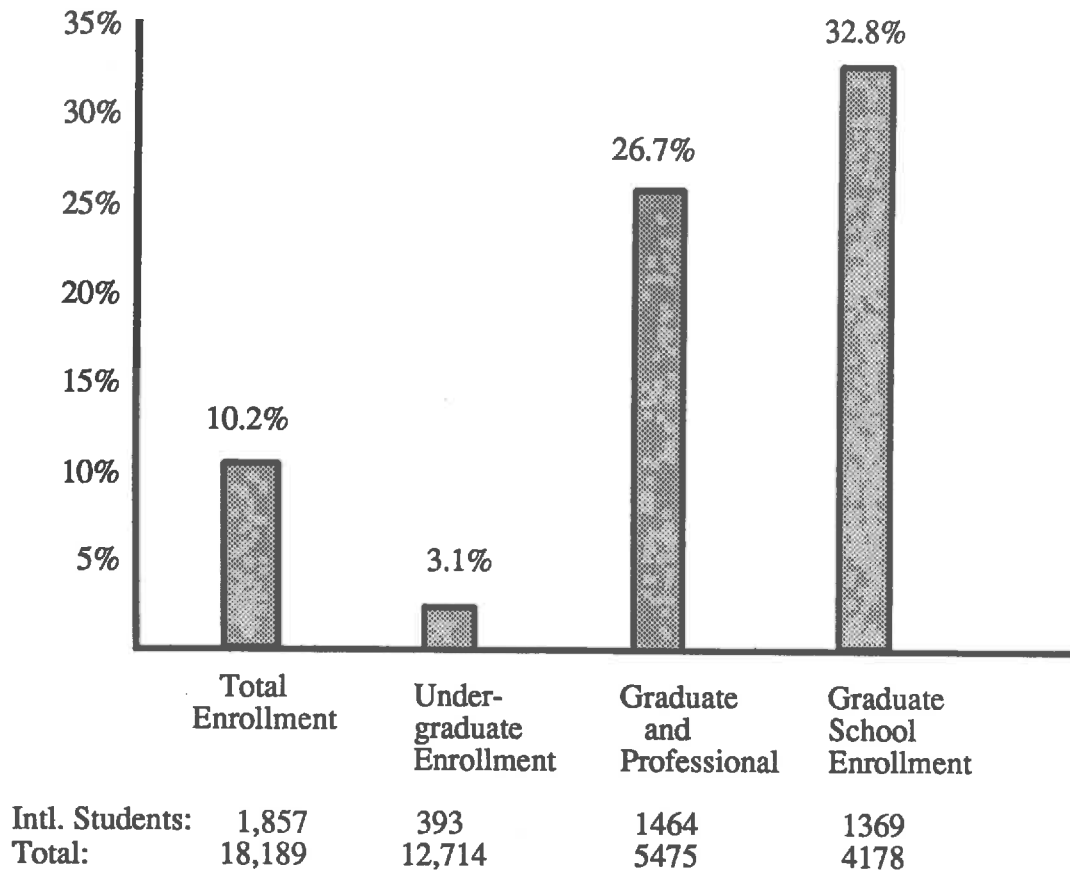
### Graduate Level-Undergraduate Enrollment
