

## Introduction

Wikidata serves as a central knowledge base for Wikimedia projects. Academic libraries have been slow to capitalize upon Wikidata's potential to promote scholarly communication. A pilot project to enhance visibility of a research institute was undertaken as part of *Join the open data movement: a beginner Wikidata course*, Oct – Dec, 2019 .

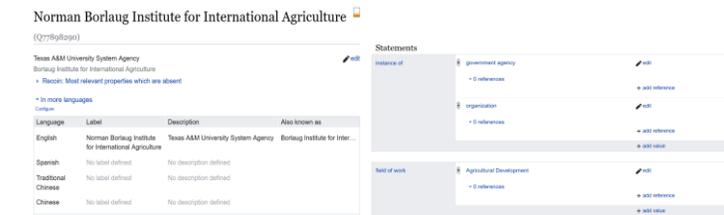

**Fig. 1** Norman Borlaug Institute for International Agriculture (Q77898290) in Wikidata

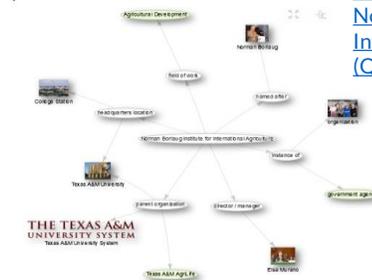


## Querying Scholia
