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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE YONKERS BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE YONKERS FEDERATION OF TEACHERS, AFT/NEA

It is hereby agreed that the collective bargaining agreement between the Yonkers Board of Education and the Yonkers Federation of Teachers dated July 1, 2003 – June 30, 2007 is amended as follows:

- Article 29 Duration of the Agreement is amended to provide for new effective dates beginning as of July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2011.
- 2. Article 6 Salaries is amended to provide for the following increases:
 - Effective July 1, 2007, a 2% Increase on base for all categories, steps, lanes, activities and increments (other than ETT/TSA).
 - Effective February 1, 2008, a 2% increase on base for all categories, steps, lanes, activities and increments (other than EIT/TSA).
 - Effective July 1, 2008, a 2.5% Increase on base for all categories, steps, lanes, activities and Increments (other than EIT/TSA).
 - Effective February 1, 2009, a 2.5% Increase on base for all categories, steps, lanes, activities and increments (other than EIT/TSA).
 - Effective July 1, 2009, a 3% increase on base for all categories, steps, lanes, activities, and increments (other than EIT/TSA).
 - Effective July 1, 2009, step one salary amount in all lanes will be eliminated. All other step increments, including longevity increments, shall be advanced to the preceding step on the Schedule. Step 36 will be eliminated.
 - Effective July 1, 2010, a 3% increase on base for all categories, steps, lanes, activities and increments (other than EIT/TSA).

Salary grids shall be as annexed hereto.

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3. <u>Article 9A</u> – <u>Welfare Fund</u> is amended by changing the Board contributions as follows:

Year	Contribution
2007-2008	\$1753.
2008-2009	\$1806.
2009-2010	\$1860.
2010-2011	\$1916 .

4. <u>Article 9B</u> – <u>Hospitalization and Medical Coverage</u> is amended to read as follows:

1. Cost of Coverage

The Board agrees to pay full hospitalization based on the Empire Plan for all employees hired prior to July 1, 2007 as individuals or as individuals with dependents. Effective July 1, 2009 and thereafter, the Board shall deduct a dollar amount equal to 5% of the then current premium cost from such employees' regular paychecks, subject to a cap of \$500 for Individual coverage and \$1000 for Individuals with dependents.

For all YFT bargaining unit members hired on or after July 1, 2007, the Board shall pay 92% of the premium cost for individuals or individuals with dependents plans and the employee shall pay the remaining 8% through regular payroll deductions. The contribution for such employees shall be capped for the years beginning July 1, 2009 and July 1, 2010 at 8% of the then current premium cost or 10% of the 2008 premium cost, whichever is the lesser amount.

For those employees enrolled in other than The Empire Plan, the Board agrees to pay the portion of the cost that would ordinarily apply to the Empire Plan.

2. Buy Out Option for Eligible Employees

Members of the unit who are eligible and enrolled in the District's health insurance plan and who withdraw from the District's plan shall receive \$2500 for an individual plan or \$5000 for an individual with dependents plan provided that they remain

eligible and uncovered for a period of twelve consecutive months. Such payment shall be made at the end of the twelve month period and annually thereafter, provided such teacher is still eligible and uncovered by the District's plan. Nothing contained herein shall preclude an eligible member from re-entering the plan at any time provided, however, that in the case of a member who re-enters in less than twelve months, or on a date prior to an annual payment, no payment shall be made.

3. Coverage Under Another Plan

Effective November 1, 2001, new hires shall not be eligible for health insurance coverage by the District if they are eligible for substantially equivalent coverage under another plan. New hires who may have to pay to participate in such plan are still deemed eligible to participate and will not be covered by the District's plan.

Upon submission of satisfactory proof that such contributions are required, such unit members shall be entitled to an annual payment while such contributions are still required. The amount of such payment shall be equal to the actual cost to the spouse, but shall not exceed 50% of the District's cost for family coverage.

Should an individual lose eligibility for substantially equivalent coverage under such plan, the Board will allow for participation in the District plan as soon as possible.

Members of the unit shall truthfully advise the District of their eligibility for health insurance under other plans.

After completing ten years of employment by the District, employees who are ineligible under this provision shall become eligible for coverage by the District. Such employees shall also become eligible for the buy out option described above.

4. Board to Share Information

It will be the responsibility of the Board of Education to provide the YFT with updated information on insurance premium costs as they occur. Additionally, the Board of Education will provide the YFT with the dollar amounts to be paid by YFT members each time premium costs change. Insurance payments shall be changed only on an annual basis.

- 5. <u>A new Article 26</u> <u>Occupational and Physical Therapists</u>, in the Form annexed to this memorandum shall be added to the collective bargaining agreement between the parties.
- 6. Except as specifically amended by this Agreement, all other terms and conditions of the collective bargaining agreement dated June 1, 2003 June 30, 2007 shall remain in full force and effect, and shall be incorporated into any revised Agreement.
- 7. This Agreement is subject to ratification by the membership of the Yonkers Federation of Teachers and the Yonkers Board of Education.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE YONKERS BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE YONKERS FEDERATION OF TEACHERS, AFT

It is hereby agreed that the collective bargaining agreement between the Yonkers Board of Education and the Yonkers Federation of Teachers, as amended by agreement dated May 31, 2006, is further amended as follows:

1. A new Article 26 is added to the contract to read as follows herein. The contract paragraphs currently numbered from 26 through the end of the contract shall be renumbered.

Article 26 - Occupational and Physical Therapists

A. Working Conditions:

- 1. Occupational and physical therapists shall be required to work all days that teachers are required to work.
- 2. The occupational and physical therapists' work day shall be the same as the teachers' work day at the building to which he/she is assigned.
 - a. The occupational and physical therapists shall have a duty free lunch period.
 - b. Occupational and physical therapists shall prepare all reports and documentation required by the Board of Education and /or applicable rules and regulations, and shall be given adequate time during the workday to prepare such reports and documents.

B. Evaluation and Protection:

1. Observations:

a. There shall be a minimum of two (2) formal observations during an occupational or physical therapist's first full year of employment. Such observations shall take place no later than December and April of that school year. During subsequent years, there shall be a minimum of one (1) formal observation each year.

- b. Within three-four (3 to 4) weeks the occupational or physical therapists shall receive a written report of the observation. The occupational or physical therapists shall have the right to have, upon request to the Administrator, a conference regarding the report within a reasonable period of time and/or make comments on the report to be placed in the personnel file.
- c. For occupational and physical therapists, an evaluation, observation or walk through may be conducted at any time by the Principal or Central Office Administrator.

2. Annual Evaluations:

All occupational and physical therapists, provisional and permanent, shall receive, on the appropriate Board form, an annual written rating of "satisfactory" or "unsatisfactory".

3. Occupational/Physical Therapists Protection:

All occupational and physical therapists are covered under Civil Service Law.

C. Personnel Files:

Evaluations and all other items from within the school system shall be open to the occupational and physical therapist's review. Individual occupational and physical therapists shall have the right to review their Personnel files, upon appointment with the Personnel Department, and in the presence of the administrator responsible for such files, or his/her designee. Occupational and physical therapists may also review all past, non-confidential materials in their personnel files whether in the central office or any school building, in the same manner. They shall have the right to obtain copies upon request, provided that such action does not interfere with the normal business of the school or office.

D. Applicable Teacher Contract Provisions:

The following provisions in the teacher contract shall apply to occupational and physical therapists.

Article 12. - Leaves of Absence - Sections: A,B,D,G (1 to 7 & 10) H

Article 13. - Grievance Procedure

Article 17. - Payroll Deductions

Article 18. - Attendance, Retirement, and Termination Pay - Section A

Article 21. - Miscellaneous - Sections: C,E,I,J,O,Q

Article 22. - Committees - Section E as amended to include occupational and physical therapists.

Article 23. - Matters Not Covered

Article 24. - Management Rights

Article 27 - Conformity To Law - Savings Clause

Article 28 - Comparable Substitutions

Article 29 - No Strike Pledge

Article 30 - Taylor Law Section 204-A

Article 31 - Duration of Agreement

E. MISCELLANEOUS:

1. Child Care Leave

Any physical or occupational therapist who becomes or will become a parent either naturally or by adoption, and desires to apply for child care leave shall give notice to the Superintendent with a copy to his/her principal. Such notice shall be given, no less than sixty (60) days before that therapist intends to leave the classroom. Under extraordinary circumstances the notification may be reduced. This leave shall continue for a period of not more than one (1) year from the date of birth or adoption. All parental leaves can be terminated by the physical or occupational therapist at any time prior to the end of a requested leave in accordance with the notification procedures that follow. At the request of the physical or occupational therapist, the Board may extend the period of any parental leave or extension thereof to correspond with the beginning of the semester next following the expiration of the leave without the loss of any rights or privileges pertaining thereto. A physical or occupational therapist may request a second (2) year of child care leave and such request shall be considered at the sole discretion of the Superintendent.

Child Care leaves will be restricted as follows:

- the child care leave period ends at the child's first birthday.
- physical or occupational therapists who take child care leave but return to work before the end of their leave will forfeit the unused portion of leave, except that the Superintendent may, in his or her sole discretion grant an additional leave within the leave period.
- physical or occupational therapists who do not request a child care leave immediately after the birth of the child will be entitled to the time remaining in the child care leave.
- physical or occupational therapists on child care leave may not engage in full time employment.

Physical or occupational therapists shall not be guaranteed return to their original school or assignment. Where a comparable vacancy exists at the time of the therapists' return, the therapist shall be given an opportunity to request such a vacancy.

The returning physical or occupational therapist shall give notice, in writing, to the Office of Personnel not later than June 1 for the Spring term and not later than January 1 for the fall term. Such notice may be included in the letter of application for leave.

A physical or occupational therapist who suffers the death of a child for whom the therapist has received a child care leave, may, upon notification to the Office of Personnel, be returned to service on the first day of the semester following. Therapists are encouraged to give this notification at the earliest possible date.

For probationary therapists, the probationary period will be suspended with the commencement of the leave and will resume at the termination of the leave. Credit will be granted for all active service in the Yonkers Public Schools.

2. Welfare Fund:

Effective as of July 1, 2007, occupational and physical therapists shall receive the same contributions to the YFT Welfare Fund as is made for teachers under Article 9, Section A of the YFT/Board of Education Agreement.

3. Hospitalization and Medical Coverage:

Effective as of July 1, 2007, occupational and physical therapists shall be eligible for hospitalization and medical coverage and accident and health insurance under the same conditions as those provided for teachers in Article 9, Sections B. and C. of the YFT/Board of Education Agreement

4. Hourly Rate:

All hourly related duties for physical and occupational therapists shall be paid at the same rate that teachers receive.

5. Lunch Period:

Occupational and Physical Therapists may leave school premises during their assigned lunch time.

6. Personal Effects Security:

The Board shall provide every occupational and physical therapist with a mail box and convenient space for therapists to secure his/her coat and lock up other personal belongs.

7. Extended Leave for Personal Illness:

Covered under Civil Service Law, Section 72.

- 8. The following is to be added to Article 6, Section A (3) in the B.A. + 30 Category, effective July 1, 2006:
 - "Occupational and Physical Therapists who possess a Baccalaureate Degree"
- 9. The following is to be added to Article 6, Section A (3) in the M.A. + 30 Category, effective July 1, 2006:
 - "Occupational and Physical Therapists who possess a Master's Degree"
- F. Except as set forth in this Article 26 the remaining provisions of the Yonkers Federation of Teachers/Board of Education contract shall not apply to Physical and Occupational Therapists.
