In reply to yours of the 12th inst. I would state, that while not authorized to bind the Company, my impression is (of which indeed I have little doubt) its Directors would authorize the sale, and perfection of title to whatever land may be necessary for a Union Depot, and yard at Kansas City, to same Company organized for that purpose, at a reasonable figure, provided the rental this Company would be required to pay was comparatively reasonable, and first fixed.

With light now possessed of, my figure would be \$10,000 per acre.
