### FOREIGN STUDENT ENROLLMENT 1970-71

We are pleased to present a summary of the foreign student enrollment at Cornell University for the academic year 1970-71. A total of 1149 students from abroad are enrolled this year, a decrease of 72 over last year.

The decrease is due to the fact that beginning this year we are no longer counting students from abroad who hold permanent resident visas in the United States. There are 167 persons in this category registered with the University.

Foreign students, representing 89 countries, make up 7.7% of the total Cornell student population in Ithaca. Canadian students comprise the largest national group (219) followed by Chinese (144) and Indians (79).

Graduate foreign students number 848, a decrease of 48 over 1969-70. Our foreign graduate students make up 22.9% of the University Graduate School enrollment. Graduate level enrollment, including The Graduate School and the Schools of Aerospace Engineering, Business and Public Administration, Law and the Veterinary College is 19%.

The University has 301 undergraduate foreign students enrolled, a decrease of 24 over last year. They comprise 2.9% of the total undergraduate enrollment. Undergraduate schools and colleges with the highest percentage of foreign students are Hotel Administration 11.1%, Engineering 4.3%, and Agriculture 3.5%.

The distribution of foreign students by country and college and school is attached with a list of the graduate student enrollment by department.

We are also attaching some statistics on the national enrollment of foreign students compiled by the Institute of International Education for 1969-70 and reported in their annual publication OPEN DOORS.

### NATIONAL ENROLLMENT OF FOREIGN STUDENTS 1969-70

Total Foreign Students in the United States: 134,959 (an 11% increase over previous year)

Area Representation: The Far East continues to dominate area representation with 49,189 (36%), followed by Latin America 24,991 (19%), and Europe 18,524 (14%).

Where They Studied: at 1734 institutions (112 fewer than previous year) with 61% of the total number of students concentrated in 82 colleges and universities, each of which reported an enrollment of 400 or more foreign students

Three major universities with the greatest number of foreign students: New York University 4182 (9.4% of total enrollment) University of California, Berkeley 2904 (10.3% of total enrollment) Columbia University 2796 (11.6% of total enrollment)

Cornell ranked 16th in percentage of foreign students to total enrollment with 8.6%.
