ALBERT R. MANN LIBRARY Microcomputer Workshops

This summer Mann Library will continue its series of workshops in the applications of software to academic tasks. We will offer workshops in word processing and the searching of online databases.

Word Processing: We will examine "Word Perfect," a sophisticated word-processing package for the IBM PC that is available for use in the Microcomputer Center. No previous experience is required.

Searching Bibliographic Databases: This workshop provides an introduction to the searching of online bibliographic databases. A search allows you to combine concepts in order to quickly and effectively retrieve references from such databases as Biological Abstracts, Psychological Abstracts, ERIC, and Index Medicus. All participants can sign up for a half-hour search appointment that will allow you to conduct a search on your own topic. No previous experience with a computer is necessary.

The workshops on Searching Bibliographic Databases will be held in the Mann Library Online Classroom. The Word Processing workshops will be held in the Mann Library Microcomputer Center.

Both workshops are free, although there will be a charge if you wish to conduct your own online search after taking "Searching Bibliographic Databases." Mann Library provides all materials used in the workshops. The programs are open to Cornell undergraduates, graduate students, research staff, and faculty members. Since space is limited, you must register in advance by coming to the MicroCenter, located on the first floor of Mann Library, or by calling us at 255-3240.
