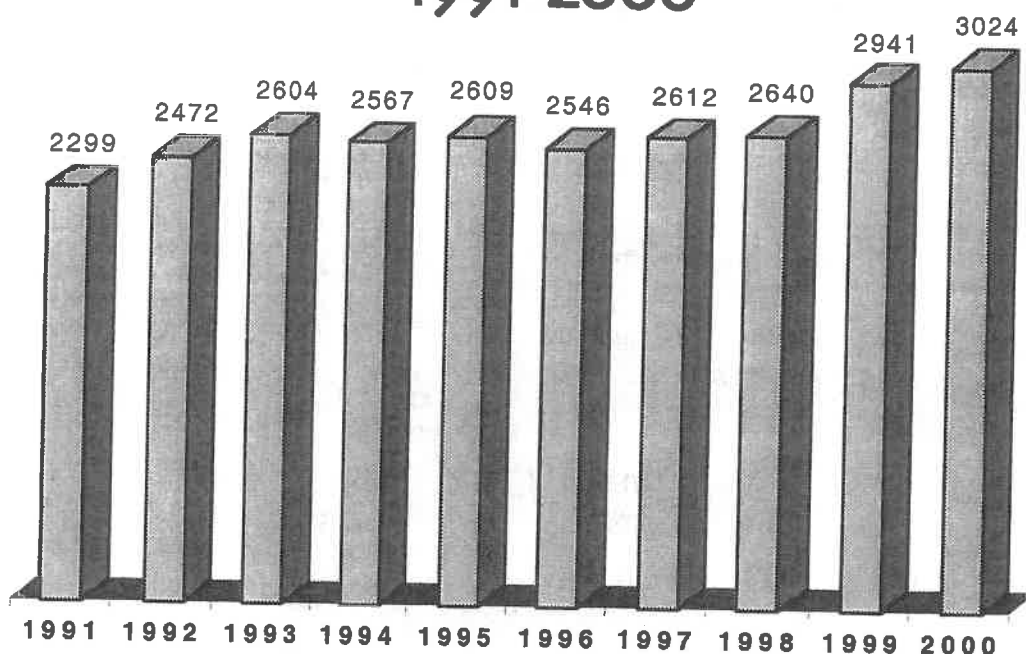

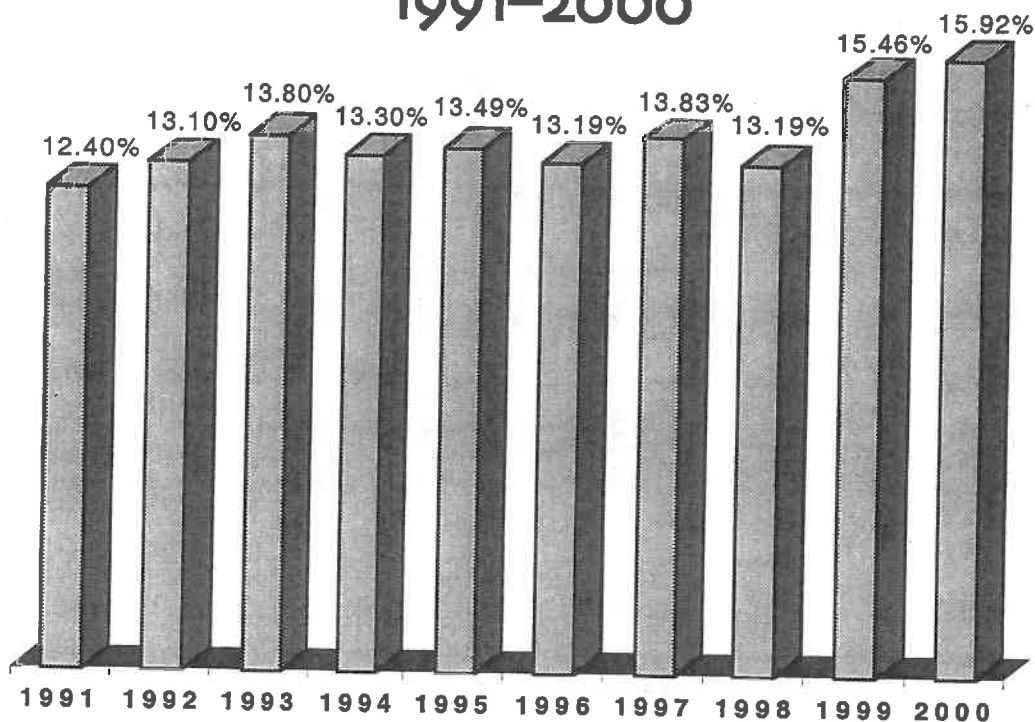

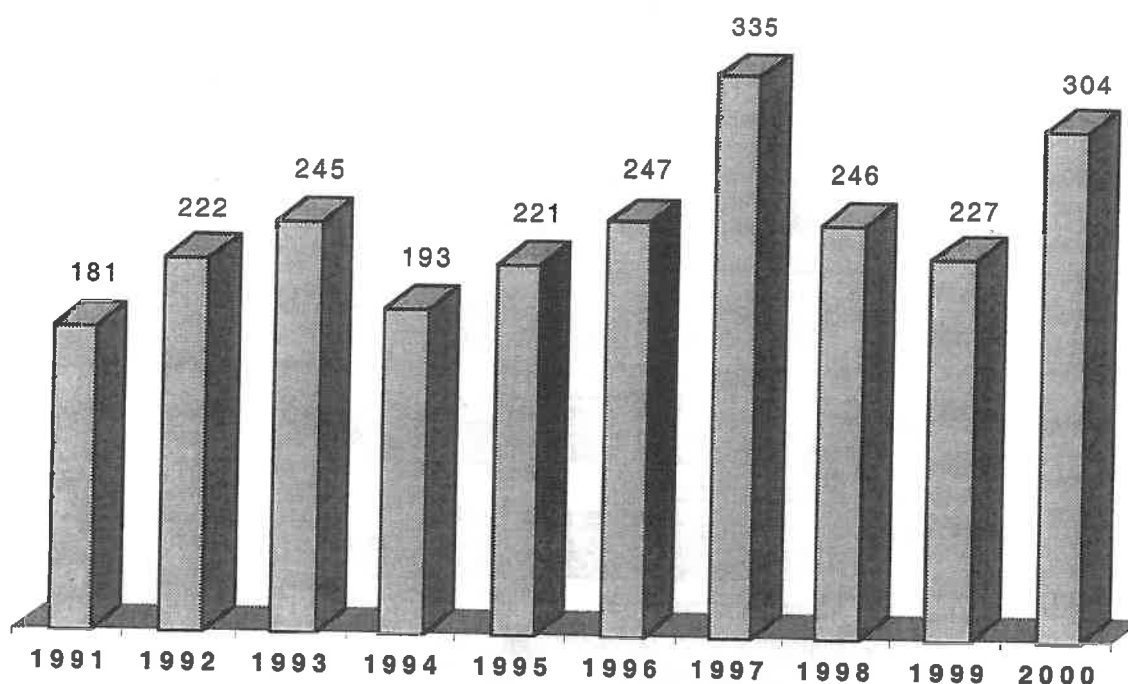

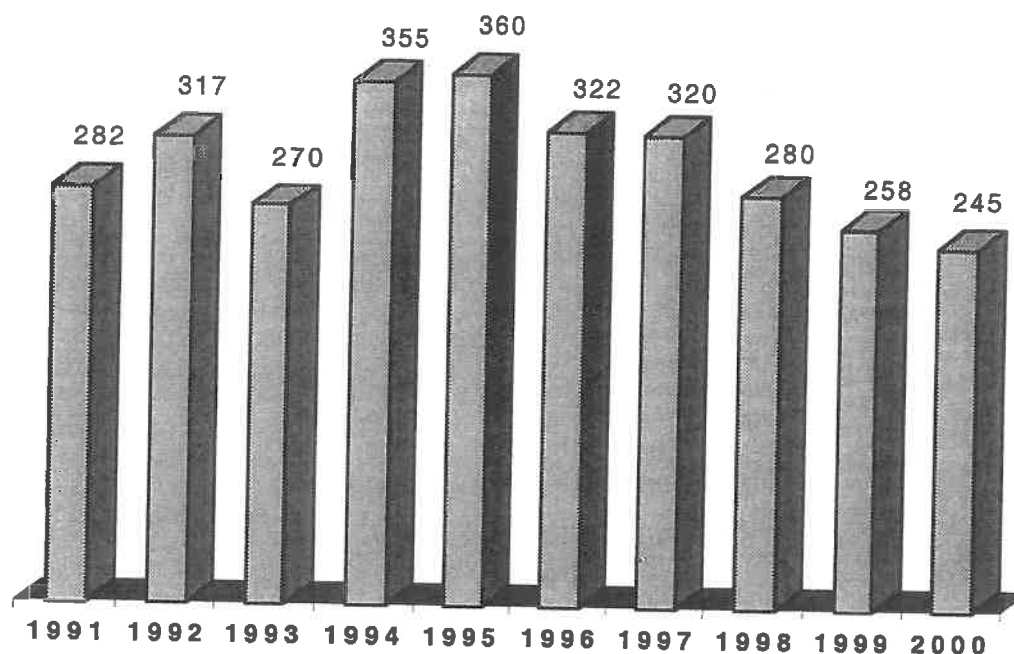
International Freshmen & Transfers 1991-2000

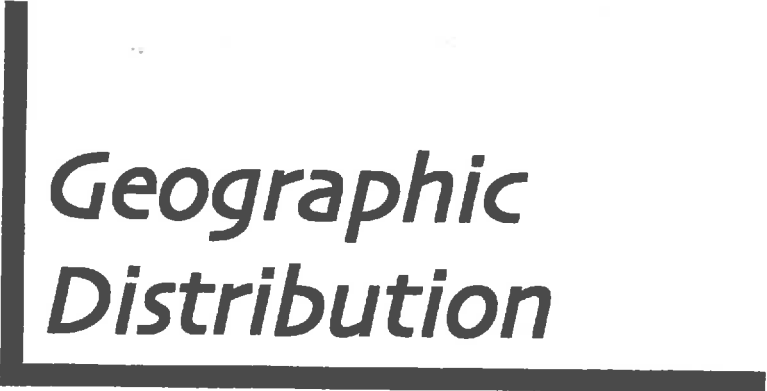

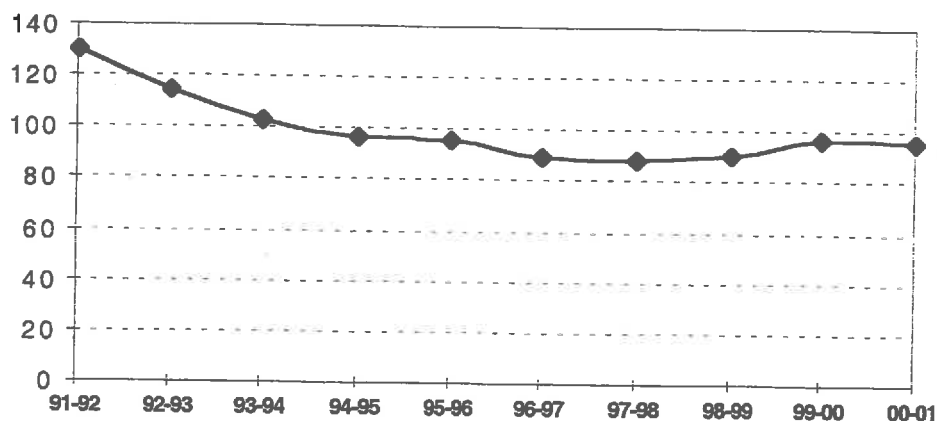

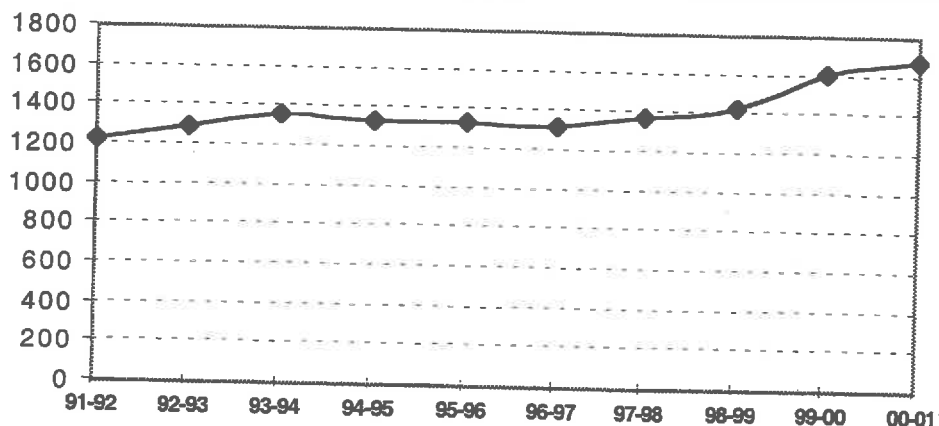

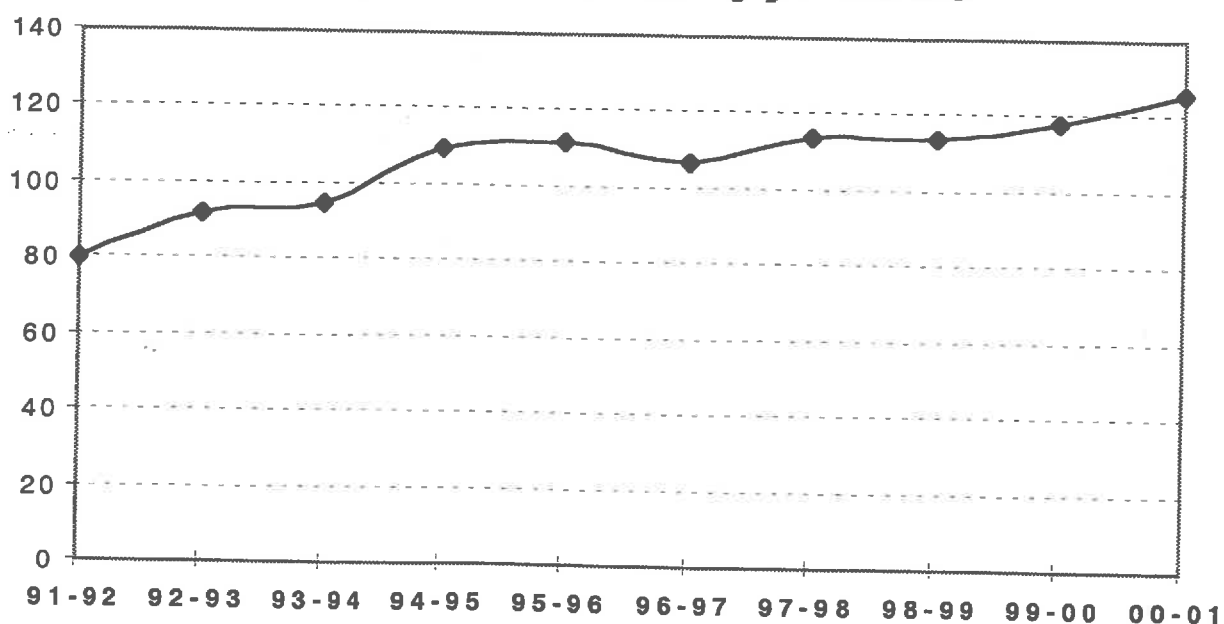

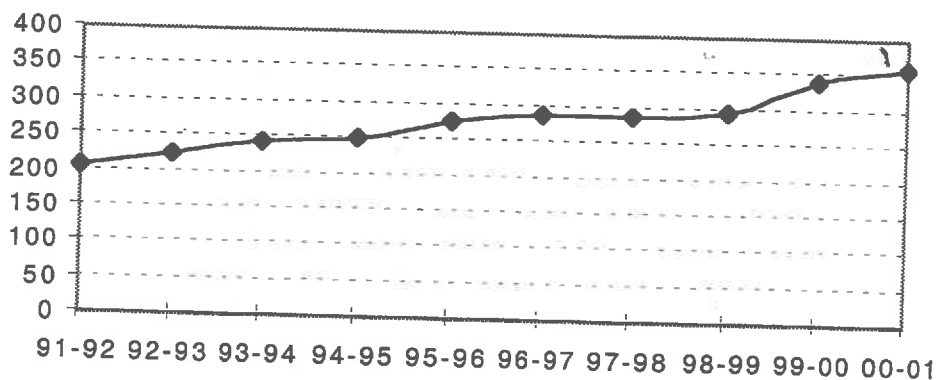

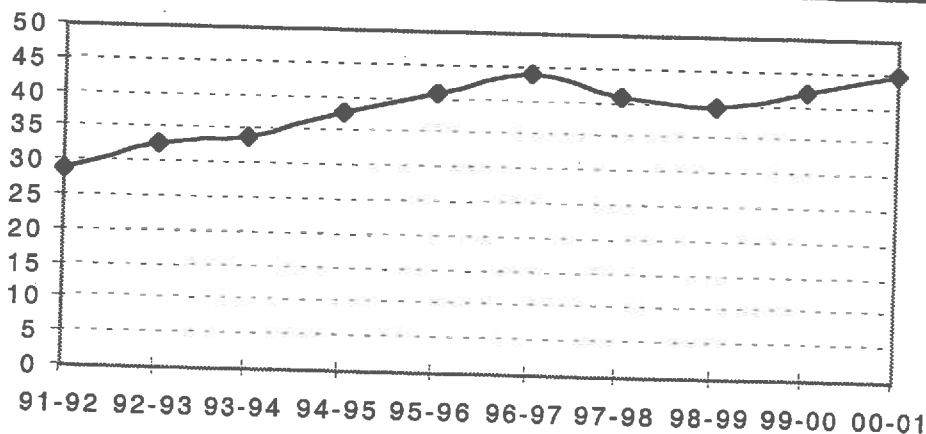

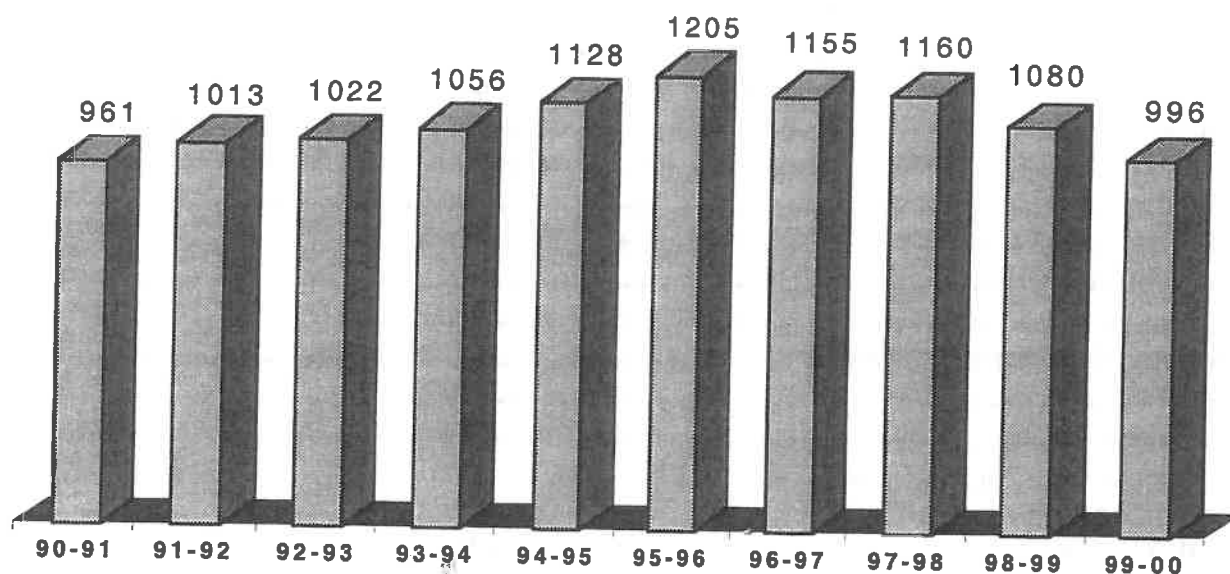

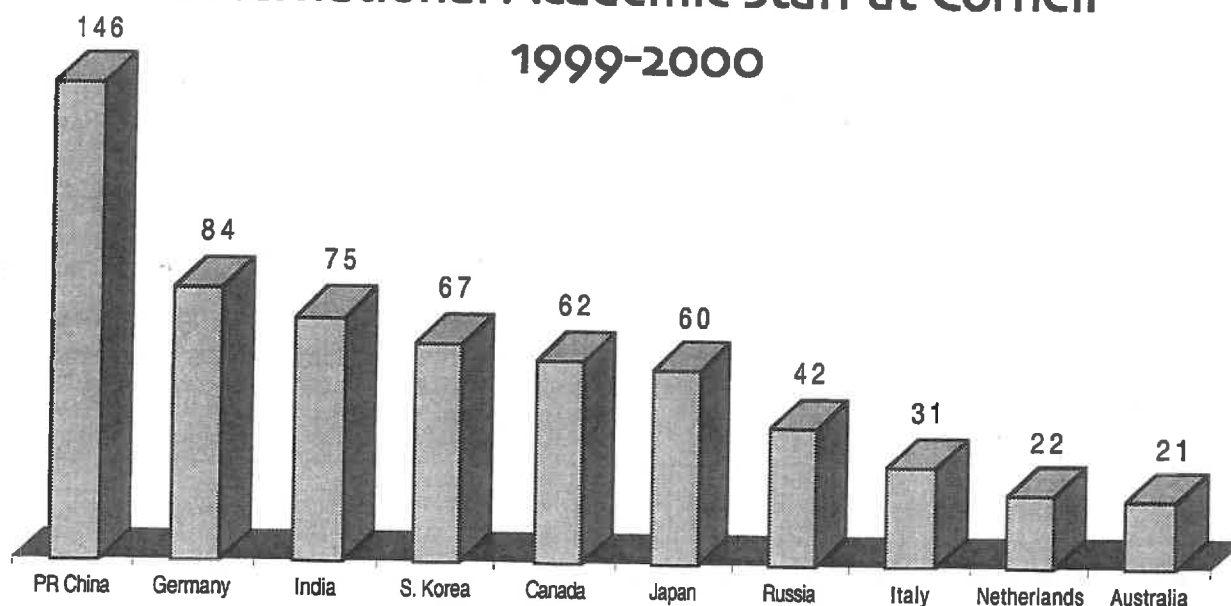

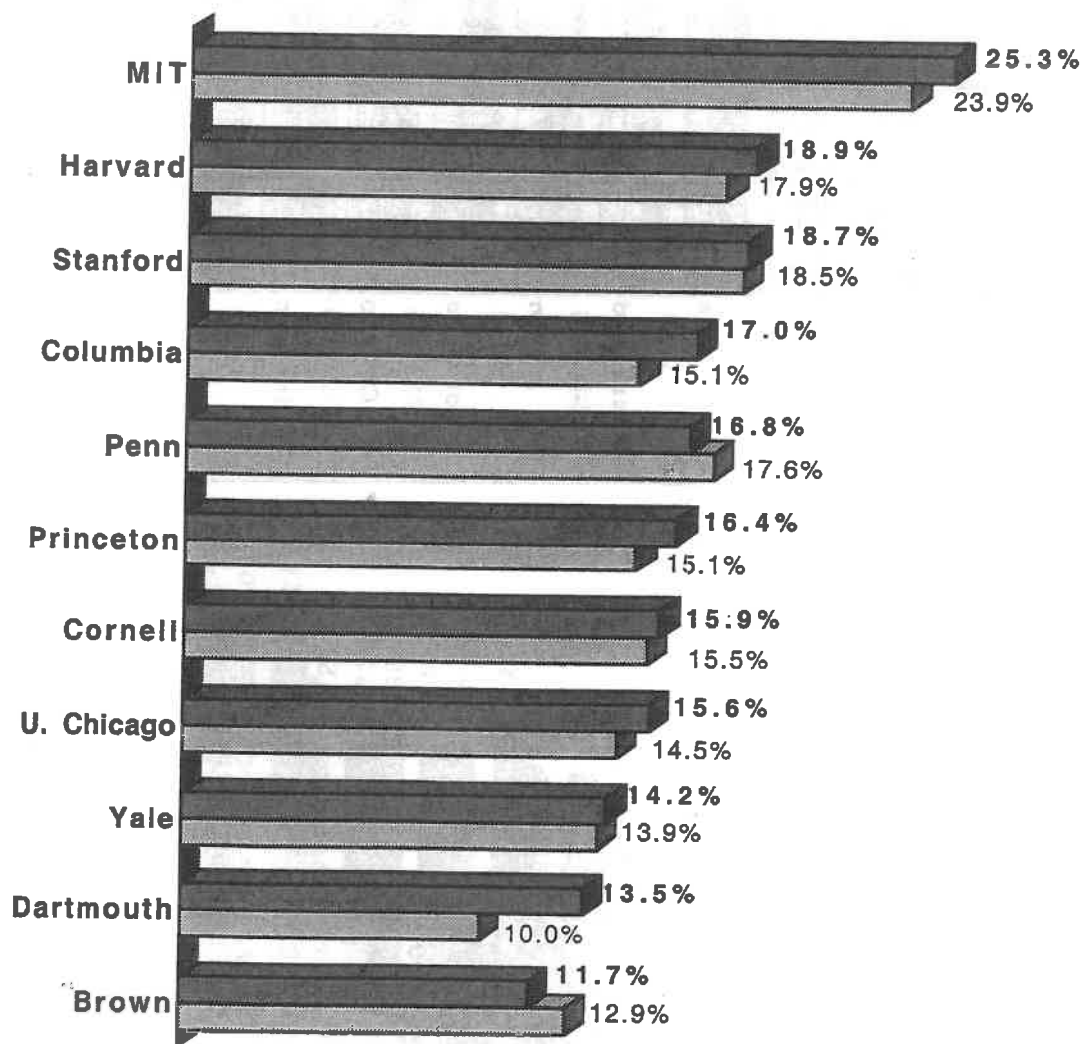

International Student Enrollment at Ivy League and Other Institutions Fall 1999-Fall 2000



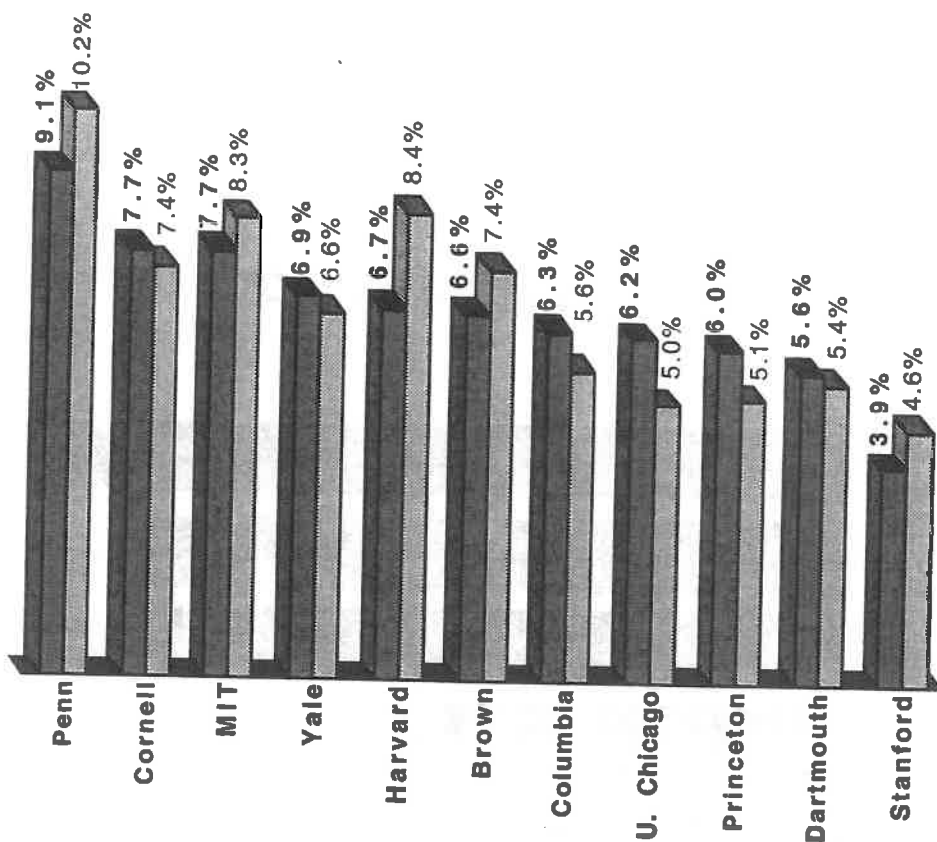

International Students as a Percent of All Students Fall 1999-Fall 2000



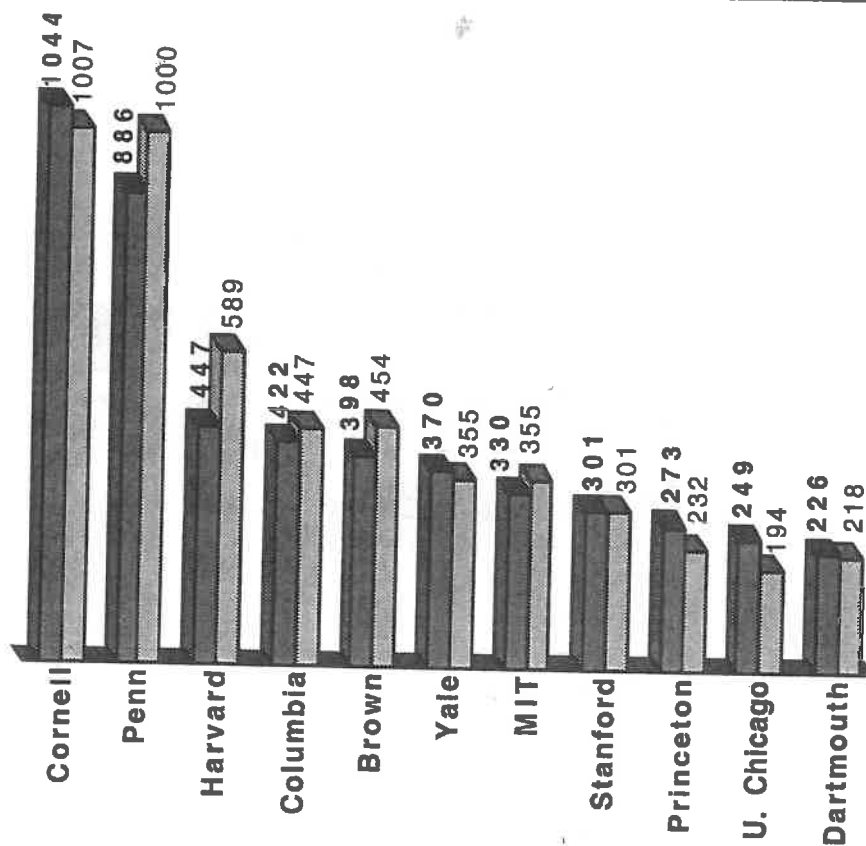

International Undergraduates as a Percentage of Total Undergraduates Fall 1999-Fall 2000



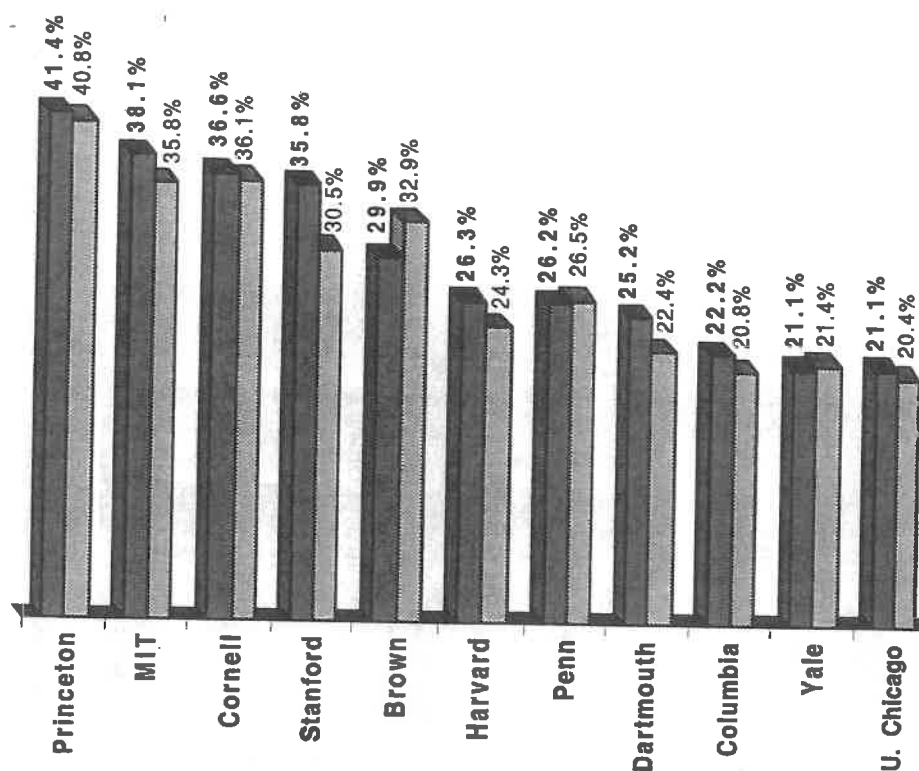

International Undergraduate Student Enrollment Fall 1999-Fall 2000



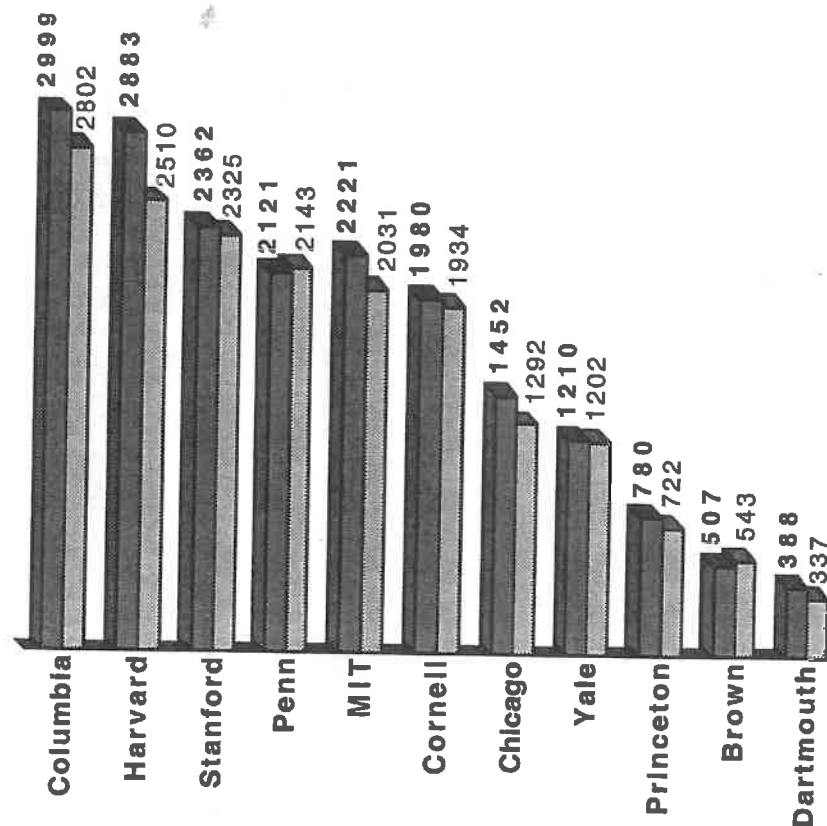

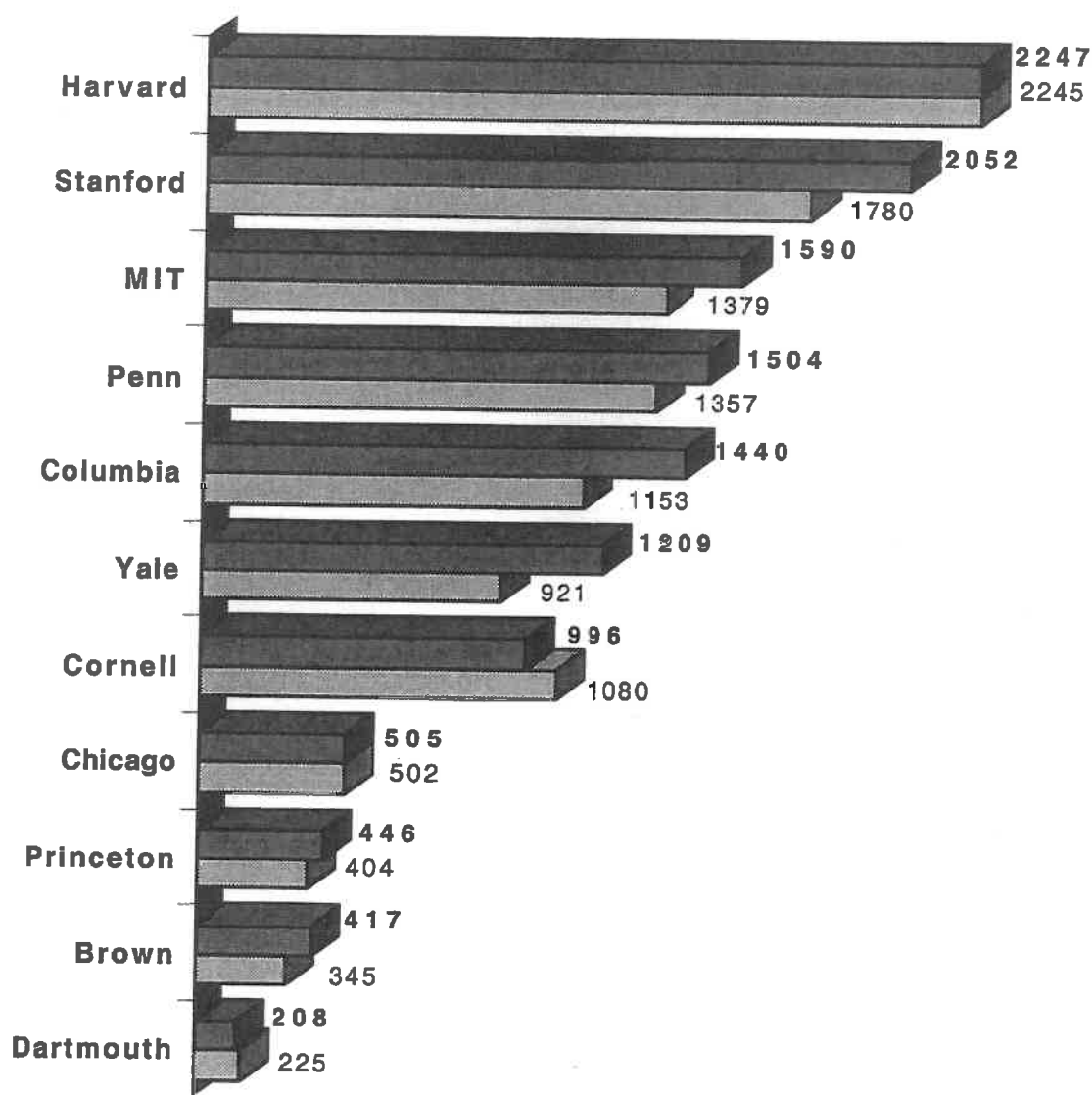
