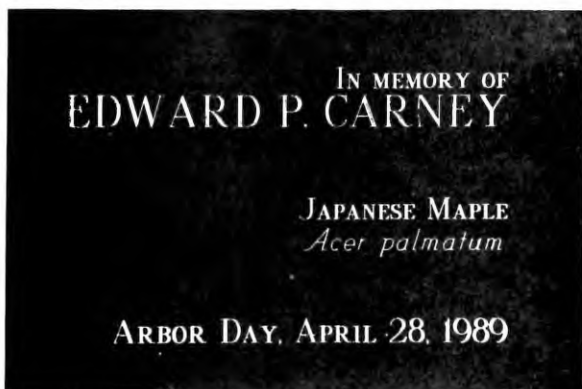

### TREE PLANTING CEREMONY

The Geneva Arboretum Association invites everyone to attend the planting of the *Gerald A. Marx Memorial Tree* at 3:30 p.m., Friday, May 12, on the lawn south of Sturtevant Hall. Former Director, Don Barton, will speak at the ceremony.

Jerry, Professor of Horticultural Science, died on November 13, 1988, after a 29-year career at the Station. He was a recognized authority on the genetics and breeding of vegetable crops, and was especially famous for his work in pea genetics.

Funds for the memorial tree were provided by Jerry's friends and colleagues.
