Dear Sir:-

Your favor of the 9th inst. addressed to Mr. Lee, our Genl Supt. referred to me for attention.

I shall take pleasure in affording your Board every facility for the most careful examination of this Road, track, buildings &c. It would be impossible, however, for you to do this on any regular train and an order to our conductors will therefore, be useless; but, if you will advise me as to the time you would like to make the examination, I shall take pleasure in furnishing you with a special train, so that you can take you own time in making the examination, stopping when, where and as long, as you please.

Please give me a few days notice, in order that there may be no delay in furnishing you with train, as above suggested. When the time is designated, I will either accompany you in person, or send some capable official with you.
