

"Old Mohawk bridge" at
Schenectady N.Y. e

- Contract made 3rd May 1808
- between Theodore Burr of the town of Oxford Chenango Co. N.Y. and the President and Directors of the Mohawk bridge.
 - "bridge over the Mohawk River at the City of Schenectady from the foot of Washington street to the termination of the Mohawk turnpike road opposite thereto and exactly on the site of the bridge built by the said Theodore at the same place"



- to be finished by the 1st of Nov 1808 sufficiently
to allow passage over it
- and by 1st of Dec. free from danger of ice
 - to be fully completed 1st day of July 1809

Contract price for sub- and super-
structure \$28,150
