Dear Sir:

Mr. Hilton, our Treasurer, yesterday presented me with a bill of the Cleveland Rolling Mills for steel rail delivered at Cleveland at an average date of April 1st, for which it appears that payment was made in three notes due Sept. 20th, Oct. 20th and Nov. 20th '75; two for twelve hundred dollars each and one for fourteen thousand, three hundred and fifty dollars.

I learn from Mr. Hilton, that the one due Sept. 20th has been paid.

In view of the present need for money in the payment of taxes, interest, &c., it is somewhat doubtful whether we shall be able to pay the one maturing the 20th inst.

I think it would be well for you to arrange with Mr. Stone for the renewal of the one falling due Nov. 20th.

Your early attention is requested to this matter so that I can be fully advised in time.
