

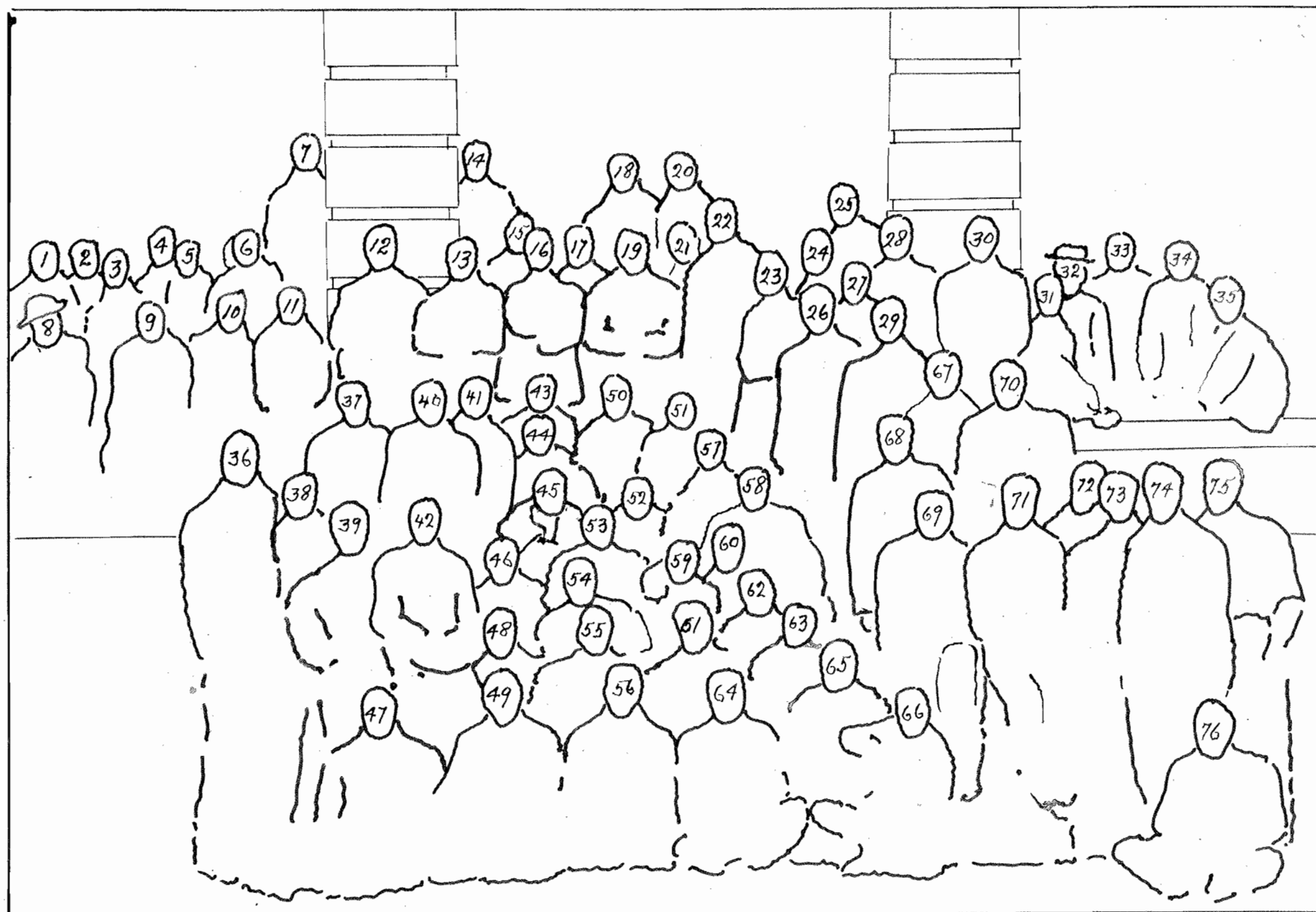
Constitutional Convention at Olmsted, Utah
