Dear Sir:-

Enclosed I hand you tracing of diagram showing location of what is known as the Atchison branch of the Hannibal and Saint Joseph Railroad, from the city of Saint Joseph to the city of Atchison. Also, our present time card, from which you will notice, we run directly through to and from Quincy and Hannibal, via Saint Joseph and Atchison, thus giving to the citizens of the last named city more desirable mail facilities than can be furnished by any other Road.
