



BIG FOOT BALER BF300 – TOOLS & SUPPLIES CHECKLIST

BigFoot BF300 <i>Basic Training Curriculum</i> (4 pages)
Grease pencil (for checking off tools, supplies, & procedures on laminated sheets)
Waterproof plastic bag containing trailer registration, BF300 operating instructions, etc.
Board, about 8” sq (to stabilize the trailer jack on soft ground)
Ball mount hitch fitted with 2-5/16” ball (either with 1” rise or with raised ball)
Jack (for changing tires)
Tire iron
Trailer jack (to stabilize the trailer when unhitched)
Wheel chocks (blocks to prevent trailer from rolling)
Anti-slip grit tape
Fire extinguisher
J-bar (wrecking bar)
Jumper cables
Scissors, Knife or other cutting tools
Marker (permanent, for labeling finished bales)
Safety reflectors (a set of triangular reflectors are provided)
Screwdriver (heavy duty, long shaft)
Storage box lock
Tire pressure gauge
Vice grips
Wire cutters (fencing quality)
Wire ties (sufficient number, in wire rack—need 5/bale)
Wire-tying tool (such as Pango Tie-Tyer—optional)
Fuel Stabilizer (such as STA-Bil® Ethanol Treatment or Marine Formula; add to gas regularly)
Lubricant for metal parts (<i>e.g.</i> , WD-40)
Oil (spare quart of SAE 5W-30 or 10W-30 for Honda engine)
Respirator masks (*Moldex 2300 N95, for use in dusty or moldy conditions)
Ear plugs/sound-reducing ear muffs (*EAR Taper Fit Foam /Peltor H9 Ear Muff NRR 25dB)
Safety glasses (*Crews BearKat mini safety glasses / Uvex Astrospec OTG – for over glasses)
Gloves (non-slip palm grip recommended— <i>e.g.</i> , Atlas cloth-backed; waterproof, if needed)
Waterproof apron (&/or other protective clothing)
Wear: Waterproof, closed toed shoes or boots
