He is an applied micro-economist with broad interests in public economics, international development, health economics, education economics, and labor economics. The main goal of his research is to understand the impact and behavioral responses to the public intervention programs in both developed and developing countries. He has been investigating various public interventions such as cancer screening, general health screening, long-term health insurance, education support program, HIV/AIDS prevention program, mother and child health program, family planning intervention as well as the effects of job opportunity and internship program on employment. He is also running several field projects in Malawi, Ethiopia, and Ghana where he has implemented randomized controlled trials (RCTs) to tackle important issues in public policy and economics.
