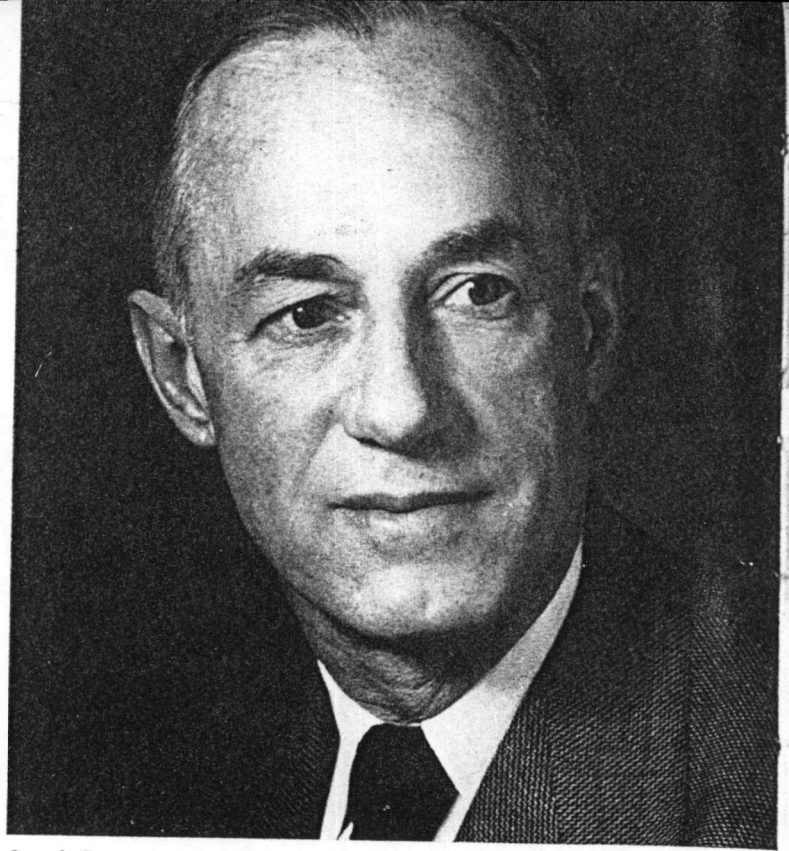


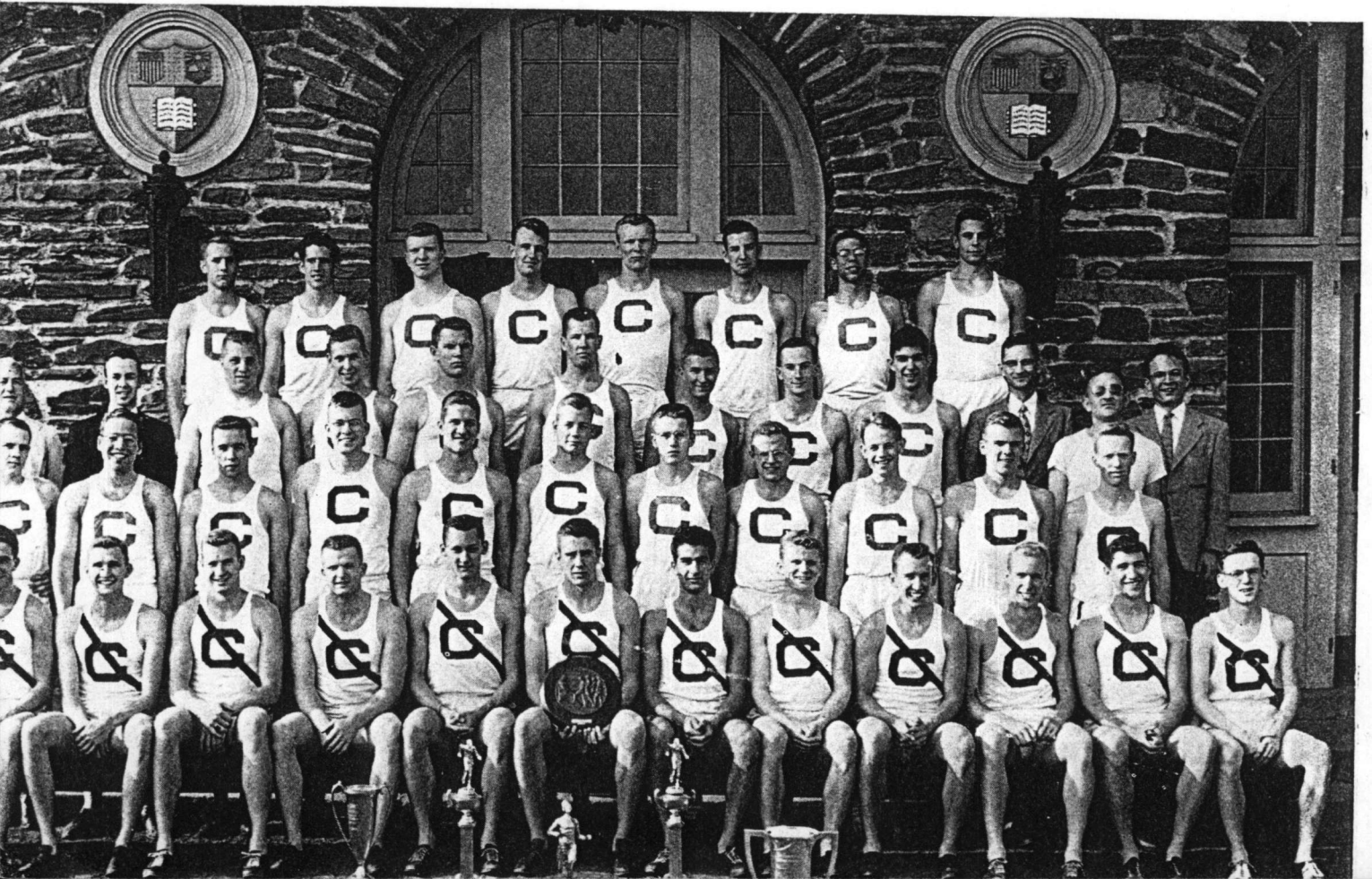

The Big Reel Track Team opened its indoor season showing good strength and depth against Dartmouth. Sophomore Andy Dadagian outraced captain Jim Lingel in the 600-yard run, and victories in the mile and two-mile relays assured the Big Red of a 69-1 3 to 39-1/3 win over the Big Green.

The Big Red Mile Relay Team, composed of Larry Lattomus, Jack Allen, Dadagian, and Lingel, surprised the sports world by winning four major invitational races. The Knights of Columbus Mile was first, followed by the Philadelphia Inquirer Relays, the NYAC Games, and the 174th Regiment Invitational. In the NYAC race, Lingel ran a 47.8 anchor quarter, the third fastest quarter mile ever run in an indoor meet. In the Regiment Invitational he set a world's record in the 300-yard dash.

Chick Trayford took the spotlight in the IC4A Races as he finished third behind Villanova's Dwyer and Army's Olive in the mile. The Mile Relay Team suffered its first loss to Manhattan, but the tables were turned in the second Knights of Columbus meet as the Red Men outraced Manhattan's crack team.

Cornell was host for the "Heps" this year, and tied Columbia for first. The Red won two firsts and placed men in all but three events. Craig Weisman
