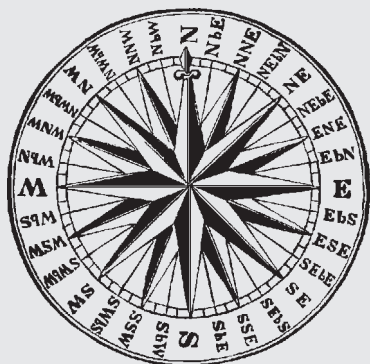

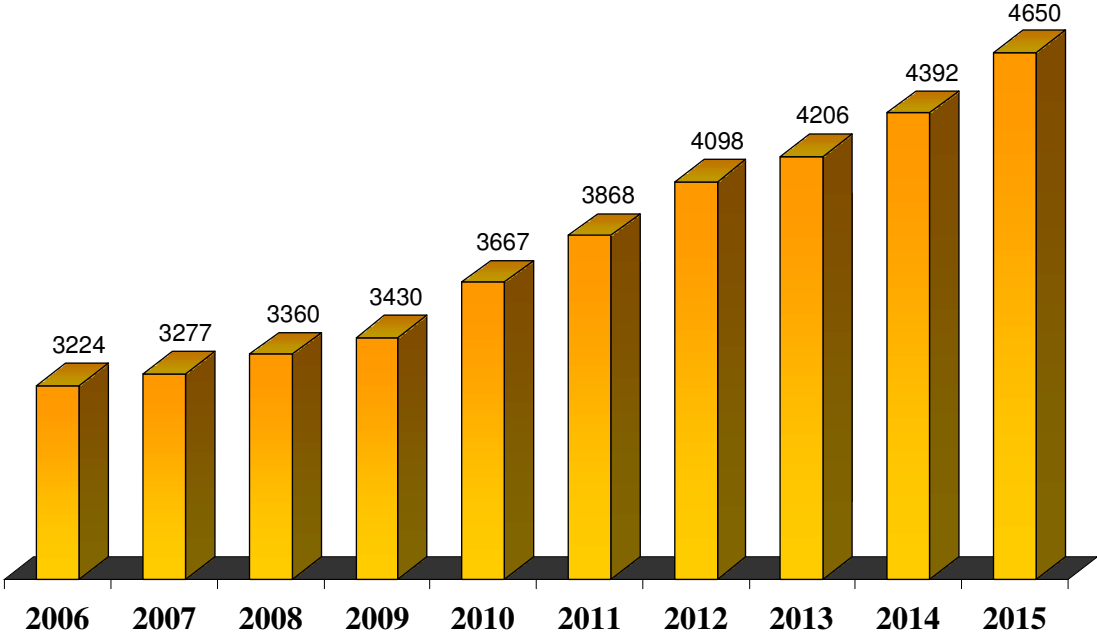

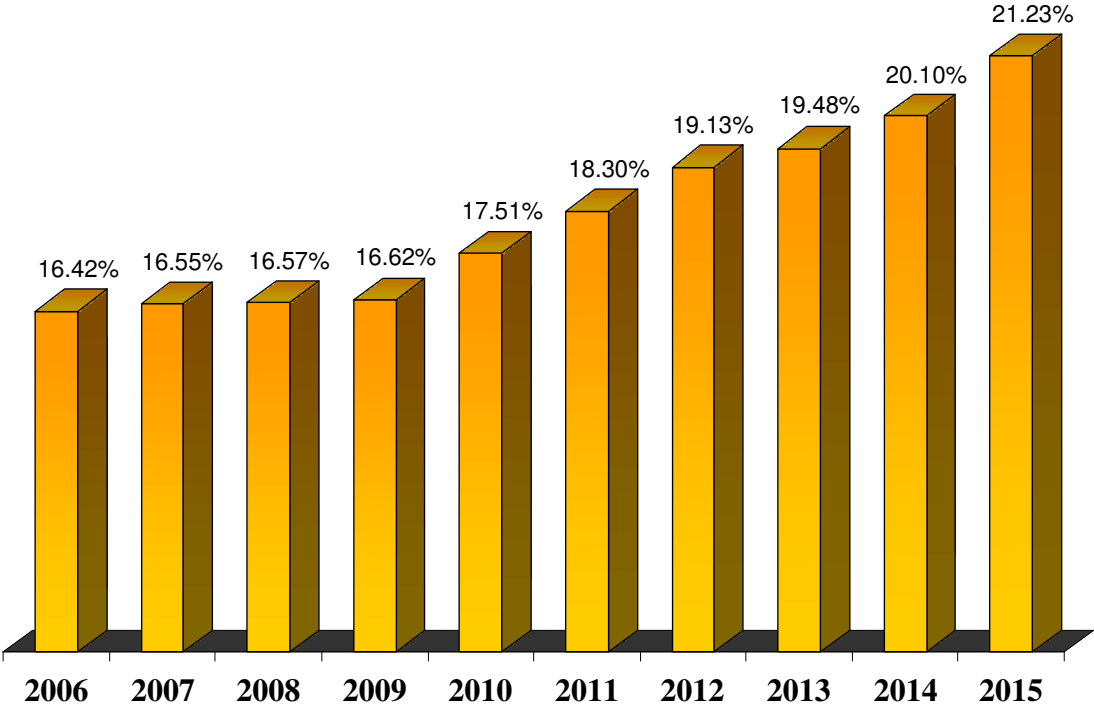

International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment

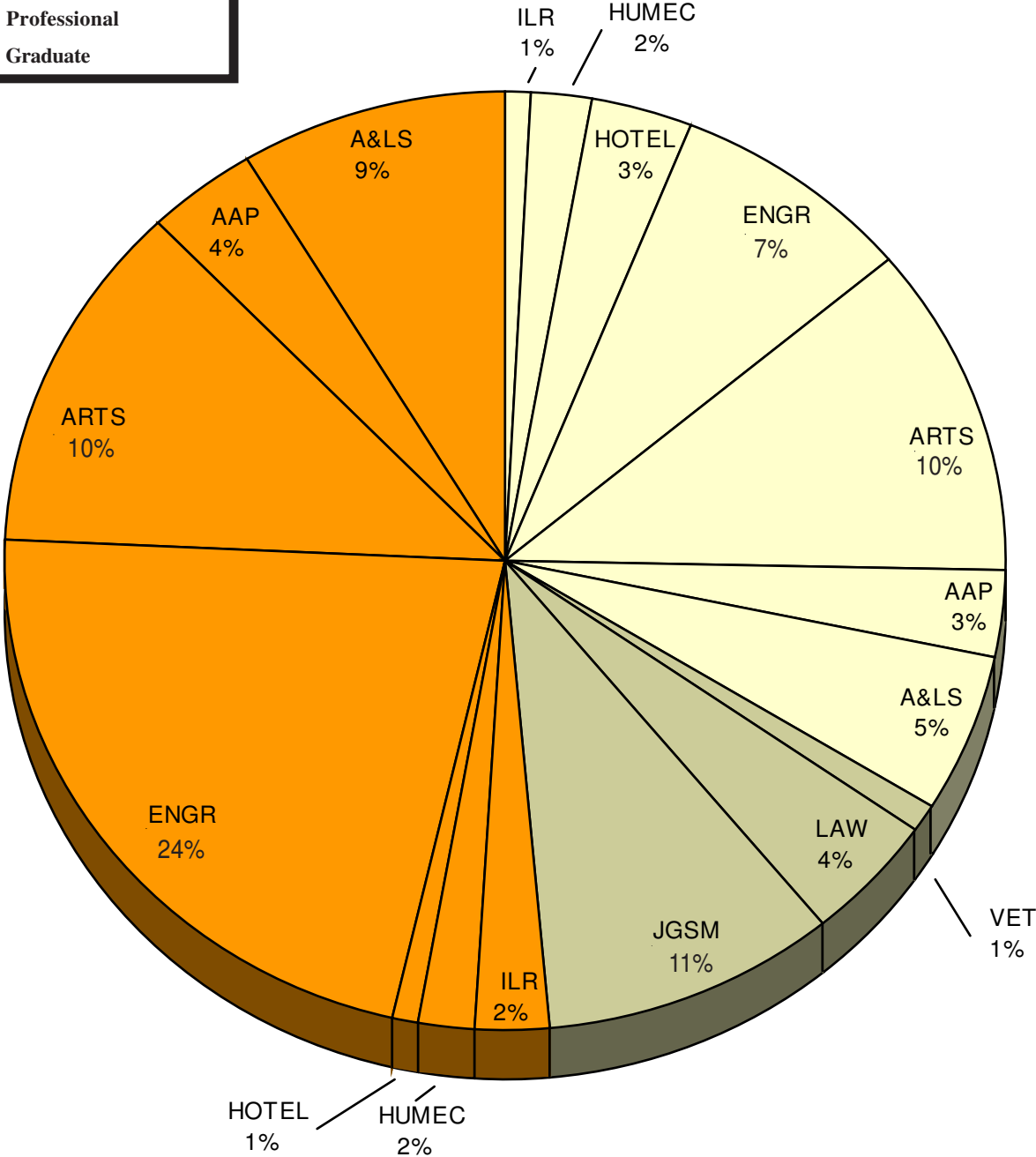
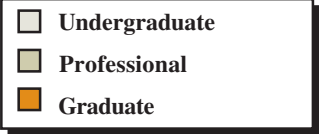

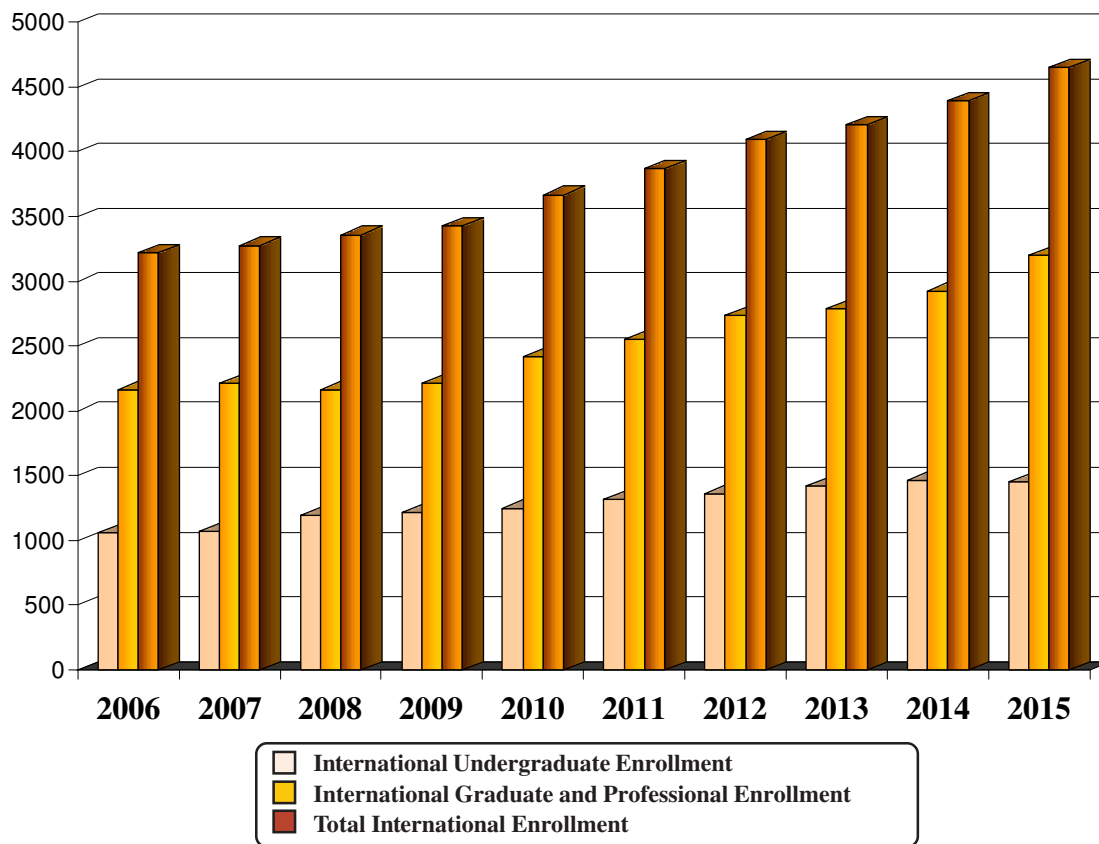

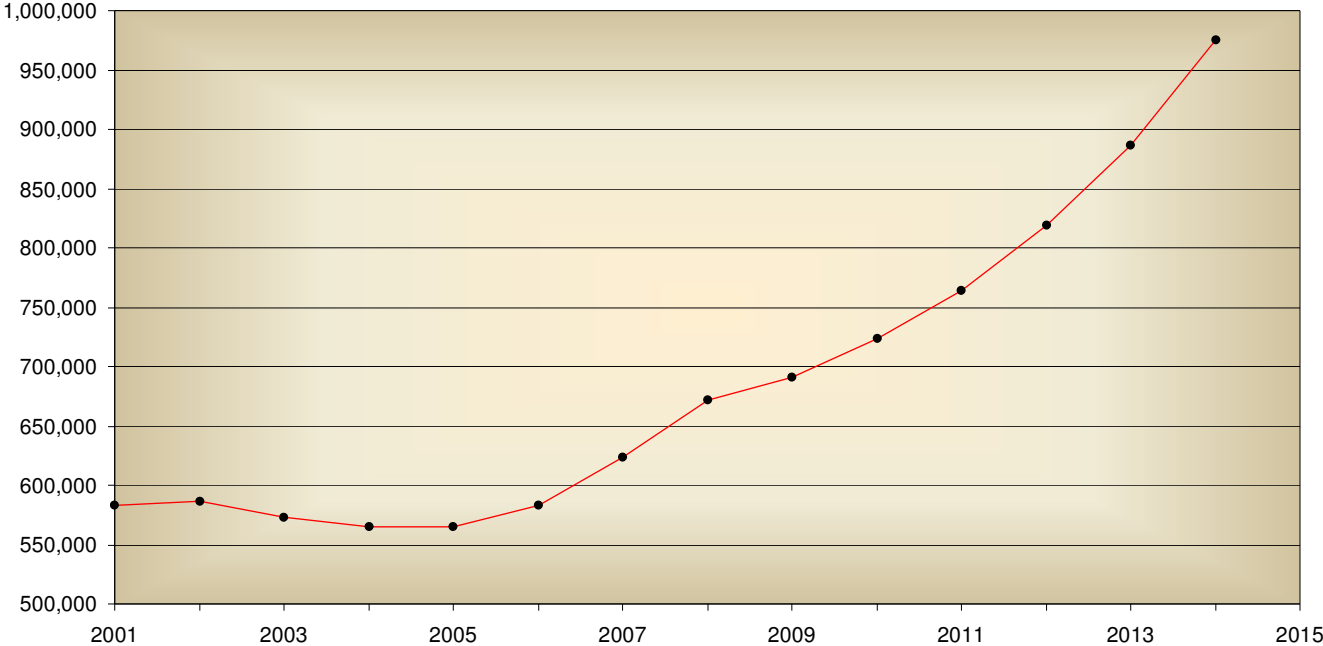

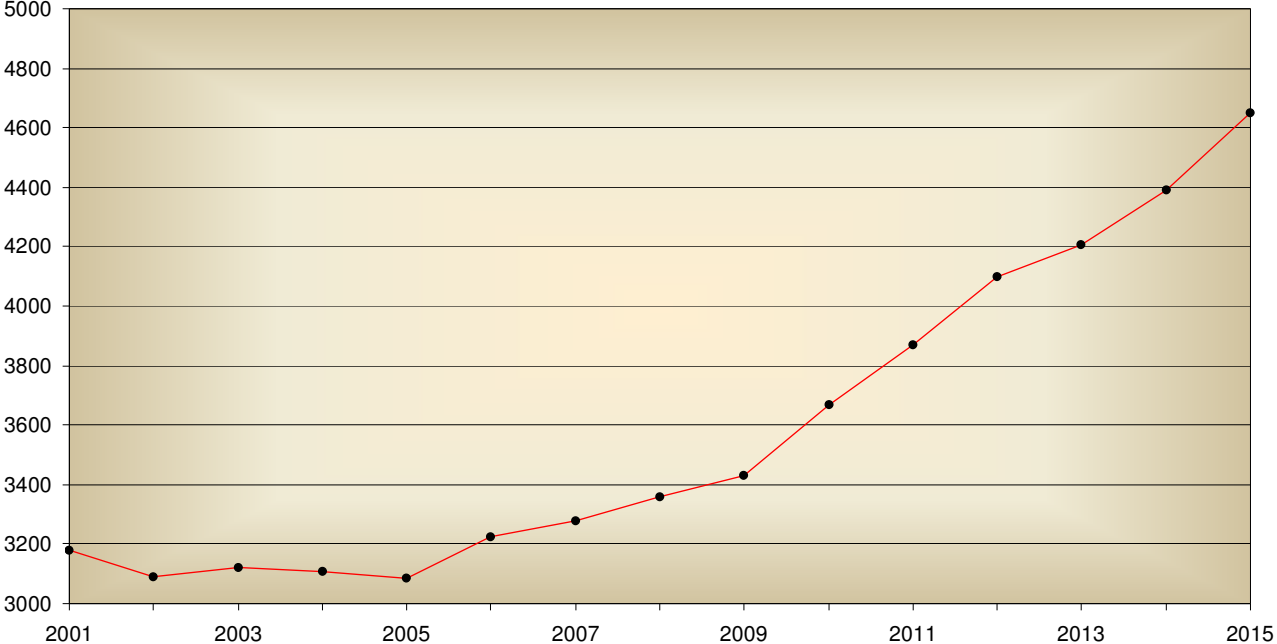

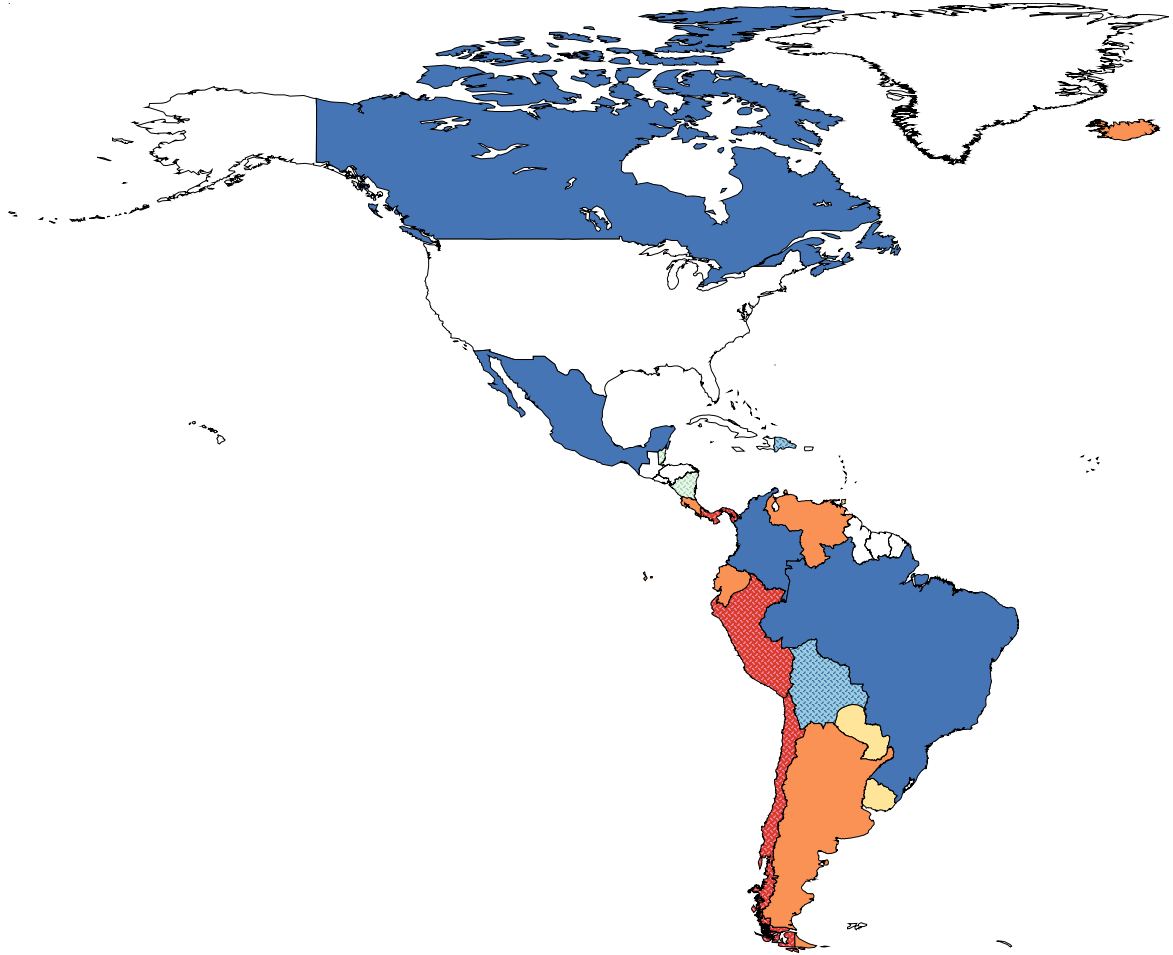
International Enrollment Trends 2001 - 2015

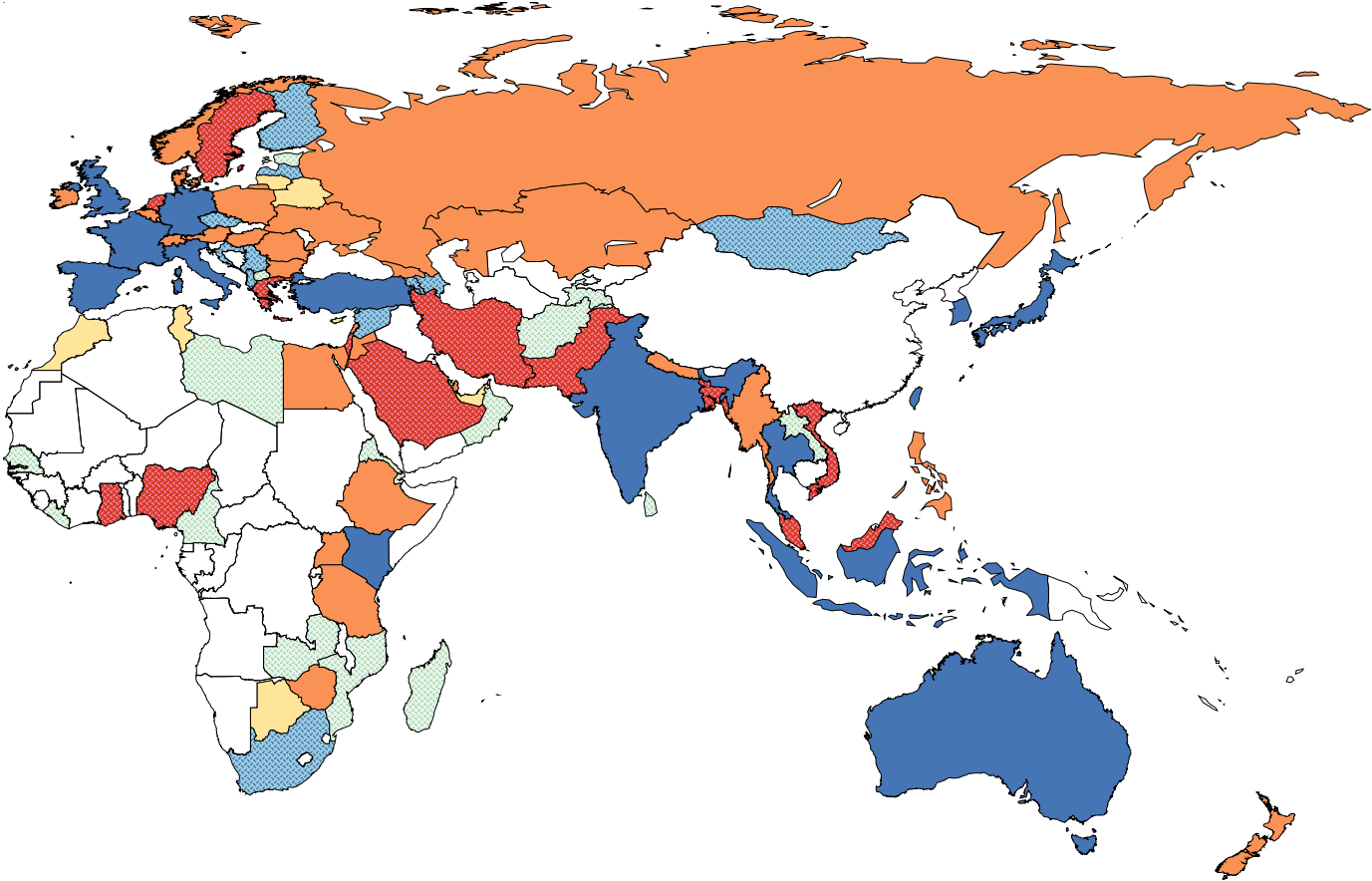
National Trend

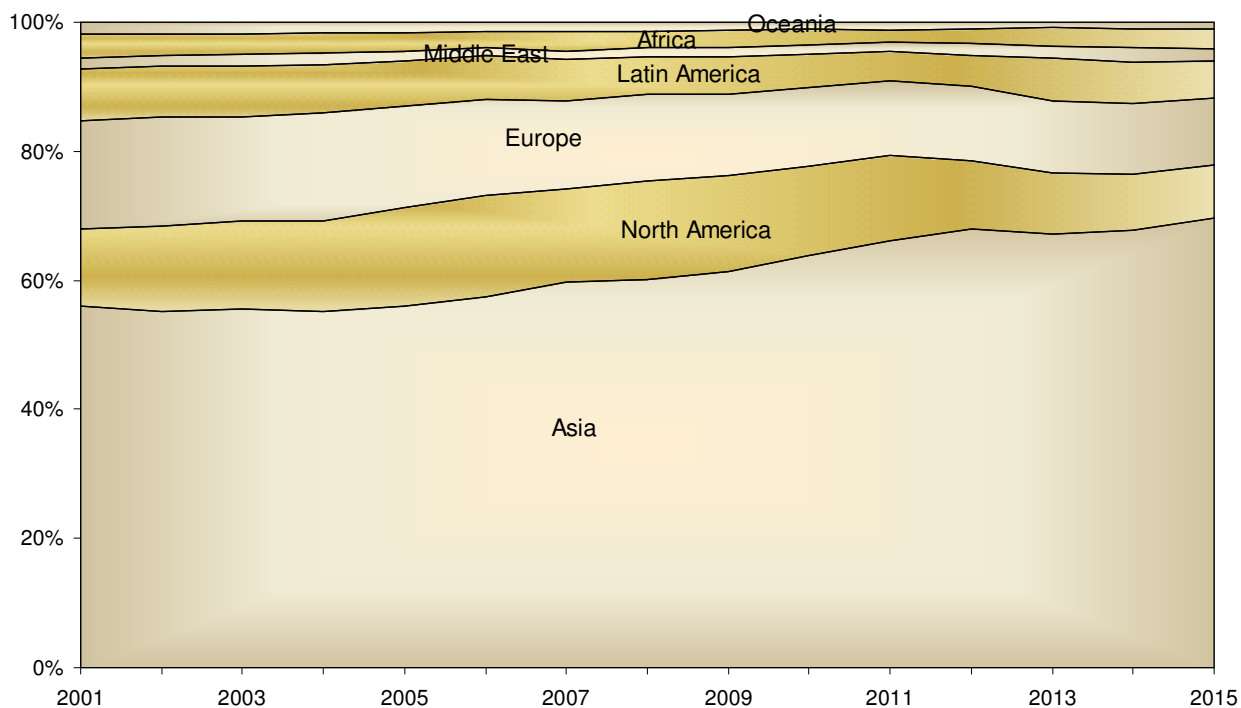

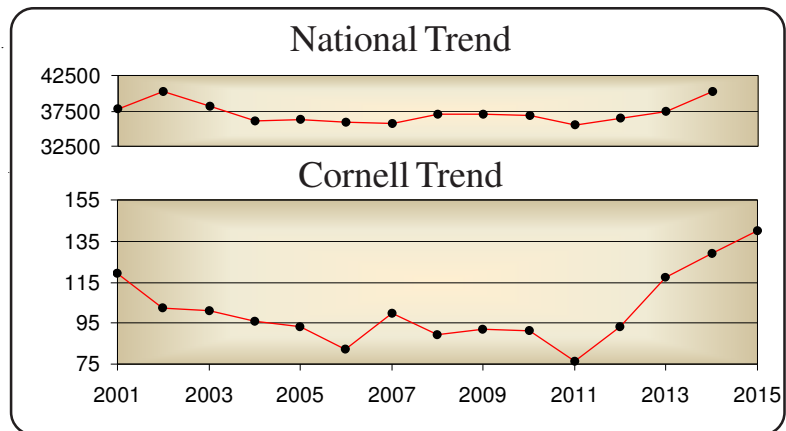
Regional Enrollment Trends 2001-2015



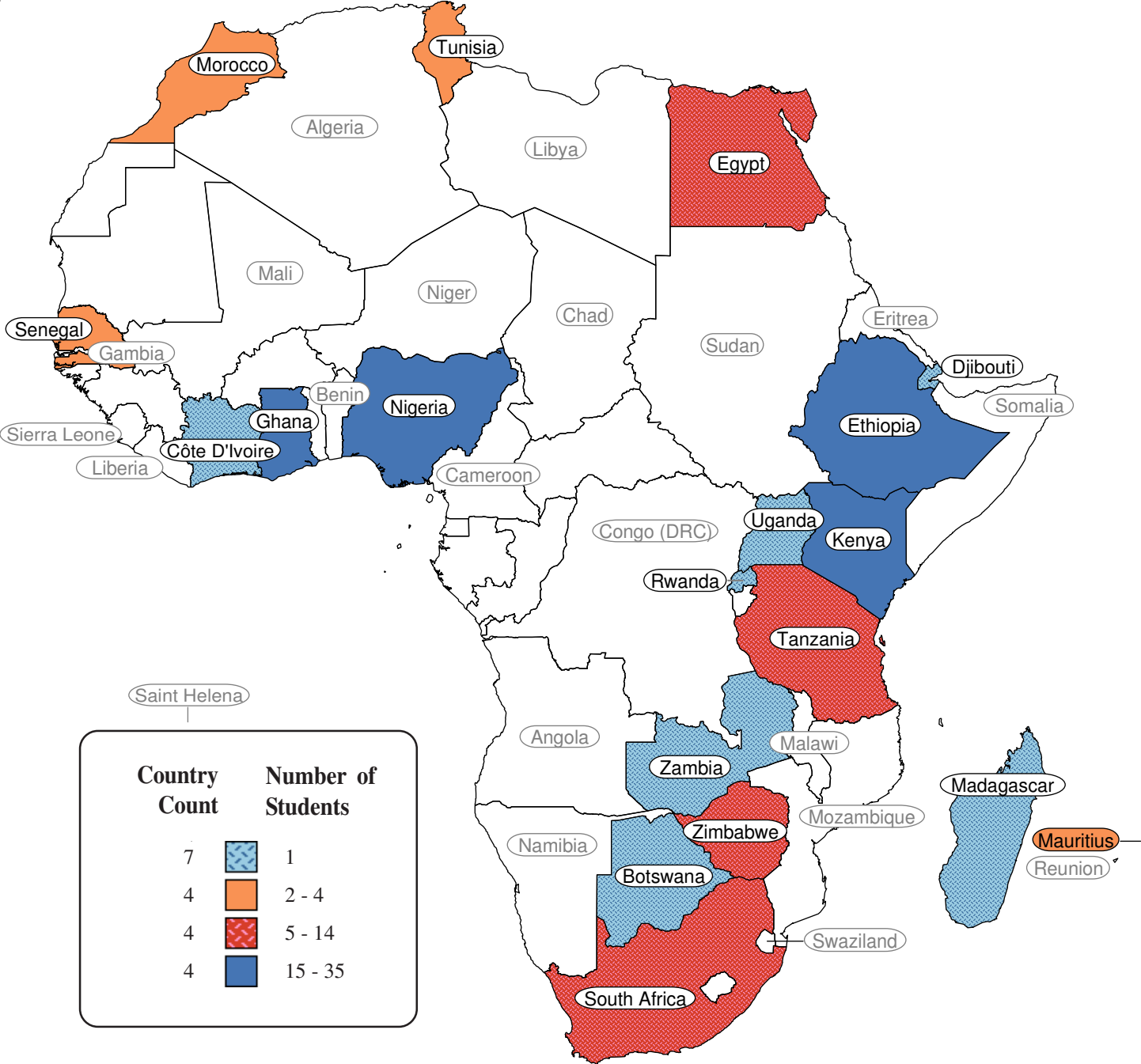
