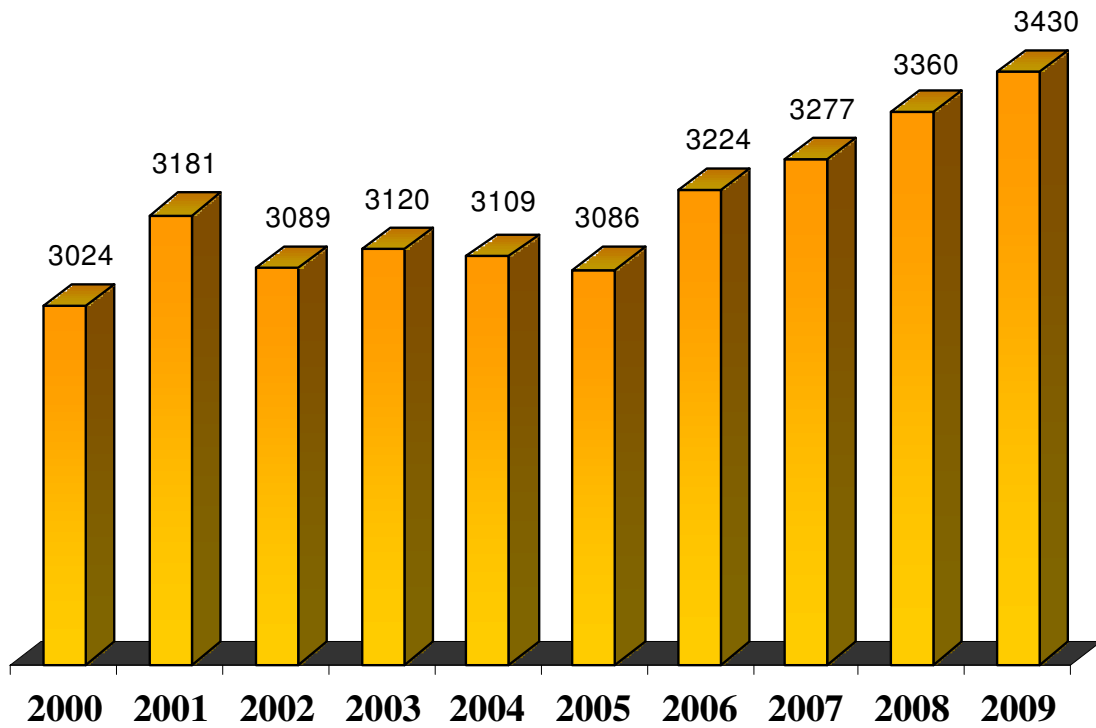

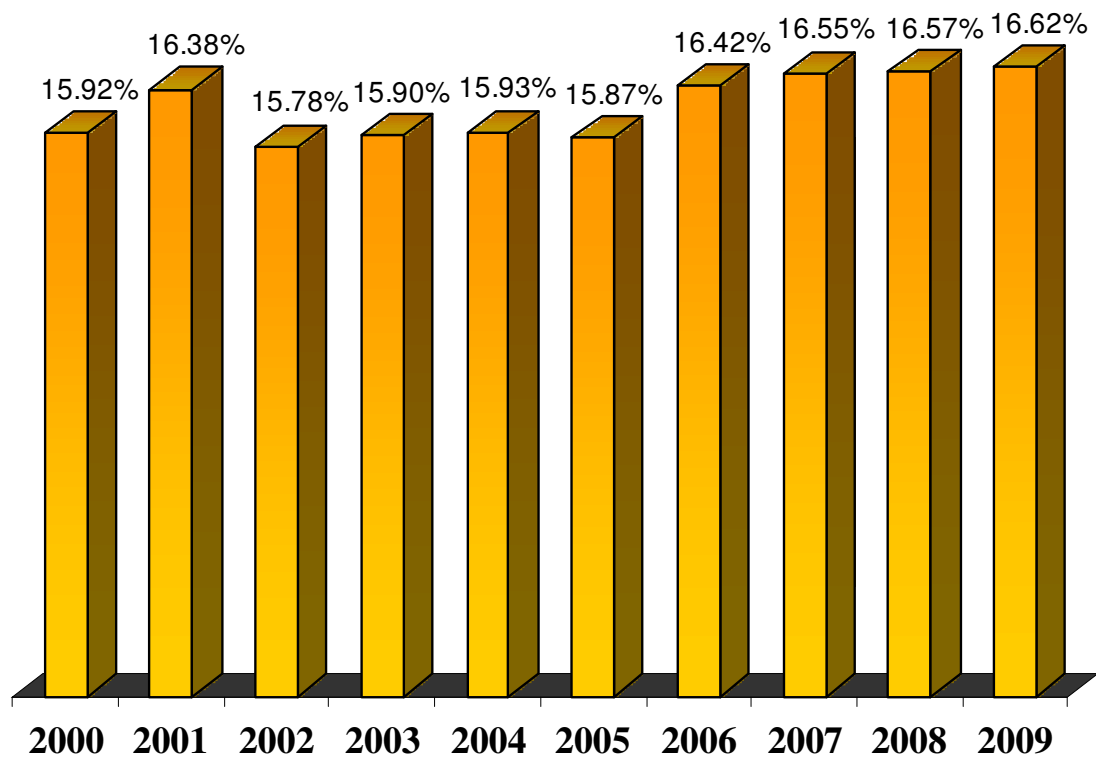

International Students At Cornell University



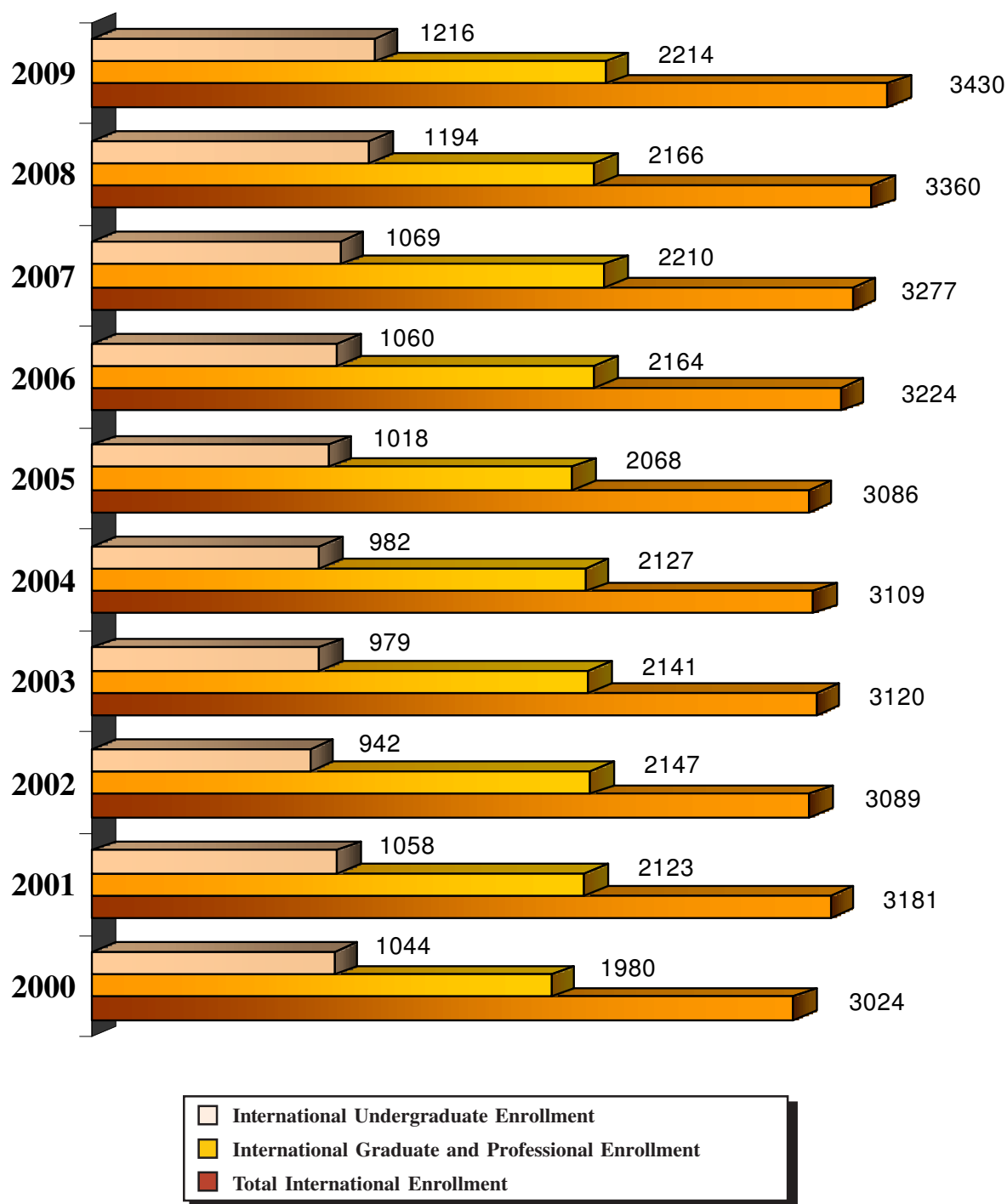
International Students as a Percentage



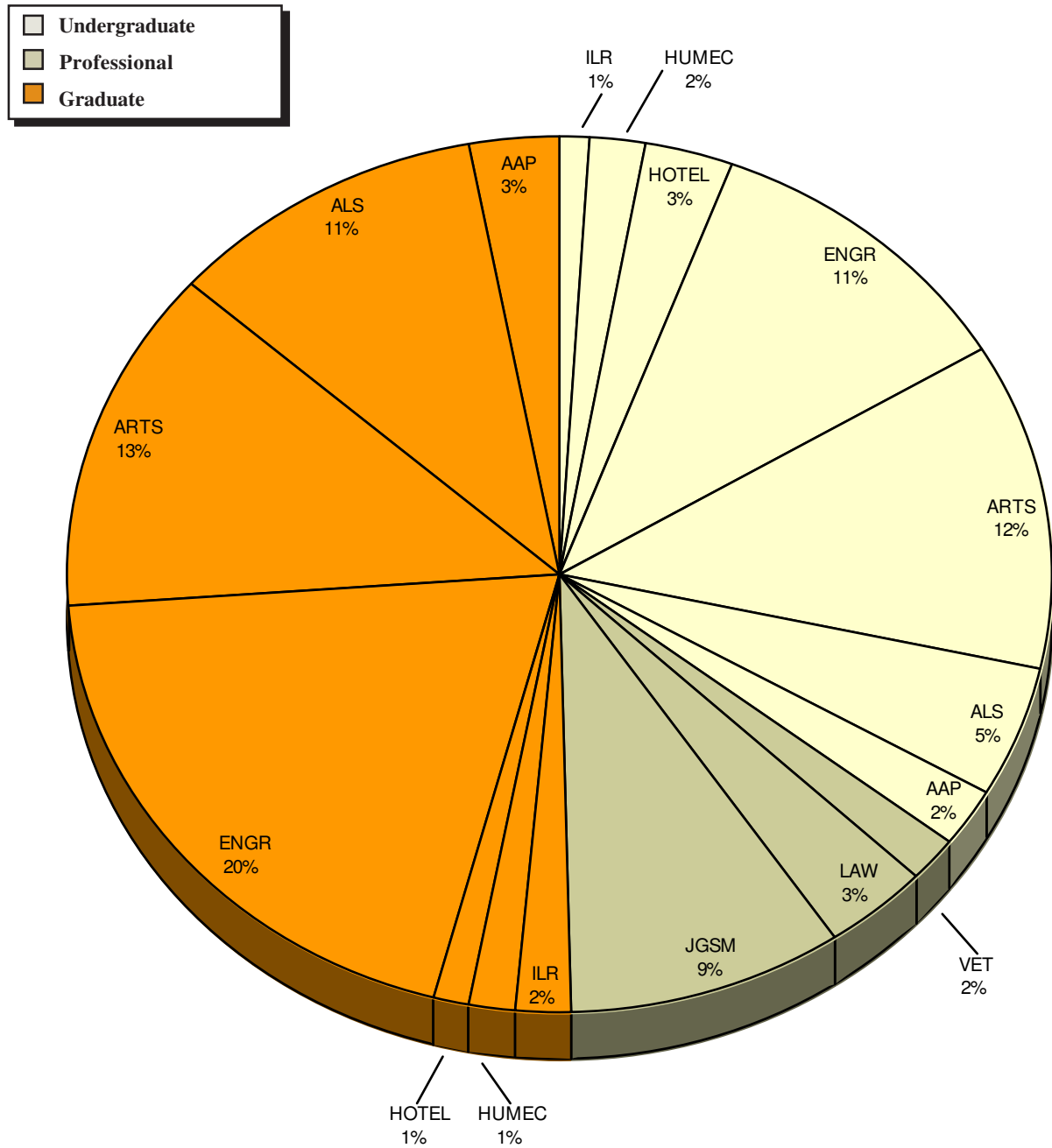

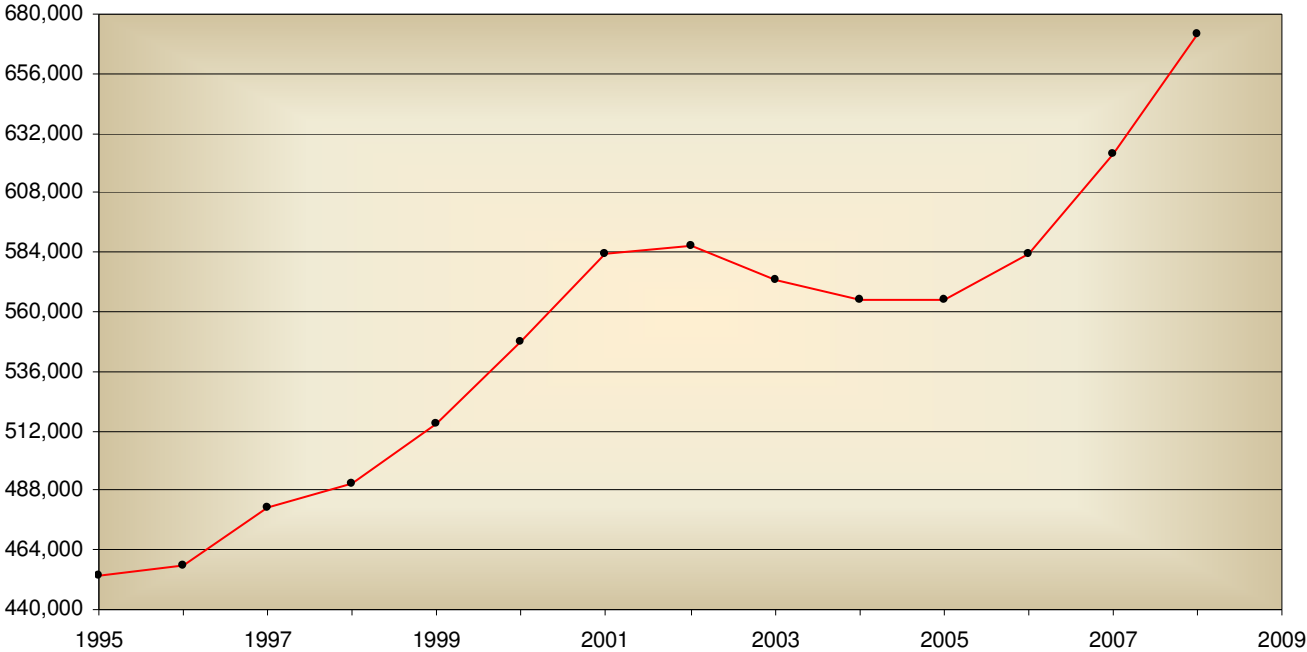


International Undergraduate, Graduate and Professional Student Fields of Study Fall 2009

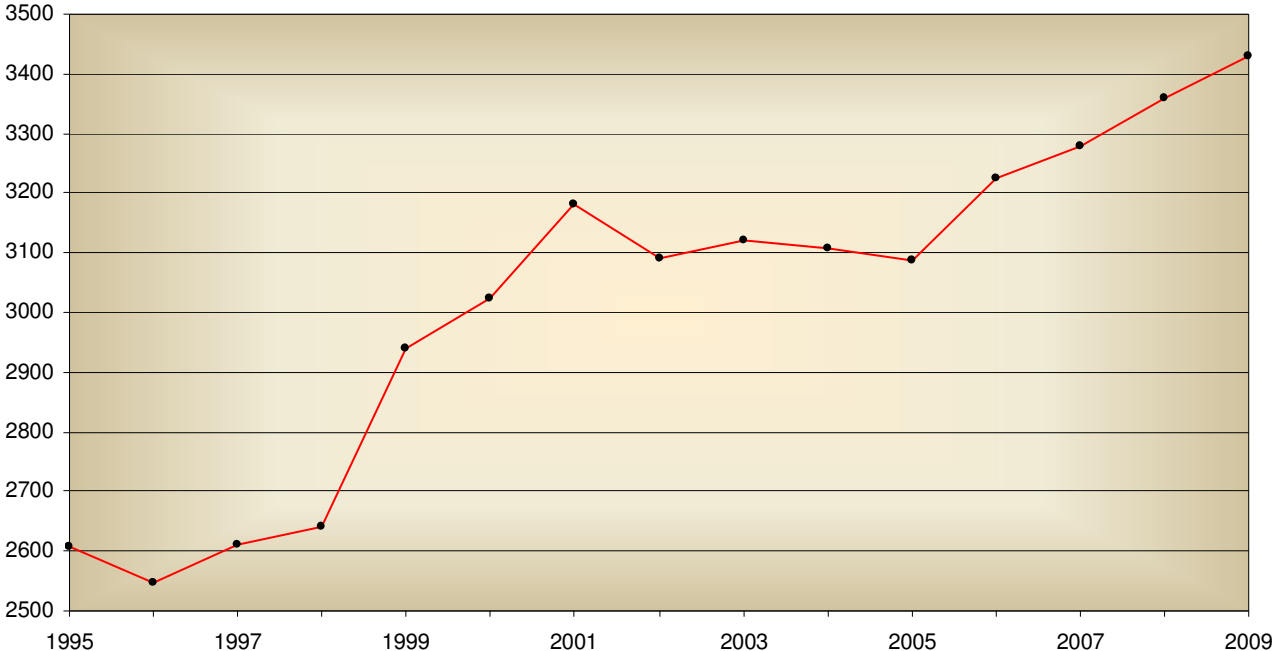


International Enrollment Trends 1994 - 2009

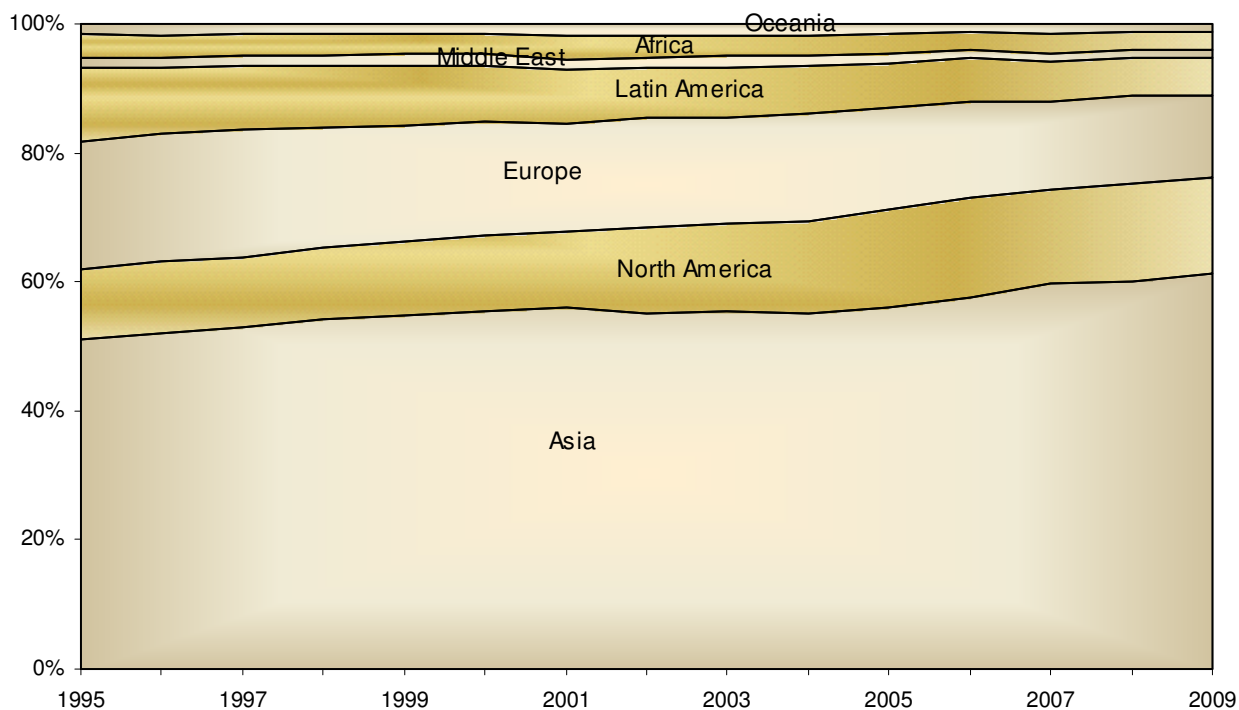

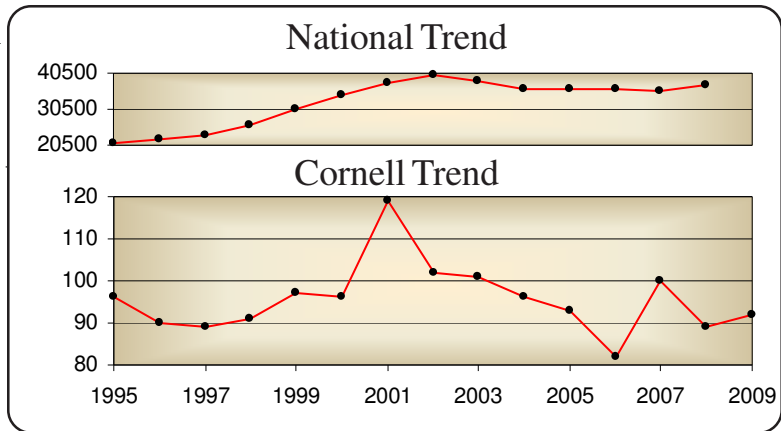
Regional Enrollment Trends 1995-2009



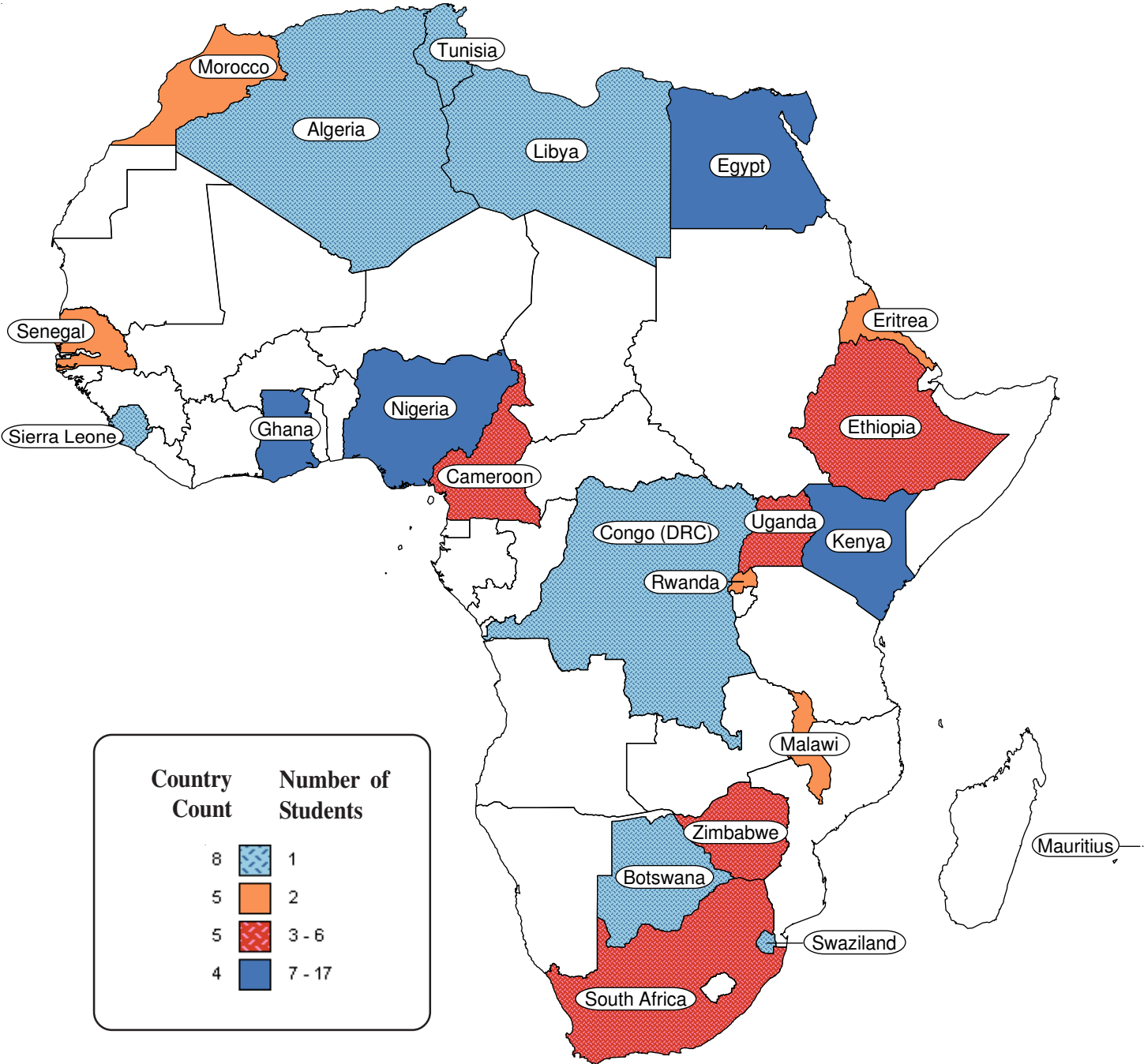
