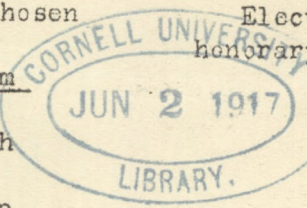
The Juniors wish to thank the Frosh for the enjoyable time which they had at the masquerade last evening.
