**Col. R. S. Stevens**

The Sedalia Democrat of the 30th contains the following:

"The Hannibal Clipper says that Col. R. S. Stevens resigned the general management of the M. K. & T. railroad on the 18th inst., and that his office of general manager has been abolished. The same paper states that the general supervisor has resigned to take effect on next Thursday (tomorrow). It is thought that Mr. J. W. Tuthill of the St. Joe and Denver road will take his place."
